FOR STARTERS: This evening is game four of a six-game series as the Rocket City Trash Pandas continue their second homestand of 2026—and their first six-game set against the Chicago White Sox affiliate, the Birmingham Barons. It's also the first of five matchups between the in-state rivals this season.

FIRST INNING DOOMS PANDAS: For the second time in three games, a Trash Pandas starter couldn't get through the first inning with the Barons jumping out to a 4-0 lead in the first frame, and went on for the 7-4 victory on Thursday night at Toyota Field.

GOBBEL GOING OFF: Ben Gobbel homered for the second-straight game on Thursday, and is 6-for-13 this week with two homers, a double, and six RBIs ... Gobbel homered in back-to-back games on 7/6/25 at Knoxville and 7/8 at Chattanooga, the latter featuring his second career multi-homer game.

RUN SCORERS: Gustavo Campero has played in just eight of 12 games, but leads the Southern League with 15 runs scored, five more than the next closest ... Campero has reached in eight-straight games The 2024 Southern League Postseason All-Star is joined by teammate Mac McCroskey as the only two Southern League players to score a run in seven-straight games.

PANDAS' SCORING: The Pandas lead the league, and rank T-4th in Double-A with 83 runs scored (6.9 per game) in 12 games. Have scored 4+ runs in 11 of 12 games. The 2023 club featuring Zach Neto, Nolan Schanuel, Jeremiah Jackson, Kyren Paris, etc had 78 runs through the first 12 games.

SCORING IS UP IN THE SL: Through the first 12 games this season, Southern League teams are averaging 5.5 runs per game, over a run higher than last season through 12 games at 4.2 in 2025 ... In fact, it's the most runs per game in the digital era of th league in 2005 ... One of the primary reasons is in 2026, the walk rate is 14.1% per plate appearance, by far the highest since 2005 ... The 103 home runs is second through 12 games to only the 104 hit du in 2021.

LUGO AND MECKLER: Outfielders Matthew Lugo, and Wade Meckler leads the league in batting at .429 with two doubles, two homers, two RBI, four walks, four steals, and seven runs scored, hitting in all seven of his games ... Lugo is 4th in the league, batting .345 with two doubles, seven RBI, 11 walks, and six runs.

AGAINST THE BARONS: The Trash Pandas are 72-68 overall against the Birmingham Barons, 34-34 at Toyota Field, and 38-34 at Regions Field. Last season, Rocket City was 8-16 against the White Sox affiliate, and 3-9 at Toyota Field. The clubs will meet 27 times this season, with Birmingham visiting Toyota Field this week, and August 4-9. The Pandas will visit Birmingham, May 12-17, July 17-19, and August 25-30.

INTERIM MANAGER: Ever Magallanes will serve as interim manager of the Trash Pandas this weekend while Joe Krugel is away from the club. Currently staffed at the Spring Training complex in Arizona, Magallanes has a 582-675 managerial record from 2004-2012. Notably, he led the Birmingham Barons to a 92-47 record in 2009, earning Southern League Manager of the Year honors.

ROSTER MOVES: On Thursday, INF Cole Fontenelle was reinstated from the 7-day Injured List, and OF Elijah Dunham was placed on the temporary inactive list. On Friday, RHP Efrain Contreras was transferred to Rocket City from the ACL Angels roster.

MORE LEAGUE LEADERS: Matthew Lugo leads the league in OBP (.512) ... Lugo is 4th in batting (.345), and T-4th in walks (11) ... Nick Rodriguez is T-5th in doubles (3), and T-6th in runs (9) ... Raudi Rodriguez ranks T-10th in RBI (9) ... Ben Gobbel is T-5th in RBIs (11) ... Harold Coll is T-5th in RBIs (11) ... Austin Gordon 2nd in innings pitched (14.0), and starts (3) ... Kenyon Yovan is T-1st in wins (2), and T-2nd in appearances (5) ... Camden Minacci is 1st in appearances (6).

MAC ATTACK: Mac McCroskey has doubled his home run total from a year ago, hitting, with two so far in the first two weeks of the season. McCroskey has reached base safely, and scored a run in each of his seven games

GORDON GETTING IN DONE: Starter Austin Gordon became the first Trash Panda starter to win a game on 4/15 vs. Chattanooga. The Opening Night starter. He is 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA over three starts, and 14.0 innings pitched, 10 walks, 10 strikeouts.

