Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Austin Peterson** to the mound today, looking to run the winning streak to 8G for the first time since 7/31-8/9/22. Omaha will counter with LHP **Ryan Ramsey**. Columbus is 5-13 (.278) versus left handers this year. Ramsey has pitched against Columbus once in his career, on 9/19/25 at Huntington Park (ND, 4.2IP, 6H, 3R, 3ER, 3BB, 3K).

vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus has lost 45 of the last 72 regular season games against Omaha, dating to 5/5/22. Of those 72G, the Clippers are 9-43 (.173, won two straight) when they allow at least four runs to Omaha, while going 18-2 (.900) when they hold the Storm Chasers to three or fewer. Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has played 7G against Omaha in his career, hitting .462 (12x26) with 1HR and 7RBI.

Climbing

Entering today looking up at only four other teams, the Clippers hold their highest ranking in the standings (5th) since ending the day tied for 4th on 4/8 (6th to 13th in between). Unfortunately, Columbus is still 3.0 games out, having spent the last 36G between 3.0 (five times) and 6.0 (twice, last on 5/2). The Clippers are 12-3 (2nd in the IL, Rochester is 13-2) since getting swept in a DH at St. Paul on 5/15.

Domination

In the 7G before Tuesday, the Clippers trailed after only one of 61 innings played (walk-off loss at Toledo on 5/25), while leading after 48 (79%), including 42 of the last 44. They never trailed last night, resulting in 7G in which they never trailed in the last 9G (6G through the first 49G). Falling behind early Tuesday night, the Clippers came back to capture their 20th comeback win of the year (1st in the IL).

Too High

Though **Cooper Ingle** has reached in 10 of his last 31PA, his OBP has dipped to .467 (6th in MiLB among players with at least 150PA). Since going deep in consecutive games at St. Paul on 5/16, Ingle is slashing .288/.397/.615 with 4HR and 15RBI in 13G. He reached 200BB in his career on Friday (17% of PA) and Sunday marked his first ever game played in fair territory (197G at catcher, 66G at DH).

Arias Rehab

Gabriel Arias is joining the Clippers on rehab today, coming back from a strained left hamstring (on the shelf since 4/7, transferred to 60-day on 5/29). Arias hit .200/.250/.433 with 2HR and 4RBI in 10G with Cleveland prior to injury (5x14 in 5G after 1x16 start). All time with Columbus, Arias has played 239G, collecting 33HR and 112RBI (today begins his second career rehab stint, 4G from 7/18-7/24/25).

Brito is Back

Juan Brito has a 6G hit streak going, batting .440 (11x25) over the stretch (hitless in previous 5G from 5/20-5/27, 18AB). Brito has but one double on the hit streak though (just a pair in the last 21G, had eight in first 17G), giving him 57 in his Columbus career (four from the franchise top 25). Batting from the right side this year, he is hitting .342/.405/.737 with all of his homers (4) in 38AB (113AB vs. RHP).

Nayled It

Bo Naylor collected his first homer of the year with Columbus Tuesday night, giving him 29HR and 102RBI in his Clipper career (133G). The Clippers are 7-0 with Naylor in the lineup, averaging 7.0 runs per game (4.2 per in previous 10G). He went hitless last night, but walked twice, scored twice and stole a base (2SB; Clipper catchers have 11SB on the season, led by **Kody Huff's** 6SB).

Start Again

Nolan Jones had his 21G on base streak snapped last night (.370OBP, 5/3-6/2), but saw his OBP drop nine points over the course of the streak, while his average dipped five points (.266, 21x79). The streak was tied for 10th longest in the IL this season. Jones has not homered since 5/1 vs. Toledo (89AB), collecting just 6RBI while posting a .345SLG in 23G (had 23RBI and .495SLG through first 26G).

Back on Track

In the last 20G, the Columbus bullpen has a 3.29ERA (82.0IP, 30ER), 3rd best in the IL (3ER or fewer in 18G until Tuesday night, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL, currently 16th at 5.17; starters have a 5.36ERA, 13th). Relievers allowed 1HR to 182BF from 5/10-5/22, but have given up 5HR to 184BF since.

This Date in Clipper History

6/4/1996

The Clippers beat Scranton/WB by a score of 5-0 thanks to a complete game shutout from **Brian Boehringer**. The UNLV product struck out 10 Red Barons, allowing 5 hits and a walk. He would go on to lead the Clippers in wins (11), ERA (4.00), K (132) and IP (153.0) in 1996, helping the Clippers to their seventh Governors' Cup Championship.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,431 to 1,378).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 81-78 (.509) in pitch reviews, with batters going 44-52 (.458) and pitchers/catchers going 37-26 (.587). They have run out of challenges in 32G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 858, would rank as 3rd most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 86 through the first 58G (on pace for 221SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 19CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 3rd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (49; nabbed 51 times in 2004).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,934RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.27 through the first 58G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 155HR (3rd lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 9th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 31G this season (20-11, .645), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Kody Huff bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 419-431 (.493), 389-385 with Columbus (.503).
