NOTES AND NUGGETS

BAM BAM CAM

Shortstop **Cam Devanney** won Thursday's game with a walk-off two-run homer, his league-leading 4th home run of the year.

Devanney is the Minor League leader in home runs (4) ... he is tied for the International League lead in total bases (22) and extra-base hits (5).

Among qualified hitters, Devanney leads the league in slugging percentage (1.100) and OPS (1.642), while ranking 3rd in batting average (.450) and 4th in on-base percentage (.542).

Cam's walk-off homer Thursday was the 32nd in the Modern Omaha era (since 2005) ... it was the Storm Chasers' 3rd walk-off win over Louisville (since 2021).

RAVING ABOUT JOHN

Outfielder **John Rave** has once again thrived hitting out of the leadoff spot for Omaha in 2025.

Rave is the Minor League leader in runs scored (10), while tied 4th in steals (4) ... 10 runs scored becomes more impressive when considering he's reached base 11 times (5 hits and 6 walks) in 29 plate appearances (.407 OBP).

Rave has scored at least one run in every game and twice has scored 3 runs (March 29 @ Iowa and April 2 vs. Louisville).

When leading off innings this season, Rave is 5-for-9 (.556) ... he has led off two games this week with home runs, hitting leadoff homers on Tuesday and Friday.

WALK IT OUT...

Omaha's 37 walks to begin the season rank 2nd in the International League and are 4th in Minor League Baseball.

Infielder **Nick Loftin** has drawn 10 walks, tied for the most in the Minor Leagues ... he's drawn at least one walk in all 6 games, with multiple walks in 3 games.

Last year, just two Omaha hitters drew a walk in 6 or more straight games: **Logan Porter** in 7 straight (May 18 to 31) and **John Rave** (June 29 to July 4).

Loftin's .517 on-base percentage ranks 2nd on Omaha, behind Devanney (.542) ... Nick has reached base multiple times in each of the last 5 games.

RIDING THE CYCLE

Wednesday, Omaha outfielder **Drew Waters** hit for the cycle, the Storm Chasers' first since 2014 and just the fourth cycle in modern Omaha history (since 2005).

Waters legged out an infield single in the 1st inning ... he tripled in a run in the 3rd ... in the 4th, his third at-bat of the day, Waters sped around the bases for an inside-the-park homer, a three-run shot that increased Omaha's lead to 7-2 ... after striking out in the 6th, he had one more chance to finish his cycle in the 8th and connected on an RBI double to complete the cycle.

The last Triple-A Omaha player to hit for the cycle was **Jimmy Paredes**, on May 12, 2014 vs. New Orleans ... he started that game 0-for-2, but hit a grand slam in the 4th inning, tripled in the 6th, doubled in the 7th and singled in the 8th.

Prior to Wednesday, Waters had come one hit shy of the cycle 15 times, including 6 times alone in 2024 ... once he needed a single, 8 times he needed a triple and 6 times he needed the home run ... he had the double in all 15 instances, which wound up being the final hit he needed on Wednesday.

In Waters' cycle, his home run was an inside-the-parker ... the last time that happened in Major League Baseball history was over 80 years ago, on July 3, 1943, by **Leon Culberson** of the Boston Red Sox.

SEASON 56

Omaha began the 56th season in franchise history last week against the I-Cubs at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa ... this is the 14th season in the Storm Chasers era.

Omaha is coming off a 2024 campaign in which they went 89-59 (.601 winning percentage) to finish 1st in the 20-team International League during the regular season, before going on to win the International League Championship Series.

The 2024 Chasers set a franchise wins record for wins in a season, passing the 86-win 1990 Omaha Royals that won the Triple-A Classic (national championship).

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS

Omaha enters 2024 as the defending champions of the International League.

Winners of the 1st half (49-24 record), Omaha hosted the 2nd-half Champion Columbus Clippers (Cleveland Triple-A affiliate) in the International League Championship Series ... after dropping Game 1 to Columbus 3-2, Omaha came back to win Game 2 in 11 innings, 5-4, before winning Game 3 by a score of 7-3.

2024 marked Omaha's 8th league championship as a Triple-A Club, having won 4 American Association titles (1969, 1970, 1978, 1990), 3 Pacific Coast League championships (2011, 2013, 2014) and now an International League title ... Omaha is the first club to win a league championship in 3 different Triple-A leagues.

CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 10 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.

Started Omaha's second game of the season ... worked a 1-2-3 1st inning, but after retiring the first batter of the 2nd, allowed 6 straight to reach, with 2 runs scoring on 3 singles and 3 walks ... pitched a 1-2-3 3rd inning, but could not get an out in the 4th inning, allowed the first 5 to reach, on three singles, a 3-run homer by Reese McGuire and a walk to cap a four-run frame and end his afternoon.
