**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels held off the RubberDucks, 5-4. **Diego Velasquez** hit a single in the second and **Sabin Ceballos** scored on an error to open a 1-0 lead. **Parks Harber** hit an RBI single in the third for a 2-0 lead. Akron tied the score, 2-2, in the fourth with an RBI groundout by Guy Lipscomb and a run-scoring single by Jose Devers. In the sixth, Velasquez moved Richmond ahead with a sacrifice fly. **Dayson Croes** led off the seventh with a triple and scored on a double by **Jonah Cox**, who scored on a double by Harber for a 5-2 Flying Squirrels lead. In the ninth, Akron scored on a wild pitch and Jason Chourio hit an RBI double to close the score to 5-4, but **Mitch White** stranded two runners on base to end the game. **Dale Stanavich**, **Manuel Mercedes** and **Brad Deppermann** combined for four scoreless innings out of the Richmond bullpen.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series features a match-up of the top two teams in the Southwest Division this season. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six against the RubberDucks at CarMax Park from May 5-10.

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 33-14 start is the best in team history through 47 games, passing a 26-21 start in 2010, 2021 and 2022. Richmond has won five series and split three so far this year. Seven-of-14 Richmond losses have been by one run.

**RELENTLESS:** In their 33 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 15 of them. In 10 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. On April 4, they scored two in the ninth for an 11-9 win at Erie. In the April 7 home opener, they never trailed but jumped ahead in the bottom of the eighth for a 3-2 win over the Curve. On April 9, they scored two in the eighth for another 3-2 win against Altoona. On April 11, the Curve scored two in the top of the 10th before the Flying Squirrels walked off with three in the bottom of the 10th. On April 15 in Hartford, the Flying Squirrels scored five runs with two outs in the ninth to win 13-11. On April 24, **Drew Cavanaugh** hit a walk-off, two-run homer in the ninth for a 7-6 win over the Patriots. On April 26, Richmond tied the score with two outs in the ninth before **Parks Harber** hit a walk-off single in the 10th. On April 30, the Flying Squirrels rallied from a two-run deficit in the eighth to take the lead in the ninth and 10th but were answered by Altoona before a 12-run top of the 11th. On Wednesday against Akron, **Jonah Cox** hit a two-run homer to tie the score in the ninth before Cavanaugh won the game, 5-4, with a walk-off double. On Friday, the Flying Squirrels tied their largest come-from-behind win in franchise history, overcoming a 6-0 deficit to win, 9-6, over Akron. On May 20 against Binghamton, **Ty Hanchey** hit a game-tying homer in the bottom of the ninth and Harber won the game with a walk-off single.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** are 6-7 in their last 13 games after opening the season 27-7 through May 13, hitting 20 games over .500 for the first time since 2014. They have the best record in Double-A. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Richmond offense ranks second in doubles (109) and third in batting average (.288). Richmond leads all 30 Double-A teams in batting average, runs (306), hits (457), doubles, triples (16) and OPS (.836) and ranks second in OBP (.369) and SLG (.467).

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** have surged to second place in the Southwest Division standings. After dropping five-of-six in Richmond from May 5-10, Akron went 8-2 from May 12-23, but is 1-4 in its last five games since Sunday. Akron's roster features five players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects list, including RHP Khal Stephen (No. 8), OF Jaison Chourio (No. 9), C Jacob Cozart (No. 14), OF Alfonsino Rosario (No. 24) and LHP Josh Hartle (No. 25). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes six Akron players, including Stephen (No. 5), Chourio (No. 10), Rosario (No. 14), Cozart (No. 18), RHP Justin Campbell (No. 22) and Hartle (No. 26).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Greg Farone** makes his 10th Double-A start and his second against the RubberDucks. He last pitched last Friday against Binghamton and allowed one run over 4.1 innings with five strikeouts, the fewest runs allowed in a start since his first two Double-A outings in April. Farone last faced Akron on May 9 at CarMax Park and allowed a season-high six runs over four innings in a loss. He was Richmond's Opening Day starter on April 4 at Erie in his Double-A debut and allowed one run over 4.2 innings. He had eight strikeouts, tying the franchise record for the most strikeouts on Opening Day. He pitched his first professional season in 2025 and split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene. He made 12 starts for San Jose, going 2-1 with a 3.73 ERA. At the time of his promotion in June, he ranked third in the California League in strikeouts (73). Farone closed the year with 11 starts at High-A, going 4-2 with a 4.25 ERA. Farone began his college career at Herkimer College in New York, where he led the team to the program's first NJCAA national title in 2022, going 7-0 with a 1.65 ERA and was named the NJCAA Division III Player of the Year and MVP of the World Series. He transferred to the University of Louisville for the 2023 season and pitched at the University of Alabama in 2024 before being selected by the Giants in the seventh round of that year's MLB Draft. **For more on Farone, see page two.**

**FOR AKRON:** Left-hander Caden Favors makes his 10th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. In his last start on Sunday at Harrisburg, he allowed five runs (four earned) over 4.1 innings. He pitched in Richmond on May 5 and surrendered a then-season-high five runs over five innings in a loss. Favors went 1-2 with a 2.45 ERA (7 ER/25.2 IP) in his first five starts from April 4-29 but has gone 0-2 with a 10.43 ERA (17 ER/14.2 IP) in his last four starts since May 5. For the month of April, he led the minors in BAA (.112). Favors was selected by the Guardians in the sixth round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Wichita State. Last year, he made 25 starts for High-A Lake County, going 8-9 with a 4.08 ERA.

