BRATT AND PITCHING SHINE, RIDERS TAKE TIGHT GAME IN SAN ANTONIO:

The Frisco RoughRiders outlasted the San Antonio Missions 1-0 on Thursday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. Frisco (19-11, 63-36) scored their only run on the night in the second inning against Missions (14-16, 45-53) starter Austin Krob (3-9) when **Luis Mieses** ripped an RBI double down the right field line to make it 1-0. That score held as **Mitch Bratt** (1-0) earned the victory in his Double-A debut, throwing five innings while surrendering just one hit and striking out four to two walks in his start. The Frisco bullpen then combined to finish off the shutout with **Reid Birlingmair** throwing two innings and both **Robby Ahlstrom** and **Skylar Hales** tossing a scoreless frame. Hales took home his first Double-A save in the process. Offensively, the Riders collected 10 hits, but went just 1-for-15 with runners in scoring position. Mieses went 3-for-4 while both **Josh Hatcher** and **Cody Freeman** had two hits. Chaos ensued in the sixth inning when benches cleared, resulting in four ejections for Frisco (Manager **Carlos Cardoza**, Pitching Coach **Jon Goebel**, Development Coach **Kawika Emsley-Pai** and player **Alex De Goti**) and two for San Antonio (players Connor Hollis and Ripken Reyes). The win marked their 13th-straight win over the Missions this season. They are now 14-1 against San Antonio on the year.

ABIMELE-LECTRIC:

Riders slugger **Abimelec Ortiz** has been crushing the baseball recently. While he is hitting well over his last 14 games, batting .327 (18-for-55)/.393/.564/.957 with four doubles, three home runs, eight RBIs and nine runs scored, the success goes back even further. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting just .176/.241/.309/.550, but has hammered the ball in 25 games since, batting .291/.380/.465/.845. He has raised his average 39 points (.210), his slugging percentage 45 points (.355) and his OPS 89 points (.639) in the last 25 games.

MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders face their division opponents for the third time this season, but the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2023, Frisco went 13-11 against San Antonio and have gone 55-26 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021, including 32-8 at the Wolff. In the 15 games, in which they are 14-1, they have a 2.25 team ERA, outscoring the Missions 79-42. They have now won 13-straight games against the Missions this year. **Josh Hatcher** has driven in 12 runs over his 13 games against the Missions, hitting .367 with an .869 OPS.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .700 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 28-21 with a 3.23 ERA, but a +26 run differential while averaging 4.1 runs per game and owning a .641 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .339/.398/.594/.992 at home this season with nine of his 12 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 23 games, he is hitting .307 (27-for-88)/.404/.545/.949 with eight doubles, two triples, three home runs and 15 RBIs. Over his last 20 games, he is batting .320 (24-for-75)/.429/.573/1.002 with six doubles, two triples, three home runs and 15 RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .316 (6-for-19) with three doubles and a .909 OPS for the Riders.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.02 ERA, which is also the third-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.49), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .227 BAA is on pace to be the best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT KUMAR

-Pronounced "KA-mar", not "KOO-mar".

-Son of Tracy and Lalitha Rocker. Tracy played defensive tackle for Auburn in the 1980s. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2004 and is the current defensive line coach for the Tennessee Titans. Uncle, David, was a DT for the Rams in the early 1990s as well.

-His name "Kumar" translates to "prince" or "young child" in Hindi as a nod to his mother's Indian heritage. Mother's parents emigrated from India to Maryland in 1965.

-Drafted originally by the Colorado Rockies in the 38th round of the 2018 draft after being named the Gatorade Georgia Baseball Player of the Year at North Oconee High School in Bogart, Georgia, but did not sign. Parents valued education and he chose to go to college.

-Played football for two years at North Oconee as well, but chose baseball.

-Broke out as a star at Vanderbilt University as a freshman in 2019, winning College World Series Most Outstanding Player for the Commodores' championship team, going 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA in the College World Series. Additionally named D1Baseball.com and Baseball America Freshman of the Year and The Tennessean 2019 Sportsman of the Year after a 12-5 season with a 3.25 ERA over 22 games with 16 starts. In 99.2 innings, he struck out 114 with 21 walks.

-His freshman season was highlighted by a no-hitter against Duke in the Super Regional round. He walked just two while striking out 19 batters in the 131-pitch no-no.

-After a COVID-shortened 2020 season, he teamed up with former RoughRider and Ranger pitcher **Jack Leiter** once again to create one of the best 1-2 punches in college baseball history. In 2021, Rocker was a unanimous First Team All-American, leading the nation with 14 wins and 179 strikeouts over his 20 starts (122.0 innings) with a 2.73 ERA.

-Drafted by the Rangers in 2022 after year in Indy Ball. *see 2022 season below*

2024 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com. Ranked as the No. 3 prospect when he joined the RoughRiders on July 26th.

-Made Double-A debut on July 26th in front of 9,151 fans at Riders Field, striking out four in his first two innings and finishing with four strikeouts over his three innings, allowing just a two-out single in the first inning to Dodgers No. 1 prospect Dalton Rushing.

2023 SEASON

-Made Rangers MiLB debut with High-A Hickory, going 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA, striking out 42 over 28.0 innings to just seven walks. His 37.8 percent strikeout rate was tied for eighth among all MiLB players with at least six starts.

-Was removed from start on 5/17 with elbow discomfort and underwent "Tommy John" surgery (performed by Rangers team physician Dr. Keith Meister) on 5/22. He missed the remainder of the season.

2022 SEASON

-Drafted by the New York Mets in the 1st round of the 2021 draft (10th overall), but did not sign.

-Prior to being drafted by Rangers, played for Independent Tri-City Valley Cats, making five starts, going 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA with 35 strikeouts to four walks over 20 innings. Valley Cats (in Troy, NY) was managed by former Ranger Pete Incaviglia.

-Did not see action in Rangers system after 2022 draft.
