

LAST GAME

The Baysox picked up their second walk-off win of the season Friday night with a 3-2 comeback victory over the Harrisburg Senators in 10 innings. Bowie fell behind early with an RBI double from James Wood in the top of the first, plating Robert Hassell III who led off the game with a single, before Leonel Valera singled in the second inning, eventually coming home to score on a wild pitch to make it 2-0 Harrisburg. Bowie would cut the deficit in half on a John Rhodes solo home run in the bottom of the third, but the Baysox struggled throught the evenin knocking runners home, as the Baysox were 0 for their first 11 on the night with runners in scoring positon, stranding 15 runners on base in the process. Bowie was still kept within striking distance, as starter Justin Armbruester went five frames, allowing no further damage after the second, before right-hander Connor Gillispie went four shutout frames, striking out seven. The Baysox were able to tie the game in the bottom of the eighth with a solo home run down the right field line by Heston Kjerstad - his eleventh of the season, to tie the game at two. The contest would remain tied into the tenth, when righthander Kade Strowd struck out back-to-back hitters for the Baysox to strand the go-ahead run at third. Noelberth Romero then came to the plate against Jack Sinclair in the bottom half of the tenth with runners at the corners and one out, lining a single through the drawn-in Harrisburg infield to win the game for Bowie

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Senators enter tonight with a record of 24-24 - good for third place in the Southwest division and two-and-a-half games out of first. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg split a six-game series in Reading last week, losing each of the last three contests. The Senators won five of six in Harrisburg against the Baysox back in the second week of May. Harrisburg has the fewest home runs (34) and road home runs (17) hit in the Eastern League, and the second fewest in Double-A, while the Bowie staff has allowed the second-most home runs at home (38) in the league. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the Nationals' top two prospects, according to MLB Pipeline - James Wood (No. 1 WSH/No. 7 overall) and Robert Hassell III (No. 2 WSH/No. 44 overall) patrolling the outfield. RHPs Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 27 WSH) alongside LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 23 WSH) feature on the Harrisburg pitching staff.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Alex Troop is the projected starter for the Senators tonight. Troop's 4.46 ERA stems from his 40 hits allowed in 42.1 innings, including nine home runs allowed in nine starts. Troop last pitched on Sunday in Reading, where he had one of his better starts of the season. . The south paw allowed a single run in five innings on five hits with three walks and three strikeouts. Troop had a troublesome outing against the Baysox on 5/11, where he took the loss, only going three innings, and allowed a season-high five runs, including three home runs. Troop owns a 9.68 career ERA against Bowie (19 ER in 17.2 IP). A 9th round pick of the Nationals back in 2017 out of Michigan State, Troop features a fastball, curveball, and changeup.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 17 doubles and is second with 25 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles prospect, per MLB Pipeline, already has three doubles in this series and five in his last six games. Mayo also leads the Baysox with 24 RBI on the season. In addition to his power and production, Mayo paces the Baysox with a .400 on-base percentage and 27 walks. In addition to his double and two free passes last night, Mayo was also hit by a pitch, marking the second time this season he reached base four times in a game, and the eleventh ocassion he reached at least three times

SLIPPING UP

After committing five errors in the past two games, the Baysox continue to lead Double-A with 52 errors this season. Last year, Bowie had a lauded infield defense, and committed only 100 errors in a full 138-game season, and an average number in the Eastern League. At this point in the season. Bowie is on pace for 153 total errors in 2023.

STRUGGLES WITH THE SENS

The Baysox have outhit the Senators in nine of the ten contests between the teams this season, and by a 84-63 total. However, last night was just Bowie's third win in 10 games against Harrisburg in 2023. In total this season, the Baysox are 15-13 in games where they outhit their opponent.

DONTA' DAZZLES

OF Donta' Williams has hits in four straight, and six of his past seven games for the first time in his Double-A career. After a 4-for-51 stretch (.078) in the beginning of May, Williams is 9 for his last 19 (474) with a pair of home runs and four doubles. Williams has also shown improved plate discipline, with six walks in his last seven games, helping his on-base percentage jump 61 points during the stretch. Williams reached base four times last night for the first time in Double-A, and the sixth time overall, in his career.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 1-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Priching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitch-ing coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Onoles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Rvan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Hermann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox devel-opment coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to season.
