FRES-NOTES

GRIZZLIES END SERIES IN RANCHO ON A HIGH NOTE: The Fresno Grizzlies (18-24, 56-51) bellowed past the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (26-16, 56-50) 9-2 Sunday evening from LoanMart Field. The Grizzlies offense recorded nine runs on nine hits and three walks. Fresno alternated scoring innings, plating at least one run in the first, third, fifth, seventh and ninth. The Grizzlies also supplied six of their nine runs with two outs in a frame. Fresno's top four of the order scored eight of the nine runs, with the first three batters reaching base two or more times. Robert Caloz and Luis Mendez combined to go 4-for-8 with two homers, six RBI, five runs, one walk and one stolen base. Caloz crushed a two-run clout to left-center field, his first longball with the Grizzlies. The Rockies' #11 overall prospect's bomb left the yard at 109 MPH with a distance of 455 feet. Mendez's late two-run wallop was his fifth of the 2024 campaign. The offensive outpouring was matched by southpaw Albert Pacheco (5-4, win). Pacheco dazzled for six innings, facing one over the minimum. He allowed a first inning solo shot to Zahir Hope, who also drew a walk in the fourth. Hope was the only batter to reach against Pacheco, but was caught on a strike-em-out, throw-em-out at second for a double play. Pacheco punched out seven before exiting to three relievers. Konner Eaton, Hunter Mann and Cade Denton locked down the final three frames.

MODESTO MINI FACTS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Modesto Nuts (Seattle Mariners Single-A affiliate) start a six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the last of five regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the third meeting in Fresno. The Nuts have already clinched a playoff berth by virtue of winning the first half in the California League North Division. In four years, the Grizzlies are 50-47 against the Nuts over their 97 games played (2024 season series tied at 9-9) since the squads became a part of the same league for the first time since 1988. At that time, Modesto was affiliated with the Athletics and were named the A's, while the Grizzlies were known as the Fresno Suns, playing independently. Now, the Nuts are associated with the Seattle Mariners organization (affiliated with the Colorado Rockies prior to Mariners), while the Grizzlies are partnered with the Rockies. The two cities are 96 miles away from one another if you drive by car, following the CA 99 route. Fresno and Modesto are one hour and 32 minutes apart, if you drive non-stop. The halfway point between both cities is Planada, California.

EXPRESS LANE, FIVE RUNS OR LESS: Since July 1 (32 games), the losing team between the Grizzlies and their opponent have scored five runs or less. Since July 30 (11 games), the losing team between the Grizzlies and their opponent have scored three runs or less. In the last seven contests (August 4), the losing team between the Grizzlies and their opponent have scored two or three runs.

PEREZ PITCHES: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Bryan Perez. Perez signed with the Rockies as an International Free Agent on January 15, 2021 out of the Dominican Republic at 16 years old. He was considered the Top Pitching Prospect Signee by the Rockies in that signing period. Perez is the nephew of former MLB All-Star, World Series champion and No-Hitter recipient Edinson Volquez.

THE 2024 DRAFT PICKS HAVE ARRIVED: The Grizzlies have added four 2024 Rockies' Draft Picks to their roster. 2nd-round OF Jared Thomas (Texas), 6th-round LHP Konner Eaton (George Mason), 7th-round RHP Fidel Ulloa (LSU) and 13th-round LHP Justin Loer (LSU).

ANDY IS DANDY: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez ranks among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. Perez ranks first in hits (121), first in total bases (184), tied for first in triples (7), second in extra-base hits (38), third in RBI (63), fourth in batting average (.289), fifth in doubles (22) and 10th in slugging percentage (.440).

ANDY PEREZ CLIMBS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez logged his 14th career triple August 4 vs. Lake Elsinore. He is now tied with Jason Ellison and Clay Timpner for seventh all-time in Grizzlies Career Triples. Up next for Perez is Jalal Leach, who is sixth all-time with 15 triples.

MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ: Andy Perez's triple on August 4 vs. Lake Elsinore was his seventh triple of 2024, putting him into the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Record Books AGAIN. Perez tied himself (2023), Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native became the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice. Up next for Perez are Ben Copeland (2010) and Andrew Stevenson (2019), who are tied for eighth all-time with eight triples.