**COX ROCKS:** **Jonah Cox** leads MiLB in batting average (.413) and is second in SLG (.665), second in OPS (1.131), eighth in OBP (.466) and tied for ninth in hits (64). He has 27 stolen bases this year, which leads the Eastern League and is tied for fifth in MiLB. The 27 steals are tied for sixth-most in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with Jalen Miller (2019). Cox reached base in the first 23 games he played this season to begin his Double-A career before an 0-for-3 outing on May 5. He opened the season on a 12-game hit streak and has at least one hit in 40-of-43 games he has played, adding a 10-game hit streak that was also snapped on May 5. He had an 11-game hit streak since May 6-19 and is currently riding a seven-game hit streak. On May 1 (G1) at Altoona, he became the fifth player in Flying Squirrels history to hit three triples in a single game. Saturday night, he reached base five times, going 4-for-4 with three steals.

**PARKS & WRECK:** **Parks Harber** has homered six times and picked up 21 RBIs in his last 18 games since May 7. Last week, he hit a solo home run on Wednesday night before driving a game-winning single in the bottom of the ninth, his second walk-off hit for the Flying Squirrels this year. Among Eastern League batters (min. 120 PA), Harber ranks fifth in SLG (.573), eighth in batting average (.316) and eighth in OPS (.948).

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 293 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Of Richmond managers since 1954, Pelfrey is second in wins behind Eddie Haas (1968, 1981-84), who had 351 wins.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** In 2025, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in total (446,679) and average (6,768) attendance for the fourth consecutive season. The average attendance was the highest in the franchise's history. April 7's inaugural game at CarMax Park had been sold out for more than a month, marking the 16th consecutive home-opener to sell out for the Flying Squirrels. This season, the Flying Squirrels rank second among the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance (7,131).

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Jonah Cox** is first in batting average (.413), first in OBP (.466), first in SLG (.665), first in OPS (1.131), first in hits (64), first in triples (5), first in total bases (103), first in stolen bases (27), tied for fourth in RBIs (35) and tied for fourth in extra base hits (22). **Scott Bandura** is sixth in batting average (.324), tied for ninth in RBIs (32), third in OBP (.430) and tied for seventh in runs (33). **Charlie Szykowny** is tied for fifth in doubles (12). **Parks Harber** is fifth in SLG (.573), tied for fifth in doubles (12), eighth in batting average (.316) and eighth in OPS (.948). **Matt Wilkinson** is first in WHIP (0.83), first in BAA (.154), second in ERA (1.87) and tied for sixth in strikeouts (49). **Joe Whitman** is tied for second in strikeouts (56), tied for second in wins (5), second in WHIP (0.97), fifth in ERA (3.05), fourth in BAA (.190) and ninth in innings pitched (44.1). **Jack Choate** is tied for second in wins (5). **Tyler Vogel** is second in saves (6). **Mitch White** is tied for third in saves (5). **Trystan Vrieling** is ninth in ERA (3.63). **Cesar Perdomo** is eighth in BAA (.220) and eighth in WHIP (1.20).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Richmond's roster features six players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bo Davidson** (No. 3), **Parks Harber** (No. 13), **Joe Whitman** (No. 18), **Jonah Cox** (No. 21), **Matt Wilkinson** (No. 25) and **Diego Velasquez** (No. 29). **Adrián Sugastey** is rated by Baseball America as the top defensive catcher in the Giants organization and Cox is rated as the top defensive outfielder. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 7), Harber (No. 14), **Maui Ahuna** (No. 20) and Whitman (No. 26).

**ROAD TO THE SHOW:** Since last Friday, three Flying Squirrels alumni have made their MLB debuts. Last Friday, **Victor Bericoto** debuted for the Giants. He was with Richmond from 2023-2025 and was last year's team MVP. On Saturday, **Bryan Torres** of the 2021 Flying Squirrels debuted for the St. Louis Cardinals and homered in his first game. Pitcher **Tanner Andrews**, part of the 2022 Flying Squirrels, made his MLB with the Toronto Blue Jays on Monday with a scoreless outing, becoming the 120th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors. **William Kempner** made his debut for Miami Marlins back on May 5.

### THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

**1986:** The Atlanta Braves beat the Richmond Braves, 6-3, in an exhibition game at The Diamond. Richmond committed four errors in the second inning. Jim Gaudango, normally the A-Braves traveling batting practice pitcher, played catcher for part of the game. Future Hall of Fame catcher Ted Simmons pitched a scoreless inning. The Braves brought in Tom Glavine from Double-A Greenville and Tommy Greene from Single-A Sumter, who both made their first pitching appearances at The Diamond throwing for Atlanta. **1993:** The Richmond Braves beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 7-2, at The Diamond. Ryan Klesko hit a two-run homer off the speaker behind the center-field wall in the first inning, estimated around 450 feet. Chipper Jones and Javy Lopez each drove in a run. **2022:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Hartford Yard Goats, 22-9, setting the franchise record for runs, hits (24) and RBIs (22) in a game. Richmond hit seven homers, which was then a team single-game record. Tyler Fitzgerald and Jacob Heyward each had five hits, tying the franchise single-game record. Fitzgerald also set the team single-game record for total bases (13) and runs scored (5).
