RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (3-3)

Stockton Ports (4-2)

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Quakes continue their six-game road trip with game four of a six-game series at Banner Is land Ballpark, taking on the Stockton Ports (ATH). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, April 15th, taking on the San Jose Giants in a six-game set.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the fourth of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the fourth of 12 here in Stockton. Last season, the Quakes went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 here in Stockton.

LAST GAME: The Ports took advantage of some wild Rancho arms, downing the Quakes on Thursday night at Banner Island Ballpark by a final of 6-3, Rancho's third straight loss. The Stockton offense finished with five hits, but none of them helped contribute to any of their six runs, as they scored four in the third inning against Rancho starter Hyun-Seok Jang (0-1) without the aid of a hit, then scored twice in the seventh, again without a single hit. Rancho pitching would finish the night with eight walks, two hit batters, while the defense made a costly error. Stockton starter Nathan Dettmer was untouchable, as he struck out 11 batters and gave up just one unearned run on one hit over just four innings of work. Stockton reliever Brayan Restituyo (1-0) got the win with an inning of relief, allowing an unearned run. **ROSTER MOVES:** The Quakes made their first roster move of the year on Thursday, placing INF Nico Perez on the IL, retroactive to April 8. INF Raynerd Ortega filled that spot and debuted on Thursday night, going 0-for-4.

AND THEY WILL RUN AGAIN: The Quakes were 0-for-2 on the bases through the first two games of the Stockton set, but bounced back last night with three steals. The Quakes stole a total of nine bases in Saturday night's game, with Kellon Lindsey, Jose Meza and Joendry Vargas all stealing two each. They followed that up on Sunday with three on Sunday, giving them 14 steals through just three games, this after they swiped just 128 bases in 130 games in 2024. STREAKS SNAPPED: Eduardo Quintero's five-game hitting streak came to an end last night with an 0-for-3 while Elijah Hainline saw his four-game streak end with an 0-for-4. Joendry Vargas had last night off and brings a five-game streak into tonight's action. Vargas is hitting .400 (8-for-20).

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes are excited to welcome back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his second start and his fourth career appearance as a pro, his first against Stockton. In his only start this year, he scattered six hits while striking out a career-high eight over 4.1 innings in a no-decision against Lake Elsinore on April 5. Last season, Foeller got a brief taste of the Cal League, striking out four, without surrendering a hit or run over three scoreless innings for Rancho. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

WEI-EN-LIN: Lefty Wei-En Lin makes his second appearance for Stockton and first against the Quakes. In his pro debut on April 5th, he retired all nine batters he faced, striking out seven over three perfect innings in a no-decision at Fresno. Lin signed with the A's in June of 2024 out of Taiwan and is now in his first pro season.