12 HOMERS IN 11 GAMES: Rocket City is living up to its name so far with the 12 long balls in 11 games, which is T-9th in Double-A baseball so far.

ON THE MOUND: Through 11 games, Rocket City has a 6.43 ERA, which is 29th out of 30 teams at the Double-A level. Amarillo is 30th with a 7.38 ERA.

MR. PANDA: OF Tucker Flint and David Calabrese are second and third in club history in games played for the Rocket City Trash Pandas.

WELCOME BACK CAMPERO: C Gustavo Campero had a breakout 2024 season in Rocket City—where he was named the team's Hitter of the Year and a Southern League All-Star after batting .279 with 14 home runs and 29 stolen bases—he quickly climbed the ladder to Triple-A and the Majors. He made his MLB debut in September 2024, recording his first hit and home run, and went on to appear in

2026 GAME INFORMATION

28 games with the Angels in 2025 while also hitting .322 in Triple-A.

OPENING SERIES WIN: The series win over Biloxi (L 7-6 on Fri., W 9-4 on Sat., W 9-8 on Sun) marked Rocket City's second to start a season (swept Birmingham at Regions Field, 4/8-4/10-22). The 9-8 victory on Sunday also marked the club's second-ever Easter win (2-0), with the previous coming in a 1-0, 11-inning victory over Pensacola on April 17, 2022.

HISTORIC OPENING WEEKEND: In front of a Southern League-most 14,087 fans at Toyota Field, Rocket City took two of three from the Biloxi Shuckers behind 24 runs in the three games.

LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: RHP **George Klassen**, 24, made his Major League debut with the Los Angeles Angels on Sunday against Seattle at Angel Stadium, becoming the 48th former Trash Panda to reach the Majors, and second so far in 2026. A native of West Bend, Indiana, Klassen worked 2.2 innings, allowing two runs while striking out four, and the Angels went on to win the game 8-7 in 11 innings. Ranked as the Angels' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline, Klassen was a key member of Rocket City's 2025 rotation, earning a Futures Game selection and ranking among the franchise leaders in starts during his first full Double-A season. **Walbert Ureña** became the 47th player in franchise history to make his Major League debut, doing so during the Los Angeles Angels' Opening Day win over the Houston Astros on March 26.

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE: C **Gustavo Campero** (41 games, LAA), RHP **Aneurys Zabala** (2 games, MIA), OF **Matthew Lugo** (31 games, LAA), and OF **Wade Meckler** (20 games, SF) all carry MLB experience on the roster.

MAKING THE JUMP FROM LOW-A: INF **Harold Coll**, INF **Nick Rodriguez**, and OF **Raudi Rodriguez** are all making the jump from Low-A to Double-A, bypassing High-A Tri-City altogether.

2026 SCHEDULE: The complete 138-game schedule will run from April 3 to Sunday, September 13 ... The first half of the season will conclude with a six-game series against Montgomery at Toyota Field from June 16-21. The regular season will wrap up with another six-game series at Chattanooga, scheduled for September 8-13. The final home series at Toyota Field will take place from September 1-6 against Montgomery.

GLOBAL BASEBALL SERIES: The Trash Pandas wrapped up their final tune-up before Opening Night with a 6-3 win over Japan's Toyota Red Cruisers on April 1 at Toyota Field. Tucker Flint led the way offensively, homering twice and reaching base four times. The victory capped the three-game Global Baseball Series in front of a crowd of 4,355. The Red Cruisers opened the series with a win over Alabama A&M on Monday, while the Trash Pandas topped UAH on Tuesday before Wednesday's finale.

2025 SEASON IN REVIEW: The Trash Pandas, managed by **Andy Schatzley** concluded their fifth season with a 45-92 record, finishing fourth in the Southern League's North Division, 35.5 games behind the champion Birmingham Barons. Rocket City went 24-45 at Toyota Field and 21-47 on the road, being outscored 637-445 for a -192 run differential. In the first half, the Trash Pandas posted a 24-44 record, placing fourth, 15 games back of the Chattanooga Lookouts. The team went 13-26 at home and 11-19 on the road, ending the half on a nine-game losing streak, including a seven-game sweep by Chattanooga, a new club record. Rocket City scored 219 runs while allowing 310. The second half saw the team finish 21-48, again fourth in the division and 22 games behind Birmingham. The Trash Pandas went 11-19 at home and 10-29 on the road, scoring 226 runs while surrendering 327.

