**ROCKHOUNDS BATS OVERWHELM CARDS:** The Midland RockHounds pounded out 15 hits and took advantage of nine free passes as Springfield fell for the second straight game to start the series 12-6 on Wednesday night at Hammons Field. **Mike Antico** drove in two runs for the second straight game, while **Jacob Buchberger** and **Ramon Mendoza** each collected two hits for the Cards. All but one Cardinal had a hit. Trailing 10-4 going into the 8th inning, Springfield brough the tying run to the plate, but **RJ Yeager** flew out to the warning track to end the threat, and the Cardinals went down1-2-3 in the 9th.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander Gunnar Hoglund makes his 7th start (8th appearance) of the season for Midland...Last pitched on Friday, May 10 against Tulsa and took the loss, allowing 4 R on 5 H with 1 BB and 3 K...His best start of the season came in the start before that, firing 7 shutout innings allowing just 2 H with 8 K...Went 2-1 with a 4.39 ERA in 5 appearances in April...Made 16 starts across three levels last season, combining to go 2-5 with a 6.05 ERA...Spent most of the season with Low-A Stockton goign 1-5 with a 7.48 ERA...Made 3 starts with Lansing and one with Midland, allowing 3 R on 6 H over 5.0 IP... **CARDINALS MEET MIDLAND FOR ONLY TIME IN 2024:** The Cardinals begin a 12-game homestand at Hammons Field with their only series of the season against the Midland RockHounds (Double-A, Oakland A's). The two teams met just once last season as well, with Midland winning four of six at Hammons Field from April 18-23.



## **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.







## CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

IN A FUNK AT HAMMONS: With back-to-back losses to start their series against the RockHounds this week, the Cardinals ran their losing streak at home to six consecutive games. The six-game skid at Hammons Field is the Cardinals' longest since the Birds dropped six straight at home form from July 10-30, 2021. The last time Spriingfield lost 7 or more straight at Hammons Field was an 8-game home skid from May 23-June 6, 2013.

CARDS OVERTAKEN AT TOP OF TEXAS LEAGUE: For the first time since April 7 (39 days), the Cardinals will begin a ballgame not at the top of the Texas League in batting average. Despite 10 hits in Wednesday night's game, the Cardinals were leapfrogged by the Midland RockHounds for the top batting average in the Texas League. Springfield will enter play today at .262, Midland at .264.

**GRINDIN':** Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cards have struck out just 253 times in 34 games, the 4th-fewest in all of full-season Minor League Baseball. In the Texas League, Springfield trails the Frisco RoughRiders (243 K's in 33 games) for 2nd-fewest in the circuit. The Birds are averaging just 7.4 K's per aame.

**UP & DOWN ON THE MOUND:** After putting together a 2.36 ERA over their previous six games, the Midland offense got to the Cardinal pitching staff for 12 ER on Wednesday night to continue what has been a roller coaster ride for Springfield pitching this season. In the 17 games prior to the start of their series in Springdale against the Naturals the Cards had an ERA of 6.12, and over the first nine games of the season the Birds notched a 2.88 mark.

All together, the Cardinals' ERA sits at 4.91, and the Birds have given up the 2nd-most runs in the Texas League at 185 (5.4/game). The Cardinals' run differenttial now sits at +2 after being outscored by 14 runs over their last three games combined.

CARDS PLAGUED BY BIG INNINGS: So far in 2024, the Cardinals have had a hard time limiting the big inning. Springfield has surrendered 27 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 27 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 103 of the 185 total runs scored by the opposition. In summation, the Cards have allowed 55.6% of the runs scored against them in 2024 in just 9.2% of their innings pitched. In the other 264.2 IP Springfield has allowed 82 runs, which comes out to 2.78 runs per 9 innings.

TABLE SETTERS: The hitters that occupy the top two spots in the Cardinal lineup on the most regular basis. Brvan Torres and Nathan Church, have been the fuel to Springfield's league-leading offense. Combined, Torres and Church are batting .314 (77-for-245) with 40 R, 14 2B, 20 SB, 4 CS and have struck out a combined 35 times compared to 29 walks.

Springfield leadoff hitters are batting .283 which ranks 4th in the Texas League, and .306 out of the 2-hole, tops in the circuit. Combined, the Cardinals are 2nd in the league batting .294 between the two spots in the lineup (Midland, .303).

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder Nathan Church ranks in the top-10 among qualified hitters in the following categories: batting average (4th; .316), RBIs (t3rd; 23), hits (2nd; 43), total bases (3rd; 63), and runs (t8th; 22). Church has hit safely in 28 of his 32 games played and despite 4-game stretch in which he struck out 6 times, has struck out just 14 times in 149 plate appearances (9.4%). The UC Irvine product has already set a career high with 4 HR. He hit just 3 longballs at High-A Peoria last season in 119 games.

Last Monday, Church was named Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month for April when he slashed .349/.402/.512 with 3 HR and 18 RBIs. He led all Cardinals minor leaguers in OPS (.914), hits (30), total bases (44), and runs (17). He hit safely in 19 of 20 games for the month including a 13-game hitting streak, the longest in the Texas League this season.

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.
