TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Oklahoma City face off for game three on Thursday night with first pitch set for 7:05 p.m. at Dell Diamond. Express RHP A.J. Alexy is slated to take the mound up against Dodgers RHP Yefry Ramírez.

LET'S RECAP

Round Rock was held to under 10 hits for the first time since April 29 as Oklahoma City earned a 13-4 victory on Wednesday. Oklahoma City scored three runs in the first two innings powered by a two-run home run from 2B Andy Burns. Round Rock responded in the bottom of the second when C Meibrys Viloria and DH Matt Carpenter scored, trimming the OKC lead to 3-2. In the third, Dodgers 1B Jake Lamb cranked a two-run shot to give Oklahoma City a 5-2 lead before Burns hit a sacrifice fly that scored LF Stefan Romero. Express LF Steele Walker hit a solo home run in the bottom of the inning to make it 6-3. The Dodgers dropped a four-spot in the sixth to take a commanding 10-3 lead. OKC's final three runs crossed home plate in the eighth frame when Burns, RF Jason Martin and DH Omar Estévez all scored. Round Rock managed to put one more on the board in the bottom of the eighth when Hernandez came home as 2B Nash Knight doubled. The Express couldn't add more to their total as the 13-4 difference held to be final.

ALEXY UP ON THE BUMP

Express RHP A.J. Alexy looks to make his seventh start of the season on Thursday against the Dodgers. Through his first six appearances, the righty has tossed to a 5.04 ERA (14 ER/25.0 IP) and has walked 20 while striking out 24.

WALK IT OUT

The Express worked 10 walks for the second game in a row, and third time this season, on Wednesday night. SS Josh Smith drew four, which is the most walks by an Express player in a single contest this season. OF Zach Reks held the previous high with three on April 8 against El Paso. Smith is tied for the team lead with teammate 3B Davis Wendzel as both have totaled 14 walks after Wendzel earned two free bases during the game.

GETTING SETTLED

Round Rock LF Steele Walker has recorded a hit in all six games that he has played in since being activated off the team's injured list on May 3. On Wednesday, the outfielder hit his third Express home run of 2022, and first of the year at Dell Diamond, a 393-foot dinger to left field.

STILL STREAKING

E-Train C Meibrys Viloria extended his hitting streak to 13 on Wednesday after going 1-for-3 with a run scored and a walk. Viloria has the second-longest active hitting streak in Triple-A behind teammate OF Leody Taveras, whose active streak sits at 17 and is the longest in all of Minor League Baseball.

FUN FACTS ON THE MOUND

After coming out of the bullpen on Wednesday, Round Rock RHP Jason Bahr threw a first-pitch strike to 12 of the 13 batters that he faced during his three innings on the bump. Relievers RHP Nick Snyder (0.1 IP) and RHP Jesus Tinoco (1.0 IP) finished the night with scoreless outings.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS

On Wednesday, the Texas Rangers announced multiple roster moves that affected the Express. LHP Kolby Allard was recalled by the Rangers while OF Zach Reks was optioned back to Round Rock. Through six appearances with the Rangers, Reks hit .286 (4-14) with one double and three RBI while scoring two runs. RHP Spencer Patton was sent back to Texas upon completion of his Major League rehab assignment before being optioned to Round Rock. Thursday saw Allard optioned to Round Rock and RHP Josh Sborz recalled by Texas.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
