**SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

**BEST IN THE ORG:** RHP K.C. Hunt, RHP Craig Yoho and SS Cooper Pratt were all selected for the organization's Robin Yount Performance Awards... Hunt and Yoho were named the organization's Co-Minor League Pitchers of the Year... Pratt was named the organization's Co-Minor League Hitter of the Year alongside SS Jesus Made.

- With the Shuckers, **RHP Craig Yoho** made 18 appearances, held a 1.17 ERA and struck out 46 batters over 23.0 innings... Yoho finished the season among the Double-A leaders (min. 20ip) in strikeout rate (1st, 46.5%), fielding independent pitching (1st, 0.62), groundball rate (6th, 62.2%) and swinging strike rate (11th, 18.6%).
- Across 25 appearances and 14 starts across 3 levels, **RHP K.C. Hunt** finished with a 2.03 ERA, 139 strikeouts and 25 walks over 102.0 innings... Hunt's 139 strikeouts ranked as the second-most in the organization... With the Shuckers, he held a 2.20 ERA across six starts in the regular season with 39 strikeouts in 32.2 innings... In his only playoff appearance, in game two of the Southern League Division Series, Hunt set a career-high with 7.2 innings and allowed one run, the third-longest playoff start in franchise history.
- SS Cooper Pratt** reached Double-A Biloxi for the Southern League Playoffs, going 2-for-8 with home run and 3 RBI in 2 games during the Division Series... In the regular season, Pratt split time between Single-A Carolina and the High-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, putting together a .277/.362/.406 slash line across 96 games... With Wisconsin, Pratt also recorded 5 home runs in 23 games before going 5-for-20 in the postseason during the team's run to the Midwest League Championship Series.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** RHP Blake Holub and 1B Ernesto Martinez Jr. were both named 2024 Southern League All-Stars... It was the 5th time in franchise history (since 2015) that multiple Shuckers were named to the post-season All-Star team... It was the 2nd consecutive season with multiple selections after a franchise-record 4 players were named All-Stars in 2023.

- 1B Ernesto Martinez Jr.** appeared in a team-high 110 games, including 86 starts at first base... He finished the year among the Southern League leaders in doubles (1st, 30), OPS (2nd, .831), extra-base hits (3rd, 45), slugging percentage (3rd, .466), hits (4th, 114), on-base percentage (5th, .365), average (6th, .284), RBI (6th, 62) and strikeout rate (7th, 16.8%)... His 45 extra-base hits ranked as the seventh-most in a single season in franchise history.
- In the second half (starting on June 25), Martinez led the Southern League in average (.346, 65-for-188), doubles (15) and slugging percentage (.543)... He finished among the top three in the league over that span in OPS (2nd, .981), on-base percentage (3rd, .438) and hits (1-3rd, 65).
- RHP Blake Holub** made 20 appearances with the Shuckers over two different stints, from May 19 to July 2 and from August 16 until the end of the season... Over his 20 appearances, he had a 0.34 ERA (1er, 26.1ip) with 29 strikeouts and 5 walks... Holub finished the year among the Southern League leaders (min. 20ip) in ERA (2nd, 0.34) and groundball rate (7th, 59.2%)... Holub also went 8-of-9 in save opportunities, tied for the 6th-most in the Southern League.

**BASEBALL AMERICA SUPERSTAR:** RHP Craig Yoho was named a *Baseball America* First-Team Minor League Baseball All-Star, including the top players from positions across every level of Minor League Baseball... Yoho was the only Brewers farmhand selected as a First-Team Minor League Baseball All-Star... Yoho was the Brewers' 8th-round pick from 2023 out of Indiana and is the organization's 20th-ranked prospect per *Baseball America*.

**BA'S BEST OF THE CREW:** RHP Jacob Misiorowski was named the *Baseball America* Brewers Minor League Player of the Year for 2024... OF Jackson Chourio previously won the award in 2022 and 2023 while appearing for the Shuckers in both seasons... Misiorowski split his season between the Shuckers and Triple-A Nashville, making 21 starts and 33 appearances.

