### SLOW NIGHT FOR THE OFFENSE

The Baseball Club took home a 7-1 win yesterday over the Express in game four of the series. Oklahoma City jumped out to an early 3-0 lead with three solo home runs through the first two innings. CF Andy Pages went yard in the first before DH Ryan Ward and 1B Kevin Padlo launched back-to-back dingers for the Baseball Club in the second. Round Rock got on the board in the fourth frame when 1B Dustin Harris hit a leadoff single, moved to second base on a passed ball, found third as RF Trevor Hauver grounded out and scored on a balk from Oklahoma City RHP Nabil Crismatt. The visitors extended their lead to 6-1 thanks to a three-run eighth inning. After a leadoff single from RF Drew Avans, Pages and 3B Trey Sweeney worked back-to-back walks to load the bases. Avans scored thanks to a sacrifice fly from LF Miguel Vargas and a double off the bat of Ward sent Pages and Sweeney home. Oklahoma City tacked on one final run in the top of the ninth as SS Jonathan Araúz doubled then scored on a single from Pages. Round Rock got two runners on base in the bottom of the inning but the 7-1 scored stood final.

### SAMPSON TAKES THE HILL

Round Rock RHP Adrian Sampson will get the baseball on Saturday night. Sampson is scheduled to make his third start of the season. After earning the win in his first start of the year on March 31 following 5.0 innings and only two earned runs against Sugar Land, Sampson went 4.0 innings and allowed three earned runs last Sunday in El Paso.

### TWO MORE FOR DUSTIN

Express 1B Dustin Harris went 2-for-4 on Friday night with a run scored and a strikeout. The lefty has posted a multi-hit game in four of his last five contests. He is 9-for-20 in his last five games with one double, one home run, three runs scored, one RBI and three strikeouts. Harris leads the team in stolen bases and is tied for the team lead in home runs (3). He is second in hits (14).

### LOOK AT LEITER

Express RHP Jack Leiter went 6.0 innings and allowed three earned runs yesterday while earning the loss. He struck out 10 which is tied for the most strikeouts he has had in a game for his professional career. Leiter leads all pitchers in the minors with 25 strikeouts to start the year. Only four pitchers in the Major Leagues have more strikeouts than him this season.

### OFFENSE STALLS

In the last two games, the Express offense has scored only three runs and collected a total of 13 hits. Of the 13 hits, 11 have been singles and two have been doubles. Between the two games, the E-Train are 1-for-15 with runners in scoring position.

### ROSTER MOVES

Express RHP Austin Pruitt joined the Texas Rangers today and will seek his first Major League action of the season. Round Rock RHP Tim Brennan and LHP Antoine Kelly both went on the 7-Day Injured List retroactive to April 12. The E-Train added LHP Grant Wolfram from Double-A Frisco. Wolfram appeared in 11 games for Round Rock last year.

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

**EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS**

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
