MARSEE'S THREE HITS NOT ENOUGH IN 5-3 LOSS

Jakob Marsee finished a triple shy of the cycle and Maximo Acosta homered on Saturday, but the Stripers rallied to a 5-3 win over the Jumbo Shrimp. Marsee went deep in the first and Acosta did the same in the second for Jacksonville to go up 2-0. A David Fletcher third-inning homer halved the lead. Marsee whacked an RBI double in the fifth, but Fletcher notched an RBI single to make it 3-2. In the sixth, Jason Delay's two-run single put Gwinnett ahead. The Stripers added a run in the seventh to set the final margin at 5-3.

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS AGO

Heading into play on Sunday, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 23 of their last 31 games (74.2 percent), including 19 contests with five tallies or more. Prior to this stretch, Jacksonville had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent). Perhaps the biggest reason for the increase in runs scored has been home runs; the Jumbo Shrimp rank second in Triple-A with 49 home runs over the last 31 games. They swatted just 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, Jakob Marsee was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 24 of his 31 starts, including 12 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 40-for-118 (.339/.428/.686/1.114 at the plate with seven doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 23 RBIs, 19 walks and 22 runs. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (42) and walks (60) while sharing the league lead in triples (5). He also ranks tied for 17th in homers (13), tied for 21st in runs (48), 22nd in OBP (.378) and tied for 20th in hits (78).

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 30 games on the season. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 46 games, Berry has drawn more walks (23) than strikeouts (22) while going 42-for-140 (.300/.407/.479/.886) at the plate with 11 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 22 RBIs and 24 runs.

AND SHE THINKS WE'RE JUST FISHIN'

Jacksonville is now 11-3 against Gwinnett this season, meaning 19.3 percent of their wins have come at the hands of the Stripers. The Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their fishy foe by an extraordinary 54-28 margin, an average of 3.9-2.0 per game, while outhitting the Stripers 100-78 and outstealing them 34-6. Meanwhile, Jacksonville pitching has held Gwinnett to a .188/.257/.291/.548 batting line through these 14 games - the Stripers have been shut out four times and scored more than three runs in a game against the Jumbo Shrimp just three times thus far in 2025.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 94 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already used 26 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 368.1 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.66 starters' ERA ranks second at the level.

MACKTION

In 30 games from May 10-June 21, Joe Mack went just 18-for-113 (.159) at the plate, totaling just a .428 OPS. The East Amherst, N.Y., native has been on an absolute tear over his last 16 games, however. During this stretch, Mack is a whopping 24-for-63 (.381/.409/.762/1.171) with six doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, three walks and 13 runs.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's bullpen ERA of 3.77 is the best such mark in Triple-A, despite the club working 451.0 innings, the fourth-most at the level... The Jumbo Shrimp have committed just three errors in their last nine games, tied for the third-fewest in Triple-A. Their 78 errors in the first 85 games of the season were the second-most in Triple-A... At 57-37 (.606), Jacksonville is off to its best start since the 2007 Jacksonville Suns started the campaign 58-36 (.617)... The Jumbo Shrimp have gone three series in a row without a set win. If they fail to win Sunday's rubber match, it'd be the club's longest drought without a series win since going eight sets in a row without a series win from May 9-July 3, 2023.

ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 145 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

2025 SEASON

-Snelling was promoted to Jacksonville on July 9 from Double-A Pensacola.

-At the time of his promotion, Snelling ranked tied for fourth in the Southern League in strikeouts (85), seventh in WHIP (1.22), 11th in ERA (3.61), 13th in batting average against (.238), tied for 13th in games started (14) and 14th in innings pitched (72.1).

-With Pensacola, opposing right-handed hitters batted just .202/.251/.301/.552 in 195 plate appearances. In comparison, left-handed batters hit .309/.387/.436/.823 against him in 104 plate appearances.

2024 SEASON

-Snelling was transferred to Jacksonville on September 20 from Double-A Pensacola.

With both Double-A San Antonio and Pensacola, held opponents to a .254/.335/.457/.792 batting line in 287 plate appearances. With runners on, that swelled to .322/.376/.503/.879 in 223 plate appearances.

2023 SEASON

Earned Baseball America's Minor League Pitcher of the Year award.

-Between three levels, Snelling went 11-3 this season with a 1.82 ERA. He struck out 118 and walked 34 in 103.2 innings. He allowed just four home runs in 22 starts. Since 2000, just seven teenage minor league pitchers have recorded a sub-2.00 ERA in 100 innings or more. Snelling is joined on the list by Cole Hamels (2003), Will Inman (2006), Madison Bumgarner (2008), Michael Pineda (2008), Jose Fernandez (2012) and Andrew Painter (2022). Painter and Snelling were the only two to reach Double-A.