- With the Shuckers, Misiorowski made 19 starts and was the team's Opening Day starter... Over 19 starts, he held a 3.50 ERA with 105 strikeouts across 79.2 innings... Misiorowski ranked among the Double-A leaders (min. 70ip) in strikeout rate (6th, 30.3%), opponent's average (6th, .181) and swinging strike rate (16th, 13.9%)... He also recorded back-to-back 10-strikeout games, coming on July 6 at the Mississippi Braves and on July 12 at the Chattanooga Lookouts.
- After being promoted to Triple-A Nashville on August 3, he finished the season with a 2.55 ERA across 14 appearances and two starts, including 22 strikeouts in 17.2 innings.

**LEADING THE LEAGUE:** The Shuckers ended the season with multiple players placing the top five in the Southern League leader boards including: **1B Ernesto Martinez Jr.** (1st, 30 2B // 2nd, .831 OPS // 3rd, 45 XBH // 3rd, .466 SLG // 4th, 187 TB // 4th, 114 H // 5th, .365 OBP), **3B Brock Wilken** (4th, 17 HR), **C Darrien Miller** (3rd, .393 OBP) and **OF Carlos Rodriguez** (T-4th, 4 3B).

**FIVE'S THE MAGIC NUMBER:** The Shuckers finished the regular season with a 45-9 record when they scored at least five runs in a game, an .833 winning percentage... The Shuckers won 33 of their last 39 games since June 1 when they scored at least five runs, including wins in 29 of their last 33 when reaching the mark... The Shuckers won their only game of the postseason when scoring at least 5 runs.

**ODDS ARE IT'S A CLOSE ONE:** 67 of the Shuckers' 135 games in the regular season were decided by 2 runs or less, including 42 one-run games... In those 67 games, the Shuckers were 34-33, a .507 win percentage... In the second half, 30 of the Shuckers' 68 games were decided by 2 or less, with the Shuckers going 17-13, a .567 win percentage.

**IT'S A PLAYOFF PARTY:** 3 of the 4 Milwaukee Brewers' full-season affiliates made a playoff appearance in 2024... The Shuckers joined the Carolina Mudcats (A) and Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (A+) as the 3rd team to reach the playoffs.

**AWAY FROM BILOXI? IT'S NO WORRIES:** The Shuckers finished the 2024 regular season with a 36-32 record on the road... It marked the 1st time in franchise history (since 2015) that the Shuckers won at least 35 road games in back-to-back seasons... The Shuckers went 40-29 on the road in 2023.

After June 1, the Shuckers finished the season 2nd in Double-A with 28 road wins, winning 28 of their final 45 road games... Over the final 45 road games, the Shuckers were 4th in Double-A and led the Southern League with a 3.25 ERA and 432 strikeouts... The Shuckers started the season 8-16 start on the road.

**SHUTTING IT DOWN:** RHP Justin Yeager earned his Southern League-leading 20th save of the season in the regular season finale with a scoreless ninth inning... A Shuckers pitcher has led the Southern League in saves in 5 of the last 7 seasons: 2024, 2023, 2019, 2018, 2017... He became the first Shuckers pitcher to reach 20 saves in a season since RHP Nate Griep (22) in 2019.

**PUTTING THE ELBOW GUARD TO USE:** C Darrien Miller was hit by a pitch 28 times in 2024, breaking the Shuckers single-season record, set by C Jacob Nottingham with 20 in 2017... It marked the 9th time since 2005 that a Southern League player has been hit by a pitch at least 20 times in a season... Miller led the Southern League with 28 HBP and was 3rd in Double-A.

**DYLAN'S MAKING HISTORY:** 2B/OF Dylan O'Rae recorded his 60th stolen base of the season on August 31, becoming the 16th Brewers Minor League player (since 1970) to reach the mark in a season... O'Rae became the first to record at least 60 in a season while playing at least one game in Double-A or higher since OF Matthew Sferazza and OF Mike Felder reached the mark in 1985 with Double-A El Paso and Triple-A Vancouver... O'Rae ended the season with a team-high 29 stolen bases with Double-A Biloxi and 62 between High-A Wisconsin and the Shuckers.

