LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped back-to-back games for just the 2nd time in 2025, falling in the series opener at Jersey Shore, 3-1...SS **Jesús Báez** and 3B **Jacob Reimer** broke up the shutout bid with a pair of doubles in the top of the 9th...C **Chris Suero** walked and stole 2nd to put the tying runs in scoring position, but a fly out to center ended the game...RHP **Noah Hall** suffered the tough-luck loss, allowing just 1 run on 7 hits in 4.0-plus innings, walking 2 and striking out 4...RHPs **Anthony Nunez**, **Dylan Ross**, and **Ben Simon** combined to work 3.0 innings of hitless and scoreless relief between the 5th and 8th innings...RHP **Casey Steward** earned the win for the BlueClaws, tossing 6.0 innings of scoreless 2-hit ball...All 3 Jersey Shore runs scored on sacrifice flies.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On April 23, 2024, RHPs **Nolan McLean** (5.0 IP), **Dakota Hawkins** (3.0), and **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0) combined on a 5-hit shutout in a 5-0 win vs. Wilmington...The trio combined to strikeout 10 batters in the win...1B **Nick Lorusso** went 3-for-4 with a triple and 3 RBI...C **Drake Osborn** reached base 4 times with 2 hits, including a double, and 2 walks...On this date, 3 former Cyclones have made their Major League debut...LHP **Lenny DiNardo** (2001) in 2004 for the Boston Red Sox, INF **Jordany Valdespin** (2009) in 2012 for the New York Mets, and OF **Juan Lagares** (2008) in 2013 for the New York Mets.

HALL OF A START: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP **Noah Hall** has returned to form in 2025...Despite taking the loss on Tuesday, over his first 4 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 1-2 with a 1.45 ERA (3 ER in 18.2 IP), 22 strikeouts and only 13 hits allowed...Entering Wednesday, Hall is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in strikeouts (22), 4th in innings pitched (18.2), and 6th in ERA (1.45)...His 54.5% ground ball rate is also good for 4th-best in the circuit...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

A THORN-TON IN THEIR SIDE: LHP **Zach Thornton** has been utterly dominant to start 2025...The Lawrence, Kan. native posted a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball, striking out a career-high-matching 8, while facing the minimum...Thornton was recognized as the New York Mets' Minor League Pitcher of the Week on Monday...He is 1 of only 2 arms at the High-A level to toss 15.0 or more innings without allowing an earned run (Aberdeen's RHP **Braxton Bragg**)...Thornton is the only arm not to allow a run at all...He is also 1 of 4 arms to not allow a run over 15.0+ frames across all of Minor League Baseball in 2025 (Double-A Corpus Christi RHP **José Fleury**, Double-A Somerset's RHP **Brendan Beck**, and Double-A Altoona's LHP **Hunter Barco**)...Entering play on Tuesday, the 23-year-old is 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball in WHIP (0.44) and tied for 5th in batting average against (.098)...Among South Atlantic League arms, Thornton leads the circuit in wins (3) and WHIP (0.44)...He is also 2nd in batting average against (.098), tied for 2nd in strikeouts (22), and tied for 8th in innings pitched (16.0)...Since 2005, Thornton's 44-to-4 strikeout-to-walk ratio (11.0) is the best in Cyclones' history among pitchers with 40.0 or more innings of work (43.0)...RHP **Benito Garcia's** 9.50 ratio (38-to-4 in 42.2 IP) is 2nd...His WHIP (0.91) is 6th...Trailing only LHP **John Mincone** (0.71), Garcia (0.75), RHP **Hansel Robles** (0.78), RHP **Marcos Molina** (0.84), and RHP **Dylan Owen** (0.87).

REIM TIME: INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Reimer registered 5-straight multi-hit games from last Sunday vs. Hudson Valley until Friday at Aberdeen, earning New York Mets Minor League Player of the Week on Monday...The 21-year-old was also named to MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" after hitting .421 (8-19) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 4 RBI in 5 games...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is tied for 4th in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (3)...He leads the South Atlantic League in triples (3)...Reimer is also tied for the league lead in extra-base hits (11) and total bases (38), tied for 2nd in doubles (6), 3rd in OPS (1.044) and slugging percentage (.644), tied for 3rd in hits (20), 5th in batting average (.339), tied for 4th in runs scored (13), and tied for 7th in RBI (13).

