SUNDAY: Aaron Bracho hit a solo homer in the seventh inning and the Captains spun a two-hit shutout to beat South Bend, 1-0. Mason Hickman held the Cubs to one hit over six scoreless frames and struck out nine to earn the win. Kevin Kelly pitched a one-two-three seventh inning. Jerson Ramirez took care of the Cubs in order in the eighth, but left with an apparent injury shortly after allowing a leadoff single in the ninth. Nathan Ocker worked around a walk to get the last three outs, stranding the tying run on second and the winning run on first to earn the

NAILBITERS: The Captains took four of six games from the Cubs last week in South Bend. All six games were decided by three or fewer runs, including four games decided by one run. The first three games of the series entered the ninth inning tied and the Captains won all three, scoring the go-ahead run in the top of the ninth.

NINTH INNING OFFENSE: The Captains scored nine runs in the ninth inning last series. That accounts for 34.6% of the team's runs in the series (26 R).

SCORING FIRST: The Captains have scored first seven games in a row. They are 4-3 in that span.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 1.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels and Great Lakes Loons for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 3.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 12.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless

WHO'S HOT?

José Tena: Since August 1. Tena has slashed .294/.353/.569 (.922 OPS). Tena is second in the league with eight homers and third in slugging percentage since the start of August.

Christian Cairo: 11-for-34 (.324) in 10 games since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 24. Jhonkensy Noel: Slashing .305/.369/.525 (.895 OPS) in his first 15 games with the Captains since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 17. Across three levels this year (Rookie, Low-A & High-A), Noel leads all Cleveland minor leaguers in OPS (1.022), slugging percentage (621) and ISO (.263).

Tim Herrin: Herrin did not allow an earned run for 11 consecutive appearances from July 21 through August 29. Herrin's streak spanned 18.2 innings before it was snapped on Wednesday by a Yonathan Perlaza home run. Since July 21, Herrin has posted a 1.05 ERA and lowered his season ERA from 3.72 to 2.66.

Kevin Kelly: Kelly has not allowed a run in seven consecutive appearances, spanning 8.1 innings. Since August 13, the right-hander has a 0.63 WHIP and a .120 opponent's batting average.

Xzavion Curry: Has a 1.44 ERA across his last five starts (4 ER, 25.0 IP) with 29 K against 4 BB.

TRAFFIC CHECK: Since August 1, the Captains' pitching staff owns the best WHIP (1.21) in the High-A Central League (fourth-best in all of High-A).

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

LAST TIME OUT: Coulter pitched 4.1 innings of shutout baseball at South Bend last Tuesday. The right-hander worked out of a bases-loaded jam in the first after giving up back-to-back walks and a single with one out. Coulter then got a double play to escape a first-and-second situation in the third. A one-out walk ended Coulter's night in the fifth inning with a pitch count of 82. Coulter did not factor in the decision in a 4-3 Captains win.

VS. DAYTON: Coulter is 2-1 in three starts against Dayton with a 7.71 ERA. His high ERA, however, is driven by his first start against the Dragons. Coulter allowed seven runs over 1.2 innings on June 5. In his two starts against Dayton since, Coulter has surrendered just three runs over 10 innings.

2019: Across 18 appearances Coulter compiled 36.1 innings out of the bullpen in the Arizona league and finished the season with a 2.23 ERA. After allowing at least one earned run in his first four appearances Coulter found his rhythm in July, only giving up one earned run eight appearances and 14.1 innings in the month. He began to stretch his arm out in August finishing the season with three straight appearances in which he threw three or more innings.

BEAR DOWN: Coulter had an up and down career at Mercer where he finished with a career 4.74 ERA. He bounced back and forth between a starting role and the bullpen where he accumulated five saves across his four-year career, including three as a senior in the first three games of the Bears season. His best season came as a senior. After starting the year in the bullpen he was moved to the rotation where he made 11 consecutive starts before bouncing back to the 'pen to finish the season. He completed the 2019 season with a career best 3.90 ERA.

THREE SPORT STAR: While at Buford High School Coulter starred as a basketball player and runner on the cross country team as well as the diamond. In 2015 he led the Wolves to a state championship his senior season
