LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox defeated the Senators in the series opener 5-3 from Prince George's Stadium. Jud Fabian and Dylan Beavers both homered in the first inning. Fabian drove in three RBI on three hits after a pair of RBI singles in the second and fourth innings. Starting right-hander **Peter Van Loon** threw 5.0 shutout innings with six strikeouts to pick up his first win of the season. Logan Rinehart threw two perfect frames and **Houston Roth** collected his first save of the season.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B Samuel Basallo, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is 3rd in the Eastern League in total bases (153) and is tied for 7th in hits (93). On Sunday, Basallo homered for the 15th time this season. The No. 2 O's/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 2nd-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (15) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit homers in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in '18. Basallo will turn 20 years of age next Tuesday.

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

With his 17th homer of the season yesterday, OF **Jud Fabian** stands alone as the Eastern League's leader in home runs after his leadoff solo shot. Amongst Double-A hitters, he is tied for 4th in home runs. The O's No. 8 prospect has 32 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has tallied a hit in 10 of his last 12 games. The Orioles No. 24 prospect had his nine-game hit streak snapped in game one in Sunday's doubleheader. Over his last 10 games, Bencosme is batting .438 (14-for-32) with two doubles, a homer and five RBI. Against Somerset last week, Bencosme went 11-for-19 in the

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers set a new a career-high in home runs last night with his 12th of the season. The 22-year-old has reached base in 70 of 88 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (47) and stolen bases (24), both tied for 5th-most and tied for 4th-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

SECOND HALF SILAS

C Silas Ardoin is batting a team-best .364 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .500 and OPS of .924. The 23-year-old has collected a hit in six straight contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 22 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

FIRST TO 1000

The Baysox pitching staff is the first Eastern League team this season to reach 1,000 strikeouts. Amongst Double-A staffs, Bowie's 1,006 strikeouts is second-most behind Northwest Arkansas. Bowie finished 17th in strikeouts in all of Double-A last

SIZING UP THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators are in last place in the Southwest Division with a record of 12-21. The Double-A affiliate of the Nationals is at the bottom of the league in AVG, OPS and HR but its pitching staff owns the second-best ERA in the circuit. Eight of the Nationals top 30 prospects are on the Senators active roster - OF Daylen Lile (No. 9), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 16), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 19), SS Kevin Made (No. 20), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (No. 25), RHP Andry Lara (No. 26), RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Dustin Saenz makes his second start of the season for the Senators. Saenz started the season on the injured list and made five rehab appearances with the FCL -Nationals and Single-A Fredericksburg before making his Harrisburg season debut on August 1 vs Akron. The southpaw threw two scoreless innings over 33 pitches. Saenz debuted in Harrisburg last season and recorded a 4.44 ERA over 73 innings. In two career starts against the Baysox, Saenz holds a 3.27 ERA in 11 innings pitched.

Ended month of July with a 3.60 ERA, best of season thus far. Named EL Pitcher of Week for 7/9-7/14 for first time in career after dealing 6.0 shutout IP with 6 K on 7/11 @ ALT. Retired 17 of final 18 batters faced. First Baysox player to receive weekly award this season. Baysox have won 10 of last 16 games that Pham has started in. Holds a 6.47 ERA in 10 home starts. Holds a 2.37 ERA in four career outings against HBG. Threw first scoreless start of season by matching career-high 6.0 IP and 0 BB over 6 K to record win on 6/11 @ HBG. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. 163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing 7th in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

The- "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión $^{\text{TM}}$ or "Fun Cup $^{\text{TM}}$ During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organizations. All Ribens, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain basebal team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia an New Zealand in 2011.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach
