## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

**CAREER TRANSACTIONS:** Drafted by the New York Yankees in the 13<sup>th</sup> round (405<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2019 draft out of South Florida. Claimed off Waivers from Yankees by Tampa Bay Rays on December 7, 2022. Traded to the Philadelphia Phillies on August 6, 2024, for cash considerations.

**2024:** Began season with Rays' Double-A Montgomery. Called up to Triple-A Durham on April 11. On 7-day IL from May 11 through May 22. Transferred back to Double-A Montgomery on June 7. Placed on Montgomery's Development List on August 1. Traded to Phillies August 6 and assigned to Double-A Reading.

**2023:** Split season between High-A Bowling Green and Double-A Montgomery. Began season with Bowling Green. Called-up to Montgomery on May 16 and finished season in Double-A. Played for Gigantes del Cibao in Dominican Winter League following season, making eight appearances.

**2022:** Spent entire season with Yankees' High-A Hudson Valley. Made 35 appearances for Renegades in second season with team, posting 2.85 ERA over 35 appearances. On 7-day IL from April 26 through May 17. Played for Mesa Solar Sox in Arizona Fall League following the season, making nine appearances, and striking out 14 over 10-innings pitched. Claimed off waivers by Tampa Bay following season.

**2021:** Spent entire season with High-A Hudson Valley, posting an 8.55 ERA over 30 appearances. Struck out 41 over 40-innings pitched.

**2020:** Did not pitch as season was cancelled due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

**2019:** Debuted professionally with three teams in Yankees' organization, Split time between Rookie-Advanced Pulaski, along with GCL-Yankees West and GCL-Yankees East. Made pro debut on June 25 with GCL-Yankees West. Transferred to GCL-Yankees East on June 29. Assigned to Pulaski on July 5 and finished season with Pulaski Yankees.

**COLLEGE:** Pitched for South Florida in 2019. Same college as Phillies reliever, and 2023 Fightin Phil, Orion Kerkerling. But, the two were never teammates as Kerkerling debuted for Bulls in 2020. Made 23 appearances in 2019 and led team with eight saves. Was teams' primary closer and struck out 43 in 35.1 innings. Held opponents to team-low .172 batting average. Pitched 2017-18 at Miami Dade Conference where he was First team all-conference. Had 4-2 record in 24 appearances and three starts. Posted 3.71 ERA and 69 strikeouts over 53.1 innings pitched.