SUPER SUERO: C **Chris Suero** has been one of the best hitters in Minor League Baseball to start 2025...Last Thursday, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On Tuesday, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on Sunday vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Wednesday, Suero is 5th in all of Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (.708) and tied for 7th in home runs (5)...He also leads the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.739), and is tied for the league lead in home runs (5) and extra-base hits (11)...Suero is also 2nd in OPS (1.105), tied for 2nd in doubles (6), 4th in RBI (16), 5th in total bases (34), and tied for 7th in runs scored (12)...Suero was recognized on MiLB's "Prospect Team of the Week" on Monday after going 10-for-29 (.345) with 5 doubles, 3 home runs, and 9 RBI over his first 8 games.

START ME UP: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 15 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 2.35 ERA (17 ER in 65.0 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 80-to-25 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 2.35 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (2.55)...It is also 2nd among all High-A franchises...Kansas City's Quad Cities (2.03) has the lowest mark at the level...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a 2.89 ERA (44 ER in 137.0 IP), which is good for the 3rd-lowest at High-A and 2nd-lowest in the SAL behind Quad Cities (2.50) and Hudson Valley (2.81)...The 2.89 ERA ranks 6th in all of Minor League Baseball...Quad Cities and Miami's Double-A Pensacola (2.50) are tied for 1st.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, Cyclones relievers have a 6-2 record with a 3.38 ERA (27

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn continues their 2-week road trip with 6 games against the BlueClaws...Jersey Shore enters the series after dropping 4-of-6 on the road against Greensboro...In 2024, Brooklyn went 10-17 against the BlueClaws and 6-6 at ShoreTown Ballpark...Jersey Shore boasts 11 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects: INF **Devin Saltiban** (9), INF **Bryan Rincón** (14), INF **Carson DeMartini** (15), OF **John Spikerman** (16), LHP **Mavis Graves** (17), RHP **Alex McFarlane** (18), RHP **Micah Ottenbreit** (28), and OF **Dylan Campbell** (30)...Spikerman is currently on the injured list...In 111 all-time meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 56-55 (.505).

ER in 72.0 IP), 3 saves, 43 walks, and an eye-popping 101 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.10 WHIP for relief arms is the 2nd-lowest at the High-A level and 10th-lowest in Minor League Baseball...Additionally, the Cyclones have accrued a 12.63 strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio, which is the 2nd-best at High-A and 6th-best in MiLB...Chicago-NL's Triple-A Iowa (14.00) holds the best mark...For the season, Brooklyn's bullpen has posted a .153 batting average against, which is tied with Detroit's Double-A Erie for the lowest mark in MiLB...The Cyclones also maintain an impressive 34.95% strikeout rate.

REMEMBER ME?: Jersey Shore and Brooklyn each have players who participate in contests for the other team in 2024...OF **Troy Schreffler Jr.** spent parts of the 2023 and the entire 2024 season with the BlueClaws...In 101 games for Jersey Shore over 2 seasons, the Harrisburg, Pa. native hit .221/.310/.372/.682 with 8 home runs, 45 RBI, and 32 stolen bases...Schreffler Jr. is currently on the Cyclones' Development List...RHP **Josh Hejka** was a member of Brooklyn in 4 different campaigns (2019; 2021-22; 2024)...The 28-year-old holds the record for most pitching appearances (63) in Cyclones history...In those contests, Hejka went 6-3 with a 2.41 ERA (28 ER in 104.2 IP), 8 saves, 25 walks, and 95 strikeouts...Both Schreffler Jr. and Hejka were acquired by the New York Mets and Philadelphia Phillies, respectively, via trade during Spring Training.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: Despite the loss last Wednesday, Cyclones' pitching dominated...After 4-straight runners reached base in the bottom of the 1st, Brooklyn pitching combined to retire 23 of the final 24 batters in order, allowing just one infield hit in the 3rd inning...14 of those 24 outs were recorded via strikeouts...RHP **Noah Hall** sat down 14 of the last 15 batters he faced, striking out 7 over 5.0 innings in the 2-1 defeat...The 23-year-old created a team-high 11 swings-and-misses...LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Ryan Lambert**, and RHP **Alfred Vega** united to sit down the last 9 hitters of the game in a row, 7 of which struck out...Lambert whiffed 4 of the 5 batters he faced, inducing 8 whiffs.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT: In a lopsided victory over Wilmington on April 5, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones' offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win...Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2025, 3 alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager **Gilbert Gómez** embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33-year-old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since **Edgardo Alfonzo** (2017-2019)...Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls...Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League...The Dominican native will serve as **Albert Pujols'** assistant manager for Team Dominican Republic in the upcoming 2026 World Baseball Classic.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 8 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), INF **Jesús Báez** (8), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (13), INF **Boston Baro** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (21), C **Chris Suero** (22), OF **Eli Serrano III** (23) and C **Ronald Hernández** (27)...Of those 8, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 6 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Suero (20), and Reimer (21).

