### ENCARNACION HOMER NOT ENOUGH, SKID HITS FIVE

Jerar Encarnacion homered but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp's rally fell short Friday in a 3-2 loss to the Durham Bulls from Durham Bulls Athletic Park. The game was scoreless until the bottom of the fourth. Osleivis Basabe tripled off Jacksonville (23-31) starter Enmanuel De Jesus (1-1) to start the inning. A Kyle Manzardo RBI ground out plated the game's first run for Durham (32-23). After taking a 3-0 lead in the fifth, Encarnacion blasted a two-run homer in the eighth to cut the deficit to 3-2 but Durham held on to extend Jacksonville's losing streak to five-straight.

### MAY SHOWERS BRING JUNE FLOWERS, RIGHT?

Jacksonville finished the month of May by losing 15 of 21 games. The club's 10-17 (.370) month was their worst record in any month since going 11-20 (.354) in July 2018. The Jumbo Shrimp began the month in eighth place, residing just 5.5 games out of first, but they closed May having lost 8.5 games in the standings, 14.0 games behind first-place Norfolk. The Jumbo Shrimp also lost their first two games of June, their 17th loss in 23 games, dropping their overall record to 23-31 - the first time since 2019 the club has been seven games below .500.

### AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 21 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 23-for-74 (.311/.393/.622/1.015) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBIs, nine walks and 14 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances during the 2022 campaign, Allen has whiffed just 19.6% of the time this season. His .198 BABIP is the third-lowest of the 197 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

### THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on Friday, Jacksonville outfielder Brian Miller has reached base in 18 of his last 21 games. During this stretch, the Durham, N.C., native is 26-for-72 (.361/.453/.500/.953) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and nine runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.7 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 36.7 percent.

### CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last seven contests, Jacksonville has blasted 12 long balls, including a season-high six on Saturday, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 12 home runs are the fifth-most in Triple-A over the last seven games. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp's 61 homers rank 18th in Triple-A.

### THE MAYOR OF STARKVILLE

An offseason trade acquisition from the New York Mets, Jacksonville outfielder Jake Mangum has had an outstanding start to the 2023 season. The former Mississippi State Bulldog is 50-for-169 (.296/.330/.456/.786) with 11 doubles, five triples, two home runs, 22 RBIs, six walks and 17 runs scored to start the campaign. Among the 123 qualified players in the IL, Mangum ranks sixth in line drive rate (31.6 percent) while producing the 11th-highest opposite-field rate (41.0 percent). Those figures were at 28.2 and 32.2 percent, respectively, while playing for Triple-A Syracuse in 2022.

### NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, over their last 26 games, they've combined to surrender 97 runs, 94 earned, on 134 hits (12.1 H/9) in 99.2 innings for a 8.49 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters have walked 63 (5.7 BB/9) against only 70 strikeouts (6.3 K/9).

### JACOB ARTIST

Jacksonville infielder Jacob Amaya came into play on May 1 with just one hit in his previous four games. His season batting line sat at .211/.284/.311/.595 with five extra-base hits. In the 23 games, since, the El Monte, Calif., native has taken his offensive game to a new level. Amaya is 29-for-83 during this stretch, slashing .349/.433/.614/1.047 with five doubles, one triple, five home runs, 16 RBIs, 12 walks and 17 runs scored. After posting a .122 ISO with Triple-A Oklahoma City in 2022, Amaya's ISO is .179 this year.

### ABOUT DEVIN

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.
