Scholarship Award: \$1,000 (one-year, non-renewable)

Scholarship Criteria:

- Applicants must be enrolled in a public or private school in Midland, Odessa or surrounding area and scheduled to receive their high school diploma following the 2026 spring semester;
- Applicants must be planning to enroll in a four-year university, junior college, or vocational institution for the 2026 fall semester (proof of enrollment may be requested at the beginning of the 2026 fall semester);
- Proof of high school graduation will be required before award is paid;
