TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes continue their series with game four of a six-game home stand against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). Tonight is Allstar KIA night, as 1,500 fans will take home a Joe Kelly Chaquetas Bobblehead, while the Quakes will don the Chaquetas uniforms on the field! Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the 22nd of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the tenth of 12 here at home. The Quakes have taken five of six in the first three series so far against the 66ers. Last night's loss gives the 66ers two straight wins over Rancho for the first time this year and leaves the Quakes with a 16-5 mark against the 66ers. In 2024, Rancho went 7-5 here at home vs Inland Empire, 17-7 overall.

LAST GAME: The 66ers survived two scoreless innings from Dodgers' left-hander Blake Snell, hitting a pair of two-run home runs in a 5-3 win over the Quakes on Thursday night at LoanMart Field. Raudi Rodriguez (9) hit his third home run in three days and Dario Laverde (4) broke a 2-2 tie with a two-run shot off Jholbran Herder (3-4). Inland Empire starter Brandon Dufault (1-3) tossed a season-best five innings, allowing two runs on four hits. Kyle Roche worked two scoreless innings to earn his first save. Samuel Munoz had a pair of sacrifice flies, while Niko Perez had three hits and a run scored for Rancho, who dropped their second straight overall.

SNELL RECAP: The Quakes welcomed their third Dodger rehabber in 2025 last night, as lefty Blake Snell tossed two innings to start Thursday's game. Snell allowed one hit and pitched around an error, striking out four batters while throwing 31 pitches (23 strikes). He joins Teoscar Hernandez and Luis Garcia, who played at LoanMart Field earlier this year. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

ROAD NOT SO FRIENDLY, LATELY: The Quakes have had a tough go of it recently on the road, as they've dropped seven of their last nine road games overall. The recent San Jose series finished poorly for Rancho, as they dropped decisions of 9-2, 12-4 and 20-2. With Friday night's 15-3 loss at Visalia, they had been outscored by 45 runs (56-11) over a four-game road losing streak. Sunday's loss in Visalia drops Rancho to just 23-22 on the road this year.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes have made a few roster moves over the last few days, including one on Wednesday, as RHP Christian Zazueta was activated from the Development List. On Tuesday, LHP Myles Caba was promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League, while C Angel Diaz landed on the Injured List. Joining Rancho is LHP Justin Chambers from the ACL and C Carlos Avila, also from the ACL.

LOGAN TABELING: 23-year-old right-hander Logan Tabeling makes his 18th overall appearance this year and eighth start, his third start and fourth appearance against Inland Empire. In three games against the 66ers, he's 1-0 with a 2.89 ERA, allowing three runs on 13 hits over 9.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on three hits over four innings, with four strikeouts and three walks in a no-decision at Visalia on July 5. The undrafted free agent out of Illinois signed with the Dodgers in July of 2024.

BARRETT KENT: 20-year-old right-hander Brandon Dufault makes his first start of the year for the 66ers and also his first against Rancho. Kent has spent the year on the 60-day Injured List and joins the 66ers after making four rehab appearances in the ACL, going 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA over eight total innings. Kent played for Inland Empire last year, going 2-14 with a 6.21 ERA over 113.0 innings, including an 0-2 mark over six start against the Quakes. The Angels selected Kent in the eighth round of the 2023 draft out of Pottsboro High School in Pottsboro, Texas. MLB Pipeline rates Kent as the Angels' 10-best prospect, making him the top prospect on this Inland Empire club.