NEW COACHING STAFF: **Joe Kruzel** was named manager of the Rocket City Trash Pandas prior to the 2026 season, becoming the third manager in franchise history following **Jay Bell** (2021) and **Andy Schatzley** (2022-25). Kruzel enters the role with more than 30 years of coaching experience at the professional and collegiate levels. The 2026 season marks his first year managing in the Angels' system after serving four seasons in a developmental leadership role. His all-time managerial record is 473-472. Joining Kruzel in Madison this season are **Daren Brown** (Coach),

Tim Leveque (Pitching Coach), **Doug Henry** (Assistant Pitching Coach), **Tony Jaramillo** (Hitting Coach), **Dylan Cutwell** (Athletic Trainer), **Chase Galloway** (Assistant Athletic Trainer), **Matt Gabriel** (Strength and Conditioning Coach), **Tristan Sagtime** (Game Planning Strategist), and **Joe Wike** (Video Assistant).

PANDAS ROSTER: The Trash Pandas Opening Day roster featured 17 returners from the 2025 season.

ANGELS PROSPECTS: The veteran team has three players among the Angels' top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: OF **Raudi Rodriguez** (No. 15), RHP **Joel Hurtado** (No. 22), and RHP **Austin Gordon** (No. 26).

Raudi impressed in 2026 Spring Training, batting .350 with an .835 OPS as a non-roster invitee. Last season, he dominated Low-A Inland Empire in 2025, hitting .281 with 49 extra-base hits and an .842 OPS across 125 games, earning multiple honors in 2025, including five Player of the Week awards, two Player of the Month selections, and the Angels Kenny Myers Memorial LAA Minor League Player of the Year. He also starred in the Arizona Fall League, batting .433 and earning AFL All-Star and Fall Stars Game MVP honors.

Hurtado pitched the majority of 2025 with Rocket City, going 5-6 with a 2.70 ERA (86.2 IP - 26 ER) and 56 strikeouts in 18 games (all starts). He led the staff in the first two months, recording five quality starts and 54.2 innings pitched. Before being shut down for load management in June, he ranked among the league leaders in starts, innings pitched, wins, ERA, WHIP, and groundouts.

In Gordon's first pro season in 2025 with Tri-City, he was 4-5 with a 5.44 ERA over 84.1 innings pitched, 27 walks, and 95 strikeouts.

Elijah Dunham (NYY), **Jose Gonzalez** (TEX), **Eybersson Polanco** (Rule 5, BOS), **Aneurys Zabala** (Japan), and **JJ D'Orazio** (ARI) are all making their Angels organizational debut this weekend. Nick Rodriguez becomes the first 2025 draft selection to reach the Double-A level.

SPORTS CENTER? MORE LIKE PANDA CENTER: The Trash Pandas grabbed national attention in 2025 with four highlights on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 and one on the "Not Top 10," putting Rocket City in front of millions of viewers. Joe Redfield's leaping catch over the berm railing at Toyota Field landed at No. 6 on May 15, while intern Cason Clarke's tarp slip and barrel roll five days later earned a Not Top 10 nod. The team closed the season with three more Top 10 plays in the second-to-last week: Mac McCroskey's sliding stop at No. 8 on August 31, and Ben Gobbel earning back-to-back spots with a barehanded play (No. 9, Sept. 2) and diving snag (No. 7, Sept. 5). In total, Rocket City delivered four Top 10 moments—and one unforgettable blooper—that reached ESPN's massive national audience.

BUILDING THE BRAND: From January through August 2025, the Trash Pandas generated 41.3 million social media impressions—an average of 5.2 million per month—ranking second among all Double-A clubs and ninth across Minor League Baseball. The team's combined audience on Facebook, Instagram, Tik Tok, and X grew by 10% this year to 356,000 followers. Since debuting in 2021, the Trash Pandas have surpassed 200 million total impressions, establishing themselves as one of the most consistently engaging brands in MiLB. In addition, The Trash Pandas hit the West Coast in 2025 with four games (July 31 vs. Birmingham, August 14 vs. Knoxville, August 28 vs. Columbus, and September 10 vs. Chattanooga) televised and streamed live on FanDuel Sports Network West during the second half of the 2025 season.