LAST TIME OUT: Díaz extended his scoreless inning streak to 11.2 innings with a 3.2 spotless frames of relief last Thursday night at Aberdeen...Entered in support of RHP **Brendan Girtton** with runners at 1st and 2nd and 1 out in the bottom of the 4th and Brooklyn trailing 3-1...Neither inherited runner scored...Allowed just 1 of 12 batters faced to reach base...Did not allow a run or a hit, walking 1 and striking out 4...Charged with one wild pitch...Threw 46 pitches and 31 strikes (67.39%)...Relieved by RHP **Dylan Ross** to start the bottom of the 8th and the Cyclones behind 3-2...Brooklyn rallied for 5 runs in the top of the 9th, taking the lead of good on a 2-run double by C **Chris Suero**, to defeat the IronBirds, 7-3.

DIALED IN DÍAZ: The 21-year-old has been essentially spotless during the start of his 2025 campaign, as both a starter and reliever...All told, Díaz has yet to allow a run through 3 outings (1 start)...If he had enough innings to qualify, the righty would be tied atop the South Atlantic League with a 0.00 ERA, along with Brooklyn teammate RHP **Zach Thornton** and Aberdeen's RHP **Braxton Bragg**...Díaz and Thornton are the only 2 pitchers in the SAL to toss 10.0-plus innings without allowing a run...Among arms with 10.0 or more innings, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native is 5th in opponent OPS (.395) and 7th in WHIP (0.77) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.50).

2024: Split the season between the Florida Complex League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie...Started the season on St. Lucie's 7-day injured list...Joined the FCL Mets on a minor league rehab assignment on 5/4...Tossed 2.0 innings of 2-hit shutout ball in his first rehab start vs. the FCL Cardinals on 5/4 (2.0 IP, 2 H, 2 K)...Was his first outing in 603 days...Allowed only 1 unearned run on 6 hits over 6.2 innings in the FCL...Did not issue a walk and struck out 9...Reinstated by St. Lucie on 5/21...Allowed 1 unearned run in his first start back with St. Lucie, taking a no-decision on 5/23 vs. Clearwater (2.2 IP, H, R, BB, 2 K)...Tossed 4.0 hitless innings and faced one over the minimum in a no-decision on 6/5 vs. Daytona (4.0 IP, BB, 5 K)...Suffered the loss, but struck out a season-high 7 batters over 5.0 innings on 7/13 vs. Lakeland (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 7 K)...Earned the win after allowing 2 runs over 7.0 quality innings on 8/2 at Fort Myers (7.0 IP, 8 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 K)...In 17 appearances (14 starts) for the Mets, Díaz posted a 2-6 mark with a 4.92 ERA (37 ER in 74.1 IP), 75 hits, 28 walks, and 71 strikeouts.

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently on any Top 30 lists, Díaz entered the 2024 campaign as the New York Mets' No. 31 prospect per *Baseball America*...The 21-year-old was considered New York's No. 14 farmhand prior to 2023 and No. 9 by the same publication before 2022...Díaz was deemed the Mets' No. 12 prospect entering 2023 by MLB Pipeline and No. 10 in 2022.

ON THE MEND: Díaz is in his second season back on the bump after missing the entire 2023 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery...Since returning from injury, the Dominican native has accrued a 2-6 record with a 3.87 ERA (37 ER in 86.0 IP), 82 hits allowed, 30 walks, and 84 strikeouts...Díaz holds a 22.5% strikeout rate and an 8.0% walk rate in that span.

UNTOUCHABLE: The right-hander burst on the scene as a prospect in his first professional season in 2021...Díaz made 15 starts with the Mets' two Dominican Summer League squads...Despite holding an 0-2 record, the then 17-year-old mustered a microscopic 0.54 ERA (3 ER in 50.1 IP), allowing only 29 hits and 9 walks, while striking out 63...During the 2021 season, Díaz was the only qualified pitcher in Minor League Baseball to register a sub-1.00 ERA...Since 2021, only 3 pitchers who have worked 50.0+ innings in a campaign have registered an ERA under

1.00, however, Díaz's 0.54 mark is still the lowest...RHP **Craig Yoho** (0.94) with High-A Wisconsin, Double-A Biloxi, and Triple-A Nashville and RHP **Nico Zeglin** (0.95) with Single-A Myrtle Beach and High-A South Bend both accomplished the feat in 2024.
