**FISHER CATS RECORD 13 HITS, FALL LATE IN PORTLAND:** New Hampshire jumped out to a 7-1 lead in the top of the fourth, but the Portland Sea Dogs would wind up mounting an impressive comeback to take the series opener 9-8. The Fisher Cats were down 8-7 after seven innings and worked the tying run across the plate thanks to an Austin Martin base hit, but the Sea Dogs plated the winning run in the bottom of the eighth before Jose Adames recorded his ninth save of the season.

**DON'T LET SAMAD GET HOT:** Samad Taylor hit his 7<sup>th</sup> home run of the season yesterday, including his first of the season away from home. The Corona, California native is just two home runs shy of his career high, and he currently is enjoying a seven game hit streak during which he is hitting .385.

**TEAMMATES NO MORE:** Simeon Woods Richardson spent the last two weeks on Olympic Qualifying duty with USA Baseball as the United States clinched their berth. Woods Richardson was also teammates with Portland Sea Dogs slugger Triston Casas, who went 6-15 with 3 RBI, playing in all four games for Team USA. This week, the players will likely face off just days after leading Team USA to four consecutive victories over Nicaragua, the Dominican Republic, Canada, and Venezuela.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** June 9, 2019---The Fisher Cats wrapped up a homestand in Manchester with a one-hitter, 2-0 over the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Nate Pearson allowed just hit in five scoreless innings and Willy Ortiz went four hitless innings the rest of the way. Chad Spanberger delivered the runs with a sixth-inning double.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Toronto Blue Jays gave up six unanswered runs, including five in the eighth inning, to fall to the AL Central leading Chicago White Sox 6-1. Buffalo also lost a lead, giving up a 5-0 lead to fall to Scranton/WB 7-5. Former Fisher Cat Kevin Smith homered for Buffalo in the loss, his seventh of the season. Vancouver held on to beat Spokane on the road, 8-6, while Dunedin dropped the series opener to Lakeland 7-4.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats will head to Hadlock Field in Portland for their third meeting with the Sea Dogs (Red Sox) this week, before returning home to face the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies) for the first time this year.

**ROSTER MOVES: June 4:** RHP Johnny Barbato signed to a minor league contract and assigned to the Fisher Cats. RHP Cre Finrock placed in IL. **June 8:** Simeon Woods Richardson reinstated from temporary inactive list (Olympic Qualifying).

**ON THE HILL:** Simeon Woods Richardson will make his first start in 18 days following his stint with USA Baseball. He has recorded either seven or eight strikeouts in each of his four previous starts this season and has limited opposing hitters to a batting average of just .197.

For Portland, Frank German will take the mound. With a record of 1-3, German will be facing the Fisher Cats for the third time this season. He picked up his first win of the season, pitching five scoreless innings against Harrisburg last week. Against the Fisher Cats this season, German has given up ten runs (six earned) in five and one thirds inning of work, but has not taken a decision.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Pitched four innings last Thursday for Team USA against Puerto Rico at the Americas Qualifier for the Summer Olympics. Allowed four hits, one run, no walks and five strikeouts. He allowed a two-out RBI single to former Major Leaguer Ivan De Jesus Jr. in the third inning, but otherwise cruised. Team USA led Puerto Rico 6-1, but the game was ultimately canceled due to lightning in the area.

**v. PORTLAND:** Two of his four Fisher Cats starts are against the Sea Dogs, including May 22 in Manchester. Allowed three runs in five innings, matching a season-high with eight strikeouts.

**2021:** Matched a career-high with eight strikeouts in Double-A debut 5/6 G1 at Portland. Allowed 3 runs (1 earned) in 4.0 IP. Followed that up with another eight strikeouts in home opener vs. Somerset. Allowed only one hit (a HR) in his five innings vs. Patriots. Also struck out eight Sea Dogs on May 22.

**2019:** Didn't miss a start while splitting time with Adv. A Columbia in the Mets system and with the Dunedin Blue Jays after the trade. Went 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in his six starts with Dunedin, with 29 strikeouts in 28.1 IP. Held FSL hitters to a .182 average. Finished the season with a combined 126 strikeouts in 106.2 IP.

**2018:** In Mets system, made a couple starts for the GCL Mets and Kingsport Mets (Appy League). Did not allow a run in first six outings as a pro.

**Career/Personal Notes:** On the opening day roster for the Fisher Cats for the first time, and is the youngest on the roster.

**Obtained:** Selected by the Mets in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the 2018 draft (Kempner HS, Sugar Land, TX). He was part of the trade on 7/28/19 when the Blue Jays sent RHP Marcus Stroman and cash to the NY Mets for LHP Anthony Kay and Richardson. Pitched only at the Adv. A level in 2019 with Columbia (Mets) and Dunedin (Blue Jays).