After no Brewers Minor League player reached at least 60 stolen bases since 2009, O'Rae and OF Yhoswar Garcia (A, CAR) both reached the mark in 2024... It's the first time a pair of Brewer farmhands have reached 60+ in a season since 1985.

**PURE GREATNESS:** RHP K.C. Hunt recorded the 3rd-longest start by a Shuckers pitcher in the playoffs and the longest playoff start in the Southern League since 2019 with 7.2 innings in Game 2 of the SLDS... It marked the longest start in a playoff elimination game in franchise history (since 2015)... Prior to the start, Hunt had pitched into the 7th inning once in 14 career starts.

No Shuckers starter had recorded an out in the 8th inning in a playoff game since 2019 prior to Hunt's start in Game 2... Hunt became the 31st Southern League starter (since 2005) to record an out in the 8th inning in a playoff game.

Hunt was the first Southern League starter to record an out in the 8th inning of a playoff game since RHP Dylan File (BLX) went 8.1 innings on September 5, 2019 against Pensacola... Hunt was the 5th pitcher to reach the mark since the start of 2017.

**THE FIRST TO 80 STRAIGHT:** 3B Brock Wilken appeared in 81 consecutive game for the Shuckers, every game since he returned from the 7-Day Injured List on May 7, 2024 until August 20... Wilken became the first Shuckers player to appear in at least 80 consecutive games since streaks were tracked beginning in 2018... The streak is the longest by a Shuckers player since 2018 and the third of at least 50 games since 2018.

**TWO-OUT OFFENSE:** The Shuckers recorded 10 RBI with two outs on August 9 at the Montgomery Biscuits and July 12 at the Chattanooga Lookouts, the 7th and 8th times in franchise history (since 2015) that the lineup recorded at least 10 RBI... The Shuckers are the only Double-A team to reach the mark twice in 2024... A Double-A team recorded at least 10 RBI with two outs in a game 13 times in 2024.

On August 9, the Shuckers were 7-for-16 with a double, 2 home runs and 3 walks... On July 12, the Shuckers were 4-for-11 with a double, triple, home runs and 2 walks.

**YOH0'S AWARD-WINNING MONTH:** RHP Craig Yoho was named the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July... Over 9 appearances in July, Yoho allowed 2 unearned runs in 10.0 innings, including 2 saves... Yoho earned his first career save on July 1, 2024 against the Mississippi Braves and his second at Mississippi on July 6... Yoho also struck out 19 of the 44 batters he faced, a 43% strikeout rate, and limited opponents to a .179 (9-for-39) average.

**NOW THAT'S WHAT YOU CALL A MONTH:** With 3 runs on Wednesday, the Shuckers finished July with 143 runs scored, the 3rd-most runs scored in any month in franchise history... Over 23 games in July, the Shuckers averaged 6.2 runs per game and were one of 3 Southern League teams that scored at least 100 runs in the month.

The Shuckers ended the month among the Double-A leaders in runs (2nd, 143), on-base percentage (2nd, .362), average with runners in scoring position (6th, .299) and OPS (7th, .751).

During the month, the Shuckers scored at least 5 runs in 14 games (61%) and at least 10 runs in 4 games (17%).

In July, 3B Brock Wilken held a .256/.374/.500 slash line with an .874 OPS and as many walks (17) as strikeouts (17)... His 6 home runs in July were tied for the 2nd-most in Double-A.

**SPARKS WERE FLYING IN JULY:** OF Lamar Sparks ended July among the Double-A leaders in average (2nd, .373) and hits (3rd, 28)... Over 19 games in July, Sparks had a .373/.392/.560 slash line with a .952 OPS, 6 2B, 2 HR and 13 RBI... Sparks recorded a hit in 15 of 19 games and tallied multiple in 9 games, including tying the single-game franchise record with 5 on July 4, 2024 at the Mississippi Braves.

**JUST KEEP RUNNING:** The Shuckers tied the single-game franchise record (since 2015) with 8 stolen bases on July 30... The mark was the team's most in a game since they set the single-game record on April 30, 2023 against the Mississippi Braves... The 8 stolen bases are tied for the 2nd-most by a Double-A team in a game this season and the fourth time this season a Double-A team has tallied at least 8 in a single game.

