Today: After a lovely 70-minute drive west, the Lugnuts open a six-game series with the archrival Whitecaps at LMCU Ballpark. (Interestingly, the Grand River runs alongside both teams' ballparks, splitting off from the Red Cedar River near Jackson Field.) The two ballclubs met in mid April in Lansing, where the Lugnuts dropped three straight games from recovered to win both games over the weekend to earn a six-game split. Lansing is coming off a 6-6 homestand, going 4-2 vs. Quad Cities and 2-4 vs. Great Lakes.

Starting Matchup: The A's 5th-round selection in 2022 from the University of Michigan, right-hander **Jack Perkins**, makes his fifth appearance and fourth start for Lansing, opposed by West Michigan southpaw **Jack O'Loughlin**. The two pitchers will rematch on Sunday.

Sunday: Lugnuts 4, Dragons 3. Though Dayton won four of six games in the series, the Nuts rallied from a 3-1 deficit to tie the game in the eighth on a **Sahid Valenzuela** RBI single and win it in the ninth on an **Alex Campos** bases-loaded HBP. **Blake Beers** struck out nine Dragons in five innings and **Daniel Susac** belted his third home run of the season, a solo shot, in the winning effort.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play West Michigan through Sunday before returning home to welcome in Lake County.

LUG•NOTES

Last Roster Transactions: The Nuts placed pitcher **Joelvis Del Rosario** and infielder **Joshwan Wright** on the Injured List on Saturday, May 6. No corresponding moves were made, leaving Lansing's active roster at 28 players.

Walking Off in Lansing... Do We Really Feel the Way We Feel? The Lugnuts enjoyed four walk-off wins during the just-completed 12-game homestand against Quad Cities and Dayton, walking off twice each week. On April 25, **Lazaro Armenteros** raced home in the bottom of the 10th on a Parker Harm wild pitch for a 6-5 win over the River Bandits. On April 27, **Daniel Susac's** two-out, two-strike, two-run triple popped out of the glove of center fielder Gavin Cross for another 6-5 10-inning win over Quad Cities. In Game 2 of a doubleheader on May 4, **Caeden Trenkle** delivered a two-out RBI single to left field to beat Dayton, 6-5. And on Sunday, May 7, Donovan Benoit hit **Alex Campos** with a pitch with the bases loaded to force in the winning run in a 4-3 victory in the ninth.

Fanning the Dragons' Flames: Lansing pitchers struck out 69 Dragons in six games totaling 52 innings, including 16 strikeouts on Saturday and 15 strikeouts on Sunday. Even so, the Lugnuts' pitching corps ranks 11th in the Midwest League in strikeouts (and Dayton's offense ranks 1st, compared to West Michigan, which is the 2nd hardest offense to strike out in the league).

Playing Catch-Up: Sunday's come-from-behind win saw the Nuts rally from a 3-1 deficit in the 6th with runs in the seventh, the eighth and the ninth to win, the first nine-inning game this year that Lansing has won in which it trailed at the conclusion of the sixth and seventh innings. (A notable exception: In last Thursday's seven-inning Game 2 of the doubleheader against Dayton, the Lugnuts trailed entering the bottom of the sixth, seventh, eighth and ninth innings and rallied for the win.)

Fresh for the Road: The Lugnuts enter this series having played only eight prior road games this year, three at Great Lakes to open the season and five in a rain-ravaged series at Lake County three weeks ago. No team in the Midwest League has played fewer games away from home, and only one team, South Bend, has played as many as 18 home games.

Streaking: C **Daniel Susac's** seven-game hitting streak ended with an 0-for-3 yesterday, though Susac did draw a walk to reach base in his eighth straight game (12-for-28, three walks, .429 average, .484 on-base percentage).

Warning With the Weather: C **Daniel Susac** batted .385 (15-for-39) during the just-completed homestand with one double, two triples, two homers and five walks, raising his slash line from average from .180/.226/.340 to .270/.330/.483. He has walked in three straight games after drawing only five walks in April.

Surfing the Whitecaps: The Lugnuts batted .296/.369/.457 in splitting a six-game series with West Michigan in April. Notable key performers included **Caeden Trenkle** (8-for-16, 5 walks in 5 games, .500/.565/.625) and **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, (7-for-19, one double, one steal, .368/.400/.821).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: Fort Wayne had scheduled Saturday night postgame fireworks, and so the TinCaps shot them off as soon as the game ended... which came after a one-hour, 38-minute rain delay before first pitch and then a three-hour, 48-minute game that concluded after midnight. Edwin Moreno's suicide squeeze in the bottom of the 10th inning (against a five-infielder infield, as directed by manager Ken Huckaby, bringing right fielder J.D. Davis into the infield) brought Nick Torres in with the winning run for a 5-4 Fort Wayne victory. Anthony Alford reached base five times in the loss, with two hits and three walks.

2019: Nick Podkul stole home to end a 22-inning scoring drought, but the Lugnuts lost at Kane County, 3-1. The Nuts entered the series having been shut out 6-0 and 6-0 by Quad Cities in the final two games of a three-game sweep – and things would get worse, as this series-opening loss set the tone for a three-game sweep at Kane County, concluding an 0-6 road trip.

In a Nutshell: Jack Perkins makes his fourth Lugnuts start today... one of four 2022 draftees on the roster; the others are 1st-rounder Daniel Susac, 4th-rounder Jacob Watters and 9th-rounder Caeden Trenkle... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Lugnuts teammate Blake Beers and such other notables as Max Schuemann (promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas), Jeff Criswell (traded in the offseason to Colorado), Jack Weisenburger and prospect OF Clark Elliott (with Single-A Stockton)... unrelated to former Phillies MLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother.

Glory Days: Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation.... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildkats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by the Cubs, but elected to attend college instead.

Study Skills: Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

Life in Louisville: Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts... missed 2020 due to undergoing Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

Off to Bloomington: Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

Draft Day: Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

Pro Debut: Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
