Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third in a six-game series against the Cedar Rapids Kernels, High-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins, the second leg in the Lugnuts' 12-game, 14-day road trip to the Hawkeye State. The Nuts split a six-game series at Quad Cities to open the road trip, winning the last two games over the weekend before dropping a slugfest last night in the opener. Cedar Rapids is 6-2 against the Nuts this year, winning four of six games in Lansing earlier this season.

Yesterday: Kernels 5, Lugnuts 3. Center fielder Emmanuel Rodriguez homered twice, including going back-to-back in the fifth inning with Kala'l Rosario to wipe out a 3-0 deficit, and Cedar Rapids scored five unanswered runs to capture the Wednesday matinee. The Lugnuts' record on Wednesdays fell to 3-14 in the defeat despite a home run for a second consecutive day from Junior Pérez.

On the Air: Calvin Christoforo calls the action on Bally Live and MiLB TV, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler delivering an audio-only call via StreamGuys.

On Deck: The Nuts wrap things up with the Kernels on Sunday before returning to Jackson Field for a two-week homestand against the Fort Wayne TinCaps and the Great Lakes Loons, running from August 8-20 at Jackson Field.

Congratulations! 1B/OF Danny Bautista, Jr., who enters today on a 14-game on-base streak, was honored as the Midwest League's Player of the Week for the week of July 25-30, collecting 11 hits in 24 at-bats (.458 avg.) with three doubles, one home run and four RBIs in six games. Bautista, Jr. increased the level of his performance as the week went on, collecting a single in each of the first two games, a single and a double in each of the next three games, and finishing with two singles and a two-run homer on Sunday. His closest competition for the weekly honor was teammate Colby Thomas, who slashed .462/.481/.654 with 12 hits in 26 at-bats, two doubles, one triple, one walk and one stolen base. The two Lugnuts topped all Midwest Leaguers in batting average for the week.

Welcome Aboard: SS Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall selection in the 2023 draft from Grand Canyon University, debuted Tuesday with a double, an HBP and a walk in his first three Midwest League plate appearances. The 21-year-old Wilson had played three games in the Arizona Complex League to open his professional career, going 5-for-11 with two doubles and an HBP. A three-year All-WAC 1st Team honoree, Wilson was named the Western Athletic Conference's 2023 Defensive Player of the Year while hitting .411 with only five strikeouts in 49 games. His father, Jack, played in the Major Leagues from 2001-2012 and coached him at Thousand Oaks High School and GCU.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: Jordan Carr recorded the save in yesterday's Kernels win, following a familiar pattern: 17 of the last 19 games that the Lugnuts have played have featured a save. By month: 7 saves in 20 games in April (35%), 9 in 27 in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and now two in two games in August.

Turnaround: Outfielder Junior Pérez opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .264 (61-for-231). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS: August - 3-for-7, two home runs, two walks, .429/.556/1,286. He has reached base 16 times in the last six games thanks to 10 hits and six walks.

What a Month: Lansing finished July with a 3.65 ERA, best in the Midwest League. Meanwhile the Nuts' offense batted .276 as a team in July, the 2nd highest average in the league this month, led by Daniel Susac (.360) and Danny Bautista, Jr. (.354). After only four double-digit hit games apiece in April and May and eight double-digit hit games in June, the Lugnuts collected at least 10 hits in 11 games in July.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections, though catcher Daniel Susac, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, was placed on the Injured List on Wednesday. A day prior, shortstop Jacob Wilson, the sixth overall pick in 2023, joined the Lugnuts. Wilson's high school teammate, 2021 first-rounder Max Muncy, played for the Nuts earlier this season and is now in Double-A Midland.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Casey Lawrence pitched a nine-inning complete game, and the host Lugnuts beat South Bend, 6-1. Lawrence allowed four hits, one run, no walks and three strikeouts. The game took two hours and 13 minutes. Groundout:flyout ratio for Casey: 20 groundouts to one flyout.

