NOTES AND NUGGETS

CLIPPING COLUMBUS

Games at Werner Park between the Storm Chasers and Clippers have heavily favored Omaha since the Chasers joined the International League in 2021.

Since 2021, Omaha has a 22-10 record in the regular season over Columbus at Werner Park, 24-11 including 2024's International League Championship Series.

Over the last 18 games at Werner Park (since June 26, 2022), the Storm Chasers are 16-2 against the Clippers ... the Chasers won the final meeting between the two teams in 2022, then swept the 6-game series in 2023, June 13-23 ... Omaha won 5 of 6 over Columbus during the regular season last year, then took 2 out of 3 in the playoffs and have won the first two games this week.

In the 18-game span where Omaha is 16-2 against Columbus, the Chasers have outscored the Clippers 130-79 while outhitting them 175-149.

PITCH, PLEASE!

After Storm Chasers pitchers worked a 5.36 ERA in April (3rd-worst in the league), the staff has worked a 3.49 ERA in May (5th-best in the IL) ... the drop of 1.87 in ERA is the 2nd-best in the league from April to May.

Last Saturday's 9-0 win in Louisville was Omaha's 2nd shutout win of the season, part of a stretch of 19.0 scoreless innings from the 3rd inning Friday through the 3rd inning Sunday ... that is the staff's longest scoreless streak of the season to pass a pair of 12.0-inning streaks.

After a 21-game stretch without a quality start (April 9 to May 3) and just 2 in the month of April, Omaha has 4 in the month of May, two each from Thomas Hatch and tonight's starter, Luinder Avila.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has the highest success rate on the basepaths in the IL.

Omaha has successfully stolen 55 bases this year, and only been caught 8 times ... 55 steals rank 5th in the International League and 6th among Triple-A teams.

55-for-63 in steal attempts is a 87.3% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd among full-season Minor League teams (1st: San Jose Giants, 93.0%, 66-for-71).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits at the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 385 strikeouts this season ... that is tied 2nd in the league and tied 3rd at the Triple-A level, 4 strikeouts behind the top Triple-A team (Sacramento).

Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.29 K/9, which ranks 4th both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 390 strikeouts through 39 games, an average of 10.00 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,490 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder John Rave has been a consistent presence at the top of the Omaha all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

John enters today on a 10-game hitting streak, tying a career-best ... the 3rd-longest active streak in the league, Rave has hit .400 (16-for-40) with a 1.289 OPS since May 3 ... he last hit safely in 10 games from June 11-25, 2023, his final game in Double-A to his first 9 games with Omaha that year, a stretch where he hit .417 (15-for-36) with a 1.238 OPS, including 6 games against Columbus.

Rave leads the league lead in triples (4), is 1st in runs scored (35), 8th in total bases (69) and tied 7th in stolen bases (13) ... in addition to these categories, he also leads Omaha in hits (38) and is tied for the team lead in home runs (6).

Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 33 of 39 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 14 of 33 games (.424 OBP leading off the 1st inning), including 4 straight games last week, Wednesday to Saturday ... that includes 9 hits (3 singles, 3 doubles, 3 homers), 4 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 3 leadoff homers this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues.

Since 2023, Rave's 41 hits, 11 doubles, 72 total bases and 22 runs against Columbus are the most of any International League player in that span ... over 35 games against the Clippers, he's hit .328 (41-for-125) with a .995 OPS, 6 homers and 21 RBI.

GET RATIOED

A pair of Storm Chasers have some of the best ratios in the Minors right now.

With 32 walks this season to just 18 strikeouts, Nick Loftin's 1.778 BB/K rank as the 3rd-best walk-to-strikeout rate in the Minors (min. 100 PA) ... his .206 walks per plate appearance is the 20th-best in Minor League Baseball.

Right-hander Andrew Hoffmann has struck out 31 batters in 20.1 innings, with just 6 walks ... his 13.72 K/9 ranks as the 2nd-most strikeouts-per-nine-innings in Triple-A (min 20.0 IP), while 5.17 K/BB is the 11th-best strikeout-to-walk rate.

LUINDER AVILA SCOUTING REPORT

The Royals signed a 16-year-old Avila out of Venezuela during the 2018 international signing period. Ever since, it's been steady progress for the now-23-year-old who spent most of the 2024 season at Double-A before making one Triple-A start. Avila posted a 1.37 WHIP over 19 starts for Northwest Arkansas. It was the first time since 2022 that he didn't throw over 100 innings, as he missed about six weeks with a minor oblique injury. In five games (three starts) in the Arizona Fall League, Avila posted a 3.07 ERA with 17 strikeouts and eight walks in 14 2/3 innings. The Royals added him to their 40-man roster to protect him from the Rule 5 Draft in November.

