POST-BREAK PATS: Dating back to 2022, Somerset's 125-82 (.604) record post All-Star break is the best in the Eastern League. The Patriots are the only EL team to have a post-All-Star break winning percentage above .600 in that span. That includes a 32-18 post-break record in 2024 and 37-20 record in 2023 that powered the Patriots to the Eastern League's best second half record each year.

CAN'T STOP CONNOR: Since hitting a 406-foot grand slam to center field as his first Double-A home run on 6/16 @POR, Connor McGinnis is slashing .322/.372/.621 with 5 HR, 18 RBI and 15 XBH across his last 25 games. His 15 XBH in that span rank second in the Eastern League and tied for fourth in Double-A, while his .993 OPS during this stretch leads all Somerset batters. In his first 20 Double-A games, he slashed .221/.312/.235 with 1 XBH, 4 RBI and a .547 OPS.

MANY RBI MORALES: Coby Morales' 63 RBI enter today tied for the Eastern League lead, while ranking third in the Yankees minor league system and tied for eighth in Double-A. In his 76th game of the season on July 4 vs. Hartford, Morales powered a three-run HR to become the fastest EL batter to 60 RBI since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (NH - 2018 - 61 GP).

JACE THE ACE: With two doubles on Friday, Jace Avina extended his hit streak to a team-best seven games and his on-base streak to a team-best 10 games. During the seven-game hit streak, Avina is 8-for-30 (.267 AVG) with 5 XBH, 6 R and 5 RBI. Avina enters today ranking among the Eastern League leaders with 59 R (2nd), 39 XBH (T-2nd), 17 HR (T-6th), .539 SLG (7th), .896 OPS (7th) and 49 RBI (9th).

BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS: The Somerset Patriots enter today leading all Double-A teams with 127 HR, which also ranks 7th in MiLB. The Patriots have recorded multiple HR in 37 of 88 games this season, already surpassing their total of 35 multi-home run games during the entire 2025 season (in 138 games).

WHERE'S THE CATCH? In the first 77 games this season from April through May, Somerset's catching corps batted .212 with 10 XBH (4 HR), 31 RBI and a .555 OPS. In 11 games during July, Somerset's catching corps is batting .338 with 6 XBH (2 HR), 12 RBI and an .856 OPS. Miguel Palma enters today on a six-game on-base streak that includes his first two three-hit games of the season. Over his last eight games, Palma is 11-for-29 (.379 AVG) with 2 HR, 1 2B, 8 RBI, 7 R and 3 BB (1.059 OPS). Manny Palencia enters today with hits in seven of his last eight games, including his second and third three-hit games of the season. During the streak, he is 12-for-32 (.375 AVG) with 3 RBI and 3 XBH (.863 OPS). In last week's series opener, Tomas Frick pieced together his first Double-A three-hit game.

SOMERSET SHOVING: On Sunday, the Patriots took a no-hit bid into the eighth inning and ended the game with 15 strikeouts. On Friday, Somerset's pitching staff recorded its second consecutive game with 15 strikeouts and fifth consecutive game with double digit punchouts. With 62 punchouts across its last five games, Somerset's active five-game streak with 10-plus strikeouts leads the Eastern League and ranks second in Double-A. The Patriots recorded at least 15 strikeouts in back-to-back games for the second time this season and first time since playing Portland at TD Bank Ballpark on April 30 and May 1. Somerset is one of four Eastern League teams to accomplish that feat this year and the only Eastern League team to do it multiple times. Somerset's 924 K this season lead Double-A and rank 7th in MiLB.

ALL-STAR WEEKEND ROUNDUP: Somerset was well represented at the All-Star festivities in Philadelphia. On Sunday, Patriots manager James Cooper was the third base coach for the AL at the MLB All-Star Futures Game. Meanwhile, after being selected to replace Yankees No. 4 Prospect Carlos Lagrange (SWB 7-day IL), Patriots reliever Ben Grable threw two pitches in the seventh inning to retire MIL No. 2 Prospect Luis Peña. Plus, Ben Rice (1-for-2, RBI) and Cam Schlittler became the first former Somerset Patriots to ever be named Major League All-Stars.

FIRST INNING FIREWORKS: Having scored in the first inning in each of its last three games, Somerset's 65 first inning runs this season are tied for 1st in the Eastern League and tied for 2nd in Double-A. The Patriots' 18 first-inning HR are T-3rd in Double-A.

2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.

Started season on Somerset's 7-day IL. Began a rehab assignment with Single-A Tampa on May 8 before being transferred to High-A Hudson Valley on May 26. Across six rehab outings prior to suiting up with Somerset, Hampton posted a 5.59 ERA, 1.14 WHIP, .225 BAA with 19 K to 6 BB in 19.1 IP.

Earned a non-roster invite to MLB Spring Training with the Yankees, but underwent Tommy John Surgery and did not pitch in 2025.

Earned a non-roster invite to Yankees MLB Spring Training and pitched in one game, hurling one shutout inning with two strikeouts and one walk vs. Tampa Bay on 2/27. Following the outing, Hampton was shut down from throwing for 3-6 weeks with a UCL sprain and received a PRP injection in early March. He began the 2024 season on the 60-day IL, before commencing a rehab assignment on 7/1 with the FCL Yankees. On 7/30, Hampton was reinstated off Somerset's 60-day IL and made his non-rehab season debut on 8/2 @BOW with 3.2 scoreless innings, allowing 3 H, 2 BB and 4 K. Hampton started again on 8/10 vs. BNG with two scoreless innings, before being pulled from his start prematurely. He was shut down for the remainder of the 2024 season with a groin injury.

After not pitching professionally in 2022, Hampton began his pro career with High-A Hudson Valley in 2023, making his debut for the Renegades on 4/11 vs. ABD. Hampton went 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA in nine High-A starts before he was promoted to Double-A Somerset on 6/15. At the time of his promotion, Hampton's 77 strikeouts led the Yankees organization and ranked 5th in all of MiLB. After beginning the season ranked as the No. 24 Yankees prospect by MLB Pipeline, by mid-season Hampton had ascended to No. 4 (top pitching prospect) in the publication's rankings.

Hampton pitched two seasons at Texas Tech University, where as a sophomore, he posted a 4.29 ERA over 15 total appearances (11 starts), while ranking third on the team with 72 K in 56.2 IP. In his final college outing (Statesboro Regional vs. Notre Dame), Hampton struck out 12 batters, matching the program record for most single-game strikeouts in an NCAA tournament game. During his freshman season, Hampton posted a 3.84 ERA in 18 total appearances with 34 K in 44.1 IP. When Hampton played for the Patriots in 2023, he was one of three Texas Tech Red Raiders to do so, joining Clayton Beeter and T.J. Rummfield.

Attended Kilgore High School in Kilgore, TX, which has a population of about 1,500. Hampton finished his high school career with 284 strikeouts and a 1.94 ERA in 162 IP, earning First Team All-State and District MVP honors his senior year. He was also awarded 2020 Perfect Game Preseason All-American and First Team All-Region honors and helped Kilgore reach the 2019 State Championship game his junior year. Grew up a Dodgers fan in Texas and modeled his game off of fellow east Texas native Clayton Kershaw. Hampton had watched Kershaw pitch in high school and although he doesn't remember it, always remembered his name and followed his career to the big leagues.

Selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech as a draft eligible sophomore, signing for a \$497,500 bonus (\$233,500 over slot value).