2022: For the second straight game, Denzel Clarke hit an inside-the-park home run, blasting an RJ Petit pitch off the right-center fence at Jackson Field and scoring standing up when the ball bounced past center field Ben Malgeri. In the process, he became the first Lugnut since Tim Locastro in 2015 with two inside-the-park home runs in the same year and the second MiLB player ever, joining Everett's Fred Bello (July 2-3, 2010), to have inside-the-park homers in two straight games. The feat has never occurred in the Maiors. The Lugnuts went on to win the game. 8-1.

In a Nutshell: Jack was originally drafted in the 21st round in 2019 by St. Louis, but turned down the Cardinals' offer in order to return to Auburn... signed as an undrafted free agent with the Athletics following the 2021 draft... made pro debut in 2021 with Lugnuts, piggybacking with Kyle Virbitsky, who was traded with Cole Irvin to Baltimore this past offseason for Darell Hernaiz (Double-A shortstop)... big dog person, with an Australian shepherd back home in California and both a goldendoodle and a labradoodle with his girlfriend in Alabama... making first start of the season today, becoming the ninth different Lansing pitcher to start a game.

Glory Days: Attended JSerra Catholic High School in San Juan Capistrano, California... named 2015 Perfect Game 16U Pitcher of the Year and 2015 Perfect Game Underclass National Championship Most Valuable Player... 2016 Second Team Lousiville Slugger High School All-American... 2017 West Coast League Pitcher of the Year... 2017 Summer Collegiate Second Team All-American... coming out of high school, was ranked the No. 2 left-handed pitcher in California... others from JSerra include the 1st overall pick of the 2017 draft, Royce Lewis and Cleveland catcher Austin Hedges

War Eagle: Used as a freshman at Auburn to pitch in midweek games, rising to receive the honor of starting SEC Tournament opener vs. Kentucky... fellow members of that 2018 Tigers rotation: Casey Mize and Tanner Burns.... excelled as a sophomore, leading the Tigers with a 2.75 ERA and bringing them to the College World Series, starting the opening game against Mississippi State (5 innings, 1 run)... entered senior year as one of eight SEC pitchers with a sub-4.00 ERA in 100+ innings, but did not pitch in non-conference action due to injury (dislocated thumb) and finished with a 5.47 ERA in 11 games, 9 starts... led Auburn as a senior in strikeouts (46) and innings (51)... in all, appeared in 43 games for Tigers (30 starts): 11-10, 4.26 ERA, 175 1/3 innings, 165 strikeouts... named to Spring SEC Academic Honor Roll, 2019-2021.

Home Cooking: Hometown of Aliso Viejo is located in southern Orange County in southern California... "Aliso Viejo" means Old Sycamore (or Old Alder) in Spanish (there is a sycamore located near Aliso Creek that is over 400 years old)... city motto: "Live Life Inspired"... only officially became a city on March 6, 2001.

Honored: Named the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week after tossing six nearly perfect innings vs. the Great Lakes Loons, July 8, 2022... set down first 14 batters, striking out seven, before Jose Ramos singled up the middle with two outs in the 5th... retired next four batters in order... 69 pitches, 49 strikes; 5 groundouts, 5 flyouts... Kumar Nambiar pitched the 7th and 8th innings, allowing one hit, and Trayson Kubo struck out the side in a perfect 9th to preserve a 1-0 win in two hours and three minutes... game's only run supplied by a Tyler Soderstrom RBI double in the 3rd inning.

Beat the Rain: The Nuts and Whitecaps played a brisk game on August 7, 2022, with Lazaro Armenteros delivering a two-run homer and Owen firing five innings, allowing one unearned run (scored in the fifth inning on a fielding error by third baseman Alexander Campos, now with Single-A Stockton), to earn the victory... the rain arrived right after Brayan Buelvas homered one batter into the bottom of the fifth inning... the game was called at a duration of 67 minutes, giving Owen a five-inning complete game.
