YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 4-2. Harrisburg opened a 4-0 lead in the first inning with two-run homers by Johnathon Thomas and Murphy Stehly. In the bottom of the first, **Cal Mitchell** hit an RBI single and **Jairo Pomares** singled in a run to close the score to 4-2. After surrendering four runs before the first out was recorded, **Jack Choate** held the Senators scoreless over the rest of his innings. **Evan Gates** threw three scoreless innings with four strikeouts. **Tyler Myrick** struck out two in two scoreless innings. **Diego Velasquez** went 3-for-3 with two walks, a run and a steal.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. Richmond played two road series in Harrisburg this year and went 2-4 in both sets, first from April 8-13 and again from May 6-11. Along with this week's series, the Senators return to The Diamond for a three-game set from July 18-20 out of the All-Star Break. The Flying Squirrels are looking for their second series split of the season.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,957 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 3-10 in their last 13 games. They have alternated wins and losses through the first five games of this week's series with the Senators. Last week, they went 1-5 in last week's series in Binghamton, falling on three walk-off hits. In the Flying Squirrels' last seven losses, four have been by one run. Of Richmond's 35 losses this season, 19 of them have been by two runs or less (12 by one, seven by two). The Richmond offense has the second-fewest strikeouts (396) in the Eastern League but are last in runs scored (157).

THE SENATORS are 5-10 in their last 15 games, including going 1-5 in their home series against the Baysox last week and 2-3 in the first six games of this series. In the Eastern League, the Harrisburg offense ranks first in triples (22), second in hits (411), second in total bases (646), third in runs (227), fourth in RBIs (209) and tied for fourth in homers (37). Harrisburg's roster features two players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list, including RHP Jarlin Susana (No. 3 - on IL) and 3B Cayden Wallace (No. 9). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list features three Harrisburg players, including Susana (No. 2), Wallace (No. 10) and SS Kevin Made (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Seth Lonsway** makes his 10th start of the season and the fourth of his career against the Senators. He last pitched last Sunday in the second game of a doubleheader at Binghamton and allowed four runs over 5.2 innings in a loss. In his three previous starts against the Senators, Lonsway has combined to go 3-0 and has not allowed a run in 17 innings, striking out 16 with three walks. He threw 6.1 innings on July 10, 2024 at The Diamond against the Senators. He has made two road starts in Harrisburg this year, working five two-hit innings on April 8 and 5.2 innings with one hit allowed on May 8, striking out seven in both scoreless starts. This year, Lonsway is ninth in the Eastern League in ERA (2.89), ninth in innings pitched (46.2) and ninth in WHIP (1.18). Since joining the team last summer, Lonsway has not allowed an earned run nine-of-15 Double-A outings, including four-of-10 starts in 2025. Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. *For more on Lonsway, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Bryce Conley makes his fourth start with the Nationals organization after singing on May 13. In the series opener on Tuesday, Conley worked 5.2 scoreless innings in a no-decision, his second straight scoreless start. He made his Nationals organization debut on May 16 at Altoona and allowed five runs over 3.2 innings. Last Wednesday, he tossed five scoreless innings against the Baysox. Conley began this year pitching with Charros de Jalisco of the Mexican League, where he was 1-0 with a 2.03 ERA in three starts. He was originally selected by the Athletics in the 22nd round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Georgia State and reached as high as Triple-A before reaching free agency after the 2023 season. On July 22, 2019, Conley started and threw six innings in a combined no-hitter for the Stockton Ports against the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes. He signed with the Nationals on May 13.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to catch 28 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is second among Double-A catchers with 17 runners caught stealing, which is first in the EL. Morgan is tied for third in the Eastern League with 11, which is tied for ninth in Double-A.

WAIT A MINUTE: Northern Virginia native **Bryce Eldridge** returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 21 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. On May 10, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win. In two games on May 15 (G2)-16, he went 5-for-7 with three homers, two doubles and five RBIs. On Wednesday he hit his sixth homer of the season and drove in three runs. Eldridge homered again on Friday night, a two-run shot. In his last 16 games since May 13, Eldridge is hitting .318 (20-for-63) with five homers, five doubles and 12 RBIs.

HELLO, GAVELLO: Catcher/infielder/outfielder **Thomas Gavello** joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. On Thursday night, he hit his first Double-A homer, a two-run shot to right. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in 10-of-14 Double-A games he has played, including five doubles, and is batting .341. He has played one game at shortstop and 12 games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

CLOSE CALLS: Of the Flying Squirrels' last seven loses, four have been by one run. In four-of-their-last-seven losses, their opponent has scored the winning run in their final inning at bat, including three walk-off losses at Binghamton last week. On the season, 19 of the Flying Squirrels' 35 losses have been by two runs or less, which is the most in the Eastern League. The Flying Squirrels have the most one-run losses (12) in the EL this year. They have lost seven games by two runs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is seventh in OBP (.381) and tied for ninth in hits (47). **Bryce Eldridge** is third in SLG (.525) and eighth in OPS (.878). **Seth Lonsway** is ninth in ERA (2.89), ninth in innings pitched (46.2) and ninth in WHIP (1.18). **Jack Choate** is sixth in strikeouts (63). **Joe Whitman** is ninth in strikeouts (49), seventh in BAA (.200) and seventh in WHIP (1.08). **John Michael Bertrand** is fourth in innings pitched (50.0).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 219 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bryce Eldridge** (No. 1), **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverson Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 21 overall by Baseball America and No. 21 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1963: The Richmond Virginians lost to the Columbus Jets, 3-2, at Parker Field. Trailing, 3-0, in the eighth, Newport News native Joe Durham broke the shutout with an RBI single. Bob Schmidt followed with an RBI single to close the score to 3-2, but Richmond stranded the bases loaded. Manny Mote, Orlando McFarlane and Bob Burda drove in the Columbus runs. It was Dairy Night at Parker Field with a cow milking contest on the field. Fred Hopke of the Virginians and Steve Blass of the Jets competed. Hopke, described by the Richmond Times-Dispatch as "a city boy from New Jersey," won. **1970:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 4-0, at Parker Field. Rick Kester threw a shutout and struck out 11 batters for the R-Braves. The game remained scoreless until a two-run homer by Hal Breeden in the seventh. **1971:** The Richmond Braves beat the Peninsula Winniepeg Whips, 8-0, at Parker Field. Rick Kester threw a three-hit shutout, striking out nine. Tommie Aaron had three hits and drove in four runs. Dusty Baker scored three runs. **1977:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 7-0, at Parker Field. Mickey Mahler threw the first no-hitter in Richmond Braves history, which is still the most recent nine-inning no-hitter thrown by a Richmond pitcher at home. The only baserunner he allowed was a two-out walk to Ron Pruitt in the fifth inning. It was only the second no-hitter in Richmond's Triple-A history. **1985:** The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, 3-2, in 13 innings at The Diamond. In the bottom of the 13th, Doc Estes fouled off six straight pitches before singling home the walk-off winning run. Marty Clary pitched 10 innings for Richmond and allowed two runs. **2000:** The Richmond Braves beat the Ottawa Lynx, 12-8, at The Diamond. Mark DeRosa had two hits and drove in three runs, including the go-ahead RBI in the eighth. Steve Sisco homered twice. The R-Braves honored Sam Ayoub that day, who was the team's trainer from 1968-1991 and had retired after 40 years with the Braves organization the year prior. The team announced that day that the home clubhouse training room at The Diamond would be named for him. Ayoub passed away in March 2025.
