PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 30 games over .500 with an overall 74-44 record (.627 winning percentage).

- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .627 winning percentage overall this year is the BEST in the Minors ... the next-best team in Minor League Baseball is the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (74-45 / .622), Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- 74 wins are tied for the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, tied with Sugar Land and one of four Minor League teams with 70 wins.
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 92 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season ... over 54 seasons of Triple-A Omaha baseball, there have been seven 80-win seasons, most recently the 2012 (83 wins) and 2015 (80 wins) Storm Chasers.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

72 of Omaha's 118 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (61%), including 28 of 44 losses in 2024, with 15 of 44 losses by just one run (32%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 13 of its last 26 save opportunities, since June 5 (50%).
- Omaha is 23-15 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as the 4th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron lead MiLB with 25 1-run wins.
- Omaha's 33 saves are tied for the most in the league, tied 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and tied 8th in the Minors ... **Evan Sisk** has recorded the team's last 7 saves.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 649 to 520 this season, a +129 run differential.

- A +129 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level as well, ahead of Tacoma (+105).
- Omaha is 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers and Midland RockHounds lead the Minors in run differential at +143.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 40 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (54%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for 3 innings or more in 16 of the 40 comeback wins.
- The Storm Chasers have 6 wins where the club had to overcome multiple deficits.
- Omaha has 11 victories in games where the Chasers trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 11 occasions.

KICKSTART MY GAME

Storm Chaser starting pitchers have been some of the best in Triple-A in August.

- Omaha's starters have combined for a 2.12 ERA (17 ER in 72.1 IP) over 14 games this month, best in Triple-A this month ... a 0.98 WHIP is also the best in Triple-A.
- Omaha has a quality start in 6 of 14 games this month, with 2 each from **Daniel Lynch IV** and **Noah Cameron** ... 10 of 14 August starts have been at least 5.0 innings.
- 72.1 innings this month from Omaha's starters rank as the 5th-most in Minor League Baseball ... in the 2nd half, 27 of Omaha's 43 starts have been at least 5.0 innings.

BACK IN BUFFALO

This week, the Omaha Storm Chasers travel to Sahlen Field in Buffalo, New York to play the Buffalo Bisons, the first meeting between the clubs since 1997.

- Omaha and Buffalo previously played in the Triple-A American Association together from 1985 until 1997 ... in 1998, Omaha moved to the Pacific Coast League and Buffalo joined the International League, with Omaha joining the IL in 2021.
- In 1997, the Omaha Royals (Kansas City Triple-A) and Buffalo Bisons (Cleveland Triple-A) played 18 games against each other, 9 at Rosenblatt Stadium and 9 at what was then named North AmeriCare Park.

TODAY'S START

- Marsh is making his 5th start with Omaha, his 24th overall start this season and his 25th appearance in 2024... he opened the year as the 5th starter in Kansas City's rotation and made a rehab start with Omaha in May... Alec was optioned to Triple-A July 31, when Lucas Erceg was activated by Kansas City.
Royals manager Matt Quatraro told reporters Marsh will throw 40-60 pitches per outing in Triple-A in order to reduce his workload... he is still going to start, but the plan is to back off his innings a bit so he stays fresh for when needed in the Majors.
Among Kansas City pitchers in 2024, Marsh ranks 5th in strikeouts (93), 5th in starts (19) and 5th in innings pitched (101.1)

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, AUGUST 15 vs. LOUISVILLE

In his 3rd start back in Triple-A since being optioned, pitched 4.0 scoreless innings as part of a combined shutout of the Bats ... faced the minimum in his start, as a leadoff single in the 1st inning was caught stealing to end the inning, a walk in the 4th inning was erased on a double play to end the frame ... pitched 1-2-3 innings in the 2nd and 3rd, part of a stretch of 9 consecutive hitters retired.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Won the fifth starting pitcher spot in Kansas City's rotation in Spring Training, pitched to a 3.57 ERA (7 ER in 17.2 IP) with 20 strikeouts in 6 Cactus League appearances (2 starts) ... allowed 1 run on 5 hits with 12 strikeouts through his first 4 outings (10.0 IP).
Opened the season with the on April 2 at Camden Yards against the Orioles and threw 7.0 innings of 1-run ball, the first time in his professional career working through 7.0 innings ... worked through 7.0 innings two more times - once in May, once in June.
Missed 14 games from April 25-May 9 due to a right elbow contusion suffered on a comeback that occurred during his start on April 24 vs. Toronto ... made a rehab start for Omaha on 5/5 @ Iowa and threw 4.0 scoreless innings with 6 strikeouts.
Got off to hot start, going 4-1 with a 2.72 ERA and .211/.269/.335 opponents' slashline through his 1st 8 starts (April 2-May 21), however, over his last 11 games (10 starts) since May 27, he went 3-6 with a 6.17 ERA and opponents' slashline of .274/.340/.484.

CAREER NOTES
