FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders dropped their first fifth-straight road contest after falling 7-3 to the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels on Friday night at Hammond Stadium. Javier Rivas plated a pair of runs in the top of the second to give Bradenton an early 2-0 lead before the Mussels scored the next six runs.

JUST WALKING AROUND: After collecting seven walks over his first 84 plate appearances, Marauders OF Braylon Bishop has eight over his last 29 plate appearances

SINGLES NIGHT: The Bradenton Maraduers have collected 15 hits over the last two games in which they've been outscored 9-4 in a pair of losses. Their last 16 hits at the plate have all been singles with their last extra-base hit coming from Axiel Plaz, a double in the ninth inning on Wednesday at LECOM Park.

GIVE ME MORE MUSSELS: Marauders' OF Eddy Rodriguez has continued to hit well against Fort Myers this season. In 14 meetings this year, Rodriguez is hitting .360/.431/.400 with two doubles, nine RBIs, seven walks, five stolen bases, and seven runs scored. This series, he is 6-for-15 with two RBIs, four walks, and two runs scored while also stealing a base. Six of his eight multi-hit contests have occurred against the Mussels this year including a season-high three hit night on May 3 at LECOM Park.

LIGHT TOWER POWER: Axiel Plaz mashed a game-tying solo-home run in the third inning against Fort Myers on Wednesday to bring his season-total to 10. Since his promotion on May 17, Plaz's 10 bombs are the most in Single-A. Fellow Pirates Minor League catchers Nick Cimillo (GBO) has 14 and Shawn Ross (GBO) has 11 in that same time frame.

NO BREAKS: The Bradenton Marauders are currently in the middle of their longest stretch of the 2024 season without a day off. After having an off-day on Monday, June 24, the Marauders will play 12-straight games against the Clearwater Threshers and the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. The Marauders will then have back-to-back off days on July 7 and July 8.

AMERICA'S BIRTHDAY: Monday is the start of a mini three-game home & home series with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels. Fort Myers enters the week with 1.5 game lead for first place in the second half of the Florida State League West Division.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games, the second-most in the FSL, with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. In June, Bradenton hit 31 home runs in 26 games, which was the most in the FSL and all of Single-A. Bradenton has homered 19 of their last 22 games. The most home runs hit in a calendar month in franchise history is 34, achieved back in June of 2023. Bradenton needed to hit three on Sunday in Clearwater to tie the record. In July, Bradenton has hit five in their first five games with Axiel Plaz accounting for three of the five.

JAVVY'S MASHIN: In June, Javier Rivas slashed .341/.400/.646 with five doubles, a triple, six home runs, 13 RBIs, three walks, and 13 runs scored in 25 games. His seven home runs on the season are also a new career-high with his six in June tied for the most in Single-A. Rivas finished first in the Florida State League during the month of June in total bases (53), tied for first in home runs (six), second in batting (.341), slugging (.646) and OPS (1.046), tied for second in hits (28) and extra base hits (12) and sixth in OBP (.400).

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, RHP Khristian Curtis entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30. The Bradenton Marauders now hold eight of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system. RHP Mike Burrows, the No. 10 prospect is also rehabbing with Bradenton to bring the total to nine.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Thursday's loss against Fort Myers marked the Marauders' 28th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 16-12 record in those games with 54 of their first 81 (66.7%) games having been decided by three runs or less.