TEN OUT OF TEN(A) FOR TRIPLES: Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Record Books in Top 10 Single-Season Triples. Tena looks to catch fellow teammate Andy Perez (2023 and 2024), as well as Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot (40 games), he has reached base 71 times in 189 plate appearances (38% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 40 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 35 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-32 (.281) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-40, 43% of the time he reaches base in first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 19 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (33/39 in stolen bases on the season).

RUNNING CLOSER TO THE RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has swiped 33 bases this season. Hobson is currently two stolen bases shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records in that category. Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) are tied for ninth all-time with 35 stolen bases.

- Started 3rd shutout of 2024, tossing a career-high 5.2 innings, allowing 3 hits and 4 walks while fanning 6 4/24 vs San Jose
- On 5/15 at Stockton, was tagged for 4 runs on 5 hits in the 1st, before flipping a switch, tossing 5 innings after that, allowing 3 hits and 1 walk while fanning 9; finished with career-high 6 frames and 12 strikeouts (8 H, 4 R, 1 BB); most punchouts by a Fresno arm in 2024
- Tossed a career-high 7 frames of 1-run ball, striking out 8 5/22 vs Visalia (6 H, 1 BB)
- Over 2 games (May 15-22), had 20 punchouts over 13 innings of work
- Dazzled for a career-high 7 innings of 1-run ball 6/12 vs Rancho Cucamonga, allowed a bunt single to open the game and a Jeral Perez solo blast in the 4th, issued 2 walks and punched out 4; had 2 different stretches where he retired 9 consecutive and 11 straight batters
- Struck out 8 over 5 strong innings 7/2 at Modesto, allowed 2 runs (earned), on 4 hits and 2 walks (6 of his 8 punchouts were looking)
- Punched out MLB rehabber Xander Bogaerts among his 5 strikeouts 7/10 at Lake Elsinore; navigated through 4 innings (4 H, 5 BB, 2 R, 1 ER)
- Chucked 6 innings of 2-run ball (1 earned), permitting 3 hits and 2 walks while punching out 10 7/26 at Stockton; retired 10 straight at one point, which included striking out the side in back-to-back frames (6 in a row)
- Hurlled a quality start 8/1 vs Lake Elsinore, going 6 innings, allowing 2 runs (earned), on a pair of hits and walks while fanning 6; did not allow a hit until the 6th; broke a Grizzlies franchise-record with 4 hit-by-pitches (set in 2000)
- On 8/7 at Rancho Cucamonga, was tagged for 4 runs on 4 hits in the 1st, before settling down, tossing 5 scoreless innings, giving him 6 IP on the night (7 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 5 K)

CAREER NOTES

2024 (pro): Enters 4th professional season with the Colorado Rockies organization...Just 20 years old, has continued to show slight improvement and is receiving more reps on the bump.

2023 (pro): Spent 2nd straight season stateside with the ACL Rockies, making 10 starts...Went 1-0 with a 7.43 ERA over 36.1 innings...Struck out 37 batters...Notched career-highs in almost every pitching category...Had 6 starts where he tossed 4 or more innings and allowed 2 earned runs or less.

2022 (pro): Spent 1st season stateside with the ACL Rockies, appearing in 4 games (3 starts)...Went 1-3 with a 9.00 ERA over 12 innings...Gave up 1 homer among his 15 runs allowed (12 earned)...Gave up 21 hits, walked 2 batters and struck out 9.

2021 (pro): Spent 1st professional season with DSL Colorado, appearing in 11 games (9 starts)...Went 0-1 with a 2.78 ERA over 32.1 innings...Had a 1.57 ERA (28.2 IP, 5 ER) as a starter and had a 12.27 ERA (3.2 IP, 5 ER) as a reliever...Struck out 35 and walked just 10 batters (1.14 WHIP).

Personal: Signed with the Rockies as an International Free Agent on January 15, 2021 out of the Dominican Republic...Was considered the Rockies' top pitching international signing...According to Ben Badler: has both power and feel, throwing plenty of strikes and spinning a curveball with tight rotation that shows plus potential, while his changeup is evolving...Other notable 2021 International Free Agent Signings included Dyan Jorge, Jordy Vargas, Bryan Menz, Rony Cruz and Bryant Betancourt...He is the nephew of former MLB All-Star, World Series champion and No-Hitter recipient Edinson Volquez.