Last year marked the first time Avila missed significant time; he's been a durable young pitcher for the Royals, and those innings don't go unnoticed. Avila's comfort zone with his fastball is 94-95 mph with flashes of the upper 90s, and the pitch has natural cut and ride. To help him command the arm'side of the plate, Avila introduced a two-seamer that is about the same velo as his four-seamer. He throws both a slider and curveball, and both can miss bats. They can sometimes morph into each other, so the separation is a work in progress. A fringe-average changeup rounds out Avila's arsenal, a pitch he's still developing with a focus on backing off the 89-91 mph velocity. Avila has near-average command but hides the ball well in his delivery, and as he's grown, his presence on the mound has gotten stronger.

Now that he's on the 40-man, Avila could make his big league debut at some point in 2025. He needs more development time in Omaha, particularly with his secondary pitches and command, but will be part of the Triple-A depth to begin the season. Avila will continue to start but might be someone whom the Royals can rely on in different roles depending on need for a long reliever or a swingman.

Baseball America

Scouting Grades: Fastball: 55 | Curveball: 60 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 45

Track Record: It's been a slow trek through the Royals system for Avila since first signing in 2018, but he's proven enough value to get a spot on the 40-man roster. The Venezuelan righthander was on the way to a strong season until a rib cage injury in early July put him on the sidelines for seven weeks. He returned in time to get three more starts at Double-A Northwest Arkansas and one with Triple-A Omaha. His 3.81 ERA and .229 opponent batting average in Double-A were among the best numbers of his career. Avila finished his year in the Arizona Fall League, where he pitched in the annual Fall Stars Game as well as throwing two scoreless innings in the championship game.

Scouting Report: Avila's four-seam fastball has glove-side cutting action and sits 93-95 mph, touching 98, with ride. A development goal will be to improve the location and consistency of the pitch. His best pitch is a high-spin two-plane curveball at 79-83 mph and he uses it to get swings and misses with its downward movement that's tough to barrel. His 87-91 mph hard changeup is still in development, a pitch with natural sink that gets whiffs, and could be an average offering with more consistency. He repeats his delivery and has been called a sneaky competitor.

The Future: The Royals added Avila to the 40-man roster in November. He projects as a valuable innings-eater at the back of the rotation but could thrive in a bullpen role.

- Avila is making his **8th start with Omaha** this season ... made Omaha's 2025 Breaking Roster, after ending the 2024 season in Triple-A with the Storm Chasers ... was added to Kansas City's 40-Man roster this offseason.
- Playing his 7th professional season this year, all have come in the Royals organization.
- Since 2021, Avila ranks 2nd among Royals Minor League arms in innings (403.2) and 3rd in strikeouts (374) ... he's allowed just 24 home runs in 453.0 pro innings, for a 0.48 HR/9 ... in that span (since 2018), only two qualified Minor League pitchers (min. 400.0 IP) had a better mark: the best is Luis Devers (0.37 HR/9, Cubs org).
- Ranks 7th among qualifiers in the International League in WHIP (1.09), 8th in opponents' average (.203).** *Has thrown 2 straight quality starts, allowed just 1 earned run in his last 14.0 innings ... since the 4th inning on April 29, has a 0.64 ERA with 7 hits, 1 walk and 13 strikeouts in that span.*

Made his 2nd consecutive quality start, his team-leading 3rd quality start of the season ... for just the 3rd time in his career, threw 7.0 innings, on a season-high 87 pitches ... retired his first 7 hitters, with 1-2-3 innings in the 1st and 2nd ... allowed back-to-back singles with 1 out in the 3rd inning, then retired his final 14 hitters, with 1-2-3 innings in the 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th ... for the first time this year, did not walk a batter, while 8 strikeouts were his 2nd-most in a start ... Arguably the best start of his professional career, the 6th time in his career throwing 6.0 or more scoreless innings, just the 2nd time doing so without walking a batter, 2nd time doing so with 5+ strikeouts.

- Pitched 3.0 innings of relief (4th to 6th) of the Royals' Spring Breakout game, on March 14 @ Arizona.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.