**HE GETS ON BASE:** OF/2B Adam Hall reached base in 21 consecutive games between June 14 and July 25, 2024, tied for the 9th-longest active streak Southern League and tied for the longest by a Shuckers player this season... During the streak (since 6/14), Hall owned a .347/.449/.389 slash line with 11 RBI... Hall has reached base in 21 of his first 22 games since joining the Shuckers on June 13.

**REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS:** The Shuckers set a new single-game franchise record (since 2015) on July 20, 2024 in a 19-1 win over the Montgomery Biscuits... The Shuckers' 19 runs broke the previous franchise record of 18, set on September 7, 2023, at the Birmingham Barons... The previous single-game franchise record at Keesler Federal Park was 16, set on May 29, 2022 against the Montgomery Biscuits.

**REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS IN AN INNING:** The Shuckers scored a season-high 9 runs on 7 hits in the second inning on July 20, 2024 against the Montgomery Biscuits, with both marks tied for the 4th-most in a single inning in franchise history... It marked the most runs scored in an inning since the Shuckers scored 10 in an inning twice in 2023, on July 22 at Montgomery and on July 30 against Birmingham.

**THROWING OUT THE OLD RECORDS:** SS/2B Eric Brown Jr. set career-highs with 2 home runs and 7 RBI as part of a 3-for-5 night on Saturday... His 7 RBI are tied for the 2nd-most by a Double-A player in a game this season and the most in a game by a Shuckers player since INF/OF Felix Valerio tallied 8 RBI on June 10, 2022... His 7 RBI are the 3rd-most in a single game in franchise history (since 2015).

**TAKE A WALK:** 2B/OF Dylan O'Rae set the Shuckers' single-game franchise record (since 2015) on July 14, 2024, with 5 walks against the Chattanooga Lookouts... O'Rae broke the previous record of 4, set by INF/OF Noah Campbell (May 17, 2023) and OF Trent Grisham (June 1, 2019).

O'Rae became the first Double-A player to draw 5 walks in a game since C Luca Tresh on May 23, 2024 with the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (KCR) against the Tulsa Drillers (LAD)... It was the 17th time a player had drawn at least 5 walks in a game in Double-A since 2005.

**SPARKS FLY ON THE FOURTH:** OF Lamar Sparks tied the Shuckers single-game record (since 2015) with 5 hits in a 5-for-5 performance on Thursday... The five-hit game was the fifth in franchise history... Sparks joined OF Carlos Rodriguez, who achieved the feat on May 1 at Tennessee, as the second Shuckers player with a five-hit game this season... It marks the first time two Shuckers players have recorded a five-hit game in the same season.

The five-hit performance is the first by any player at Trustmark Park since OF Tyler Neslony (BIR) in 2022 and the 14th in the ballpark's history.

**REACHING HISTORY:** OF Carlos Rodriguez tied the single-game franchise record with five hits on May 1, 2024, with a 5-for-5 performance... The five hits also set a new career-high for Rodriguez.

Rodriguez became the first player in franchise history to record five hits in a game since OF Chad Spanberger on July 21, 2021 against the Mississippi Braves... He also became the ninth Brewers prospect to collect five hits in a game since 2021, the first since OF Arbert Cipion on May 24, 2022 with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in High-A.

**A PAINFUL PIECE OF HISTORY:** SS/2B Freddy Zamora tied the single-game franchise record (since 2015) on April 26, 2024, after being hit by a pitch 3 times... The Shuckers 1.69 ERA through 14 games is tied with the 2019 Pensacola Blue Wahoos for the best start in Double-A since 2005... The start is also tied for the seventh-best in Minor League Baseball through 14 games since 2005 at any level.

**GOING LONG:** The Shuckers and Biscuits played a 12-inning game on April 7, 2024, the Shuckers' longest of the year... The game was the Shuckers longest since playing 13 innings on August 18, 2021, against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos in a 4-3 loss in 2021... It marked the longest home game for the Shuckers since August 21, 2017 in a 1-0, 12-inning, loss to the Mobile BayBears.
