WEDNESDAY: The Flying Squirrels had their four-game winning streak snapped with a 10-5 loss to the Yard Goats. Juan Guerweblesoft: The rights squirres had trief rour-game winning streak shapped with a 10-5 loss to the Yard Goats. Judh Guerero opened the scoring with a two-run single in the second for his first Double-A hit. In the third, Bladimir Restituyo opened a
3-0 lead with an RBI double. The Yard Goats extended the lead to 6-0 with an RBI triple by Adael Amador and a two-run homer
by Sterlin Thompson in the fourth. Victor Bericoto broke the shutout with an RBI single in the fifth and hit a two-run homer in
the seventh to close the score to 6-3. The Yard Goats pushed the lead to 8-3 with a sac bunt RBI by Nic Kent and an RBI single
by Thompson in the eighth. In the ninth, Zach Kokoska and Braxton Fulford hit back-to-back solo homers to stretch the Hartford
lead to 10-3. Bericoto brought in a run in the bottom of the ninth with a groundout, his fourth RBI of the game, and Andy Thomas
added an RBI single.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, in the fourth and fifth of a six-game series. This is the only series between the two teams this season. Last year, the two teams met for six games at Dunkin Park in Hartford, with Richmond winning four-of-six. This set is the Flying Squirrels' final series this year against an opponent from the Northeast Division. Thursday's game was rained out and will be made up as part of a doubleheader today. The Flying Squirrels are 4-2 in doubleheader games this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS had won four straight games prior to Friday's loss after going 4-12 in their previous 16 games from July 13-August 2. They had lost five straight games from Sunday through Friday before beating the Curve on Saturday night and Sunday afternoon. In their last five games since last Saturday, the Flying Squirrels are hitting a league-best .319 (58-for-182) dating back to Saturday night, which is the highest in the Eastern League during that time.

THE YARD GOATS clinched their first postseason appearance in franchise history by winning the Northeast Division in the Eastern League's first half with a 38-30 record, finishing 2.5 games ahead of Binghamton and Portland. The Yard Goats will face the second-half division champ in this year's Eastern League playoffs. For the season, the Yard Goats lead the Eastern League in stolen bases (158). Hartford's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including RHP Chase Dollander (No. 2), OF Adael Amador (No. 3), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 4), INF Sterlin Thompson (No. 7), LHP Sean Sullivan (No. 16), SS Ryan Ritter (No. 25), and RHP Zach Agnos (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes nine Hartford players, including Dollander (No. 1), Amador (No. 2), Fernandez (No. 4), Thompson (No. 6), Sullivan (No. 13), INF Warming Bernabel (No. 16), RHP Bradley Blalock (No. 20), LHP Mason Albright (No. 22) and LHP Luis Peralta (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his league-leading 22nd start of the season and the second of his career against the Yard Goats in Game 1. Last time out, Bertrand allowed five runs on a career-high 11 hits over 4.1 innings and struck out six in a no-decision at Altoona last Sunday afternoon. Over his six July starts, Bertrand went 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (9 ER/36.0 IP). This season, he leads the Eastern League and ranks tied for second in the minors in double plays induced (15). He also ranks second in the Eastern League in innings pitched (117.0) and groundball percentage (50.6%) and ranks ninth in ERA (3.69). This year, he has made eight scoreless starts, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wind (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

Right-hander **Nick Morreale** makes his third Double-A appearance and his second start of 2024 in Game 2. Last Saturday, he started against the Curve and threw four scoreless innings. In his Double-A debut on July 27 at The Diamond and worked 3.2 innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts. He was promoted to Double-A on July 26 after spending parts of four seasons in High-A with the Eugene Emeralds. This year, he went 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA in 25 bullpen appearances for Eugene. Morreale was selected in the 14th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Georgetown University. *For more on Morreale*, see page two.

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Sean Sullivan makes the second Double-A start of his career in Game 1. He made his Double-A debut last Saturday and threw four scoreless innings. In his final two High-A starts, he faced the Giants' Northwest League affiliate at Eugene on July 23 and 28, combining to throw 10 scoreless innings with 20 strikeouts, one walk and five hits allowed. With High-A Spokane this season, Sullivan went 7-2 with a 2.16 ERA in 14 starts. At the time of his promotion, he ranked tied for second in wins (7) and tied for second in strikeouts (101) in the Northwest League. Sullivan was selected by the Rockies in the second round (46th overall) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Wake Forest. He is rated by Baseball America and MLB.com as the No. 13 Rockies prospect.

Right-hander Chase Dollander makes his fourth Double-A start in Game 2. He last pitched on Sunday at Reading and threw five innings, allowing one run with six strikeouts. Pitching in his first professional season, Dollander began the season with High-A Spokane and went 4-1 with a 2.83 ERA in 14 starts. At the time of his promotion on July 24, Dollander led the Northwest League in strikeouts (111). Dollander was selected in the first round (ninth overall) by the Rockies in 2023 out of the University of Tennessee, where he was the highest-drafted pitcher in program history. Dollander is rated by MLB.com as the No. 1 Rockies prospect and No. 2 by Baseball America. Among MiLB pitchers (min. 80 IP), Dollander ranks second in K/9 (13.39) and fourth in strikeout percentage (34.9%).

HIT PARADE: Dating back to Saturday, the Flying Squirrels have 58 hits over five games, combining for a league-leading .319 (58-for-182) batting average. They had at least 10 hits in four of those games. On Saturday in a 4-1 win at Altoona, the Flying Squirrels had 10 hits. On Sunday afternoon in the series finale, they scored nine runs and tied a season high with 17 hits. In the opener of the current series against the Yard Goats, the Flying Squirrels picked up 12 hits in a 10-7 win. On Wednesday night, Richmond collected 11 hits and won, 5-2. They had eight hits in Friday's 10-5 loss.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 74 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 72. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. It is also tied for the second-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

KING OF THE HILL: Turner Hill is batting .343 (12-for-35) with two doubles, a triple and five RBIs in his last 10 games dating back to July 23, including three multi-hit games. Last Wednesday at Altoona, he picked up three hits, including a double. Last Thursday night, he belted a bases-clearing, three-run double. Since his Double-A debut on June 27, Hill is ranked eighth in the Eastern League in batting average (.297). On Friday night, he worked a career-high three walks.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 45 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .311 (56-for-180) with four homers, nine doubles, nine walks and 28 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on Friday night off the scoreboard in left-center. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 17-of-37 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .310 (45-for-145) in that stretch.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,636), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: One of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, which is SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
