THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge wrap-up a 12-game Texas Road Trip today. The Wind Surge won a shortened series in Amarillo taking three of five games and earned the franchise first ever series win in Amarillo. The Surge need a win this afternoon to manage a sweep, Missions lead the series 3-2. The team just past the half way point of the first half and the Wind Surge are in 4th place four and a half games back of the division lead.

TEXAS TWO STOP- The Wind Surge will play in two cities as part of this Texas roadtrip. The Surge are 67-68 all-time in the Lonestar State. The Surge are 5-5 on this trip.

SURGE TOP MISSIONS - The Wichita Wind Surge (18-19) defeated the San Antonio Missions (14-24) 5-2 in game five of their six-game series Saturday night at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium as the bottom half of Wichita's lineup powered the offense with seven hits and two home runs. Maddux Houghton, Andrew Cossetti and Jorel Ortega each recorded multi-hit performances from the lower third of the order. Ortega turned in one of his strongest all-around games of the season, blasting his first home run of the year while making multiple standout defensive plays at second base. Cossetti also homered in the win, crushing a 110 mph solo shot for his second homer of the season. Ricardo Olivar added his 10th multi-RBI performance of the year, while Kyle DeBarge extended his on-base streak to 10 games. Wichita's pitching staff also delivered a strong performance as five pitchers combined to allow just two runs. Jose Olivares bounced back impressively from his previous outing, striking out three over two scoreless innings while flashing a fastball that topped out at 98 mph. Alejandro Hidalgo and Luis Quiñones each notched scoreless relief appearances to help secure the win.

AGAINST THE MISSIONS - Wichita has dropped 13 of its last 16 against the Missions going back to last season. The Wind Surge trail the all-time series to San Antonio 20-33. The Wind Surge were 2-10 last season against the Missions, going 1-5 in The Alamo City. The Wind Surge are 11-18 all-time in San Antonio.

ON THE HILL - The Surge will start Eli Jones today, it will be his second start with Wichita and his second against San Antonio. He pitched five innings on Wednesday and allowed 2 unearned runs. Jones has appeared in ten games this season. He was 2-1 with a 4.46 ERA this season at Cedar Rapids in nine games. The 22-year-old was drafted in 2024 from the University of South Carolina. He pitched in 23 games last season at Fort Myers.

AMICK OF A WEEK– Billy Amick has a team-leading 11 home runs, is batting .263 on the trip, 10x38 with 5HR and 13 RBI in his last nine games. He has moved to second in the league in homers and second in league with 32 RBI!

OLLIE– Ricardo Olivar is second on the team with ten home runs, 3rd in Texas League and fourth in the league with 30 RBI. In his last 20 games, he is (23x73) .315 all ten of his home runs, 23 RBI. He has 10 multi-RBI games this season

HOMER RUN LEADERS- Wichita leads the Texas League with 64 home runs and has three hitters ranked among the league's top five in home runs. The team is second in all of Class AA. 39 of the 64 home runs have been solo shots this season. 13 different Surge players have gone yard and seven have had multi homer games.

STRIKE OUTS! The Wind Surge have dealt 346 strikeouts and the team has 16 games of double digits. Wind Surge hitters have been punched out 391 times, third most in the league. Friday the team struckout a franchise record 20 times, the team has struck out 17 times or more four times this season. The club has been struck out 17 times or more five times in franchise history.

THE PEN- Wichita relievers have pitched a league leading 190 innings so far this season. An average of 5 plus innings per game. The teams pen has earned the win in 17 of the 18 team wins, the bullpen has a 5.21 ERA, starters are at 4.50. Wichita has seven blown saves, third most in the Texas League. Surge starters are 1-11, fewest wins in the league

RECORD BREAKER - Jaylen Nowlin appeared in his 80th career Wind Surge game on Saturday, he ties John Stankiewicz (80) with most games ever appeared in. His 14 wins are tied for third, trail Aaro Rozek by two. Nowlin is second with 209K's, and fourth with innings pitched.

ICT NOTES – Andrew Cossetti extended his on-base streak to nine games and hit his second home run of the season, recorded his fourth multi-hit game and posted a season-high three hits. Jorel Ortega hit his first home run of the season and recorded his third multi-hit performance of the year. Maddux Houghton tallied his seventh multi-hit game and has hit safely in five of his last six contests. 15 of the 18 wins the team have scored five or more runs. The Surge have dealt 146 walks, second fewest in the Texas League.

In his Class AA Debut he pitched five innings allowed 2 unearned runs.

He was 2-1 with a 4.46 ERA this season at Cedar Rapid with nine games. The 22-year-old was drafted in 2024 from the University of South Carolina. He pitched in 23 games last season at Fort Myers. Jones, a junior righthanded pitcher from Peachtree City, Ga., made 17 appearances with 15 starts for the Gamecocks in 2024, striking out 56 batters in 68.2 innings pitched and winning three games. He had a perfect game through the first six innings in a win over Vanderbilt on March 23. Jones allowed just one run while striking out six in six innings in a win over Florida on April 12. In the three years at Carolina, Jones has eight wins and a 4.76 ERA.
