ACKER STRONG, RIDERS FALL IN PITCHERS' DUAL:

The Frisco RoughRiders held the Corpus Christi Hooks to just two runs for the second-consecutive game but could not muster enough offense in a 2-1 loss on Wednesday at Riders Field. **Dane Acker** tossed five shutout innings with only one hit allowed for Frisco, striking out five and walking just two. In his 10th start at Double-A, he tied his season high with five innings and lowered his ERA to 3.08. **Justin Slaten** struck out five batters over two innings as the first RoughRiders reliever of the night. He did not allow a hit and held onto the 1-0 lead. Reid Birlingmaier (1-1) allowed the go-ahead run on a bloop single in the eighth inning and took the loss. **Danny Duffy** pitched a scoreless top of the ninth. **Jax Biggers** doubled to lead off the bottom of the ninth inning but was stranded at third base to end the game. Tyler Brown (5-3) garnered the win by posting two hitless innings out of the Hooks' bullpen. Ray Gaither tossed the final two innings without a run and picked up the save. **Chris Seise**'s sacrifice fly in the second inning put the Riders ahead 1-0. Liam Hicks had walked earlier in the inning and scored the first run of the game. Hicks went 1-for-3 and has now reached base in all 33 of his games at Riders Field this year. The Riders held onto the 1-0 lead until the eighth, when the Hooks scored their only two runs of the game. Frisco snapped a streak of 40 innings without trailing. The RoughRiders snapped a four-game win streak on Wednesday. Frisco has won four consecutive games on three occasions this year but the Riders have not won five games in a row. **Trevor Hauver** went 2-for-4 on Wednesday and has three hits plus a walk in the first two games of this series.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in four of the last five games. The Riders are tied for the Texas League lead in first-inning runs with 94 over their 121 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .274/.368/.443/.811 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 610 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .357 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. In the six games in Midland, the Riders walked 38 times (6.3 per game) with **Chris Seise**, **Trevor Hauver** and **David Garcia** leading the way with five.

HE'S DOING BIG(GERS) THINGS:

RoughRiders infielder **Jax Biggers** has been showing off in the power department this season for Frisco. Entering 2023, his career high in home runs was four and on Wednesday, he hit his 11th long ball of the season. In his last 28 games, he has clubbed six homers while hitting .292 (31-for-106)/.405/.538/.943 with four doubles, two triples, six home runs, 17 RBIs, 19 walks and 19 runs scored. In August, he has a .920 OPS, which leads the team.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 26 games in August, (13-13 record) the RoughRiders are first in the Texas League with a 3.90 ERA while allowing a league-low 18 home runs. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant two Tuesdays ago in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .717 OPS and tied for last in runs per game with 4.6 per contest.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 55 games since, he is batting .296/.410/.466/.876 with 15 doubles, six home runs, 31 RBIs and 41 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 43 points and his OPS 92 points.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 34 games, Hicks is batting .322 (38-for-118)/.438/.424/.862 with seven doubles, a triple, a home run, 20 RBIs, 22 walks and 15 runs scored. In his last 22 games, he is batting .333 (24-for-72) with a .882 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on August 17th in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 11 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT SETH

-Seth went to Mountain View High School in Arizona, which has produced four MLB players. Scott Lydy (MLB in 1993), Brian Banks (1996-2003), Shea Hillenbrand (2001-2007) and Brad Mills (2009-2015) all were Mountain View Toros.

-Nordlin was the highest-drafted pitcher alumni (13th round in 2017) from of Mountain View since Spencer Moran was drafted in the 11th round in 2014 out of Concordia.

-In his sophomore season at GateWay Community College, Nordlin went 4-3 with a 1.91 ERA before being drafted by the Rangers. That season, he had 123 strikeouts to 17 walks in 85.0 innings for Geckos.

2023 SEASON

-Selected in the Minor League Rule 5 draft by the Minnesota Twins in December of 2022 and assigned to Double-A Wichita.

-Released by the Twins on June 4th and signed by the Rangers on June 6th.

2022 SEASON

-Designated as one of two "long relief" pitchers for Frisco, along with **Tai Tiedemann** at the beginning of the year.

-Promoted to Triple-A Round Rock for spot start on July 14th at El Paso, throwing 3.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits while striking out three and walking one.

-Made first Double-A start on July 27th at Springfield, throwing four shutout innings in a 5-2 win.

2021 SEASON

-Pitched in 20 games with 11 starts for High-A Hickory.

-Struggled as a starter, going 0-5 with a 6.48 ERA, but pitched well in relief: 3-0, 3.27 ERA.

-Nordlin's 83.0 innings were the second-most on the Crawdads, just trailing **Avery Weems** (85.1).

2019-2020 SEASON

-Missed entire 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Was one of team's most-used relievers in Arizona Fall League in 2020, (16.0 IP, 14 H, 9 R, 5 BB, 20 K).

2018 SEASON

-Playing with Short-Season Low-A Spokane, he led the Northwest League in strikeouts with 79 while being fourth in innings (88.1) and tied for fifth in ERA (3.82).
