EVAN CARTER WALKS IT OFF IN THE 10TH:

The Frisco RoughRiders came back from a 6-0 deficit and walked off the Amarillo Sod Poodles in the 10th inning for an 8-7 win on Saturday at Riders Field. The RoughRiders (17-20) scored six unanswered runs and tied the game in the seventh inning at 6-6. In the 10th inning, Amarillo (16-22) scored the designated runner on a sac fly. Down 7-6 in the bottom of the 10th, **Luisangel Acuña** singled for the game-tying RBI. He stole second and scored on **Evan Carter**'s base hit to right field. It was the first extra-inning win for Frisco and the first walk-off win of 2023. The RoughRiders drew closer in large part due to **Liam Hicks**, who launched a grand slam in the sixth inning. The RoughRiders scored five runs in that inning to draw within one, and Hicks delivered the game-tying RBI with a base hit in the seventh. Hicks went 3-for-5 in the ballgame while Carter went 4-for-6. **Dustin Harris** and Acuña added a pair of hits of their own. **Antoine Kelly** (2-2) pitched the ninth and tenth innings for Frisco without a hit. Mitchell Stumpo (0-1) allowed the game-winning run in the 10th inning and took the loss. Frisco's starter, **Ricky Vanasco**, allowed four unearned runs in the first inning and left after recording just two outs. **Nick Krauth** replaced him and got out of the first inning before allowing two runs in four innings. From then on, RoughRiders relievers shut down the Amarillo hitters. **Nick Starr** did not allow a hit in 1.1 innings, **Michael Brewer** delivered a scoreless seventh inning, **Theo McDowell** followed suit in the eighth.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Liam Hicks** hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball and the only team with more than four. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese).

SINGLE-INNING HISTORY:

On Wednesday, Nick Tanielu hammered two home runs in the fifth inning for the Riders. It was the first time in franchise history that a player hit two home runs in the same inning. It was also the fourth multi-home run game for Tanielu in his career. The 30-year-old veteran is on fire at the plate, hitting four homers in his last three games and riding a nine-game hitting streak while batting .353/.421/.882/1.303 with five home runs and 10 RBIs.

The RoughRiders came back from down six runs on Saturday night to win 8-7 on their first walk-off hit of the season. It was the largest comeback win since they returned from down six at Corpus Christi on 6/18/21 and their first comeback win of more than two runs on the season. It was also their first time they won a game when trailing after the fourth inning this season.

MLB.com has reranked their Top 100 prospects and the RoughRiders have four Top 100 players that have seen some movement. Outfielder **Evan Carter** is now the No. 11 prospect in baseball (previously No. 36) while pitcher **Owen White** is No. 51, infielder **Luisangel Acuña** places at No. 58 and pitcher **Jack Leiter** is at No. 80. The Rangers fourth-round pick in 2022, pitcher **Brock Porter**, is the No. 81 prospect as well. He is currently pitching for Low-A Down East.

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 19 games, he is hitting .383 (31-for-81)/.425/.568/.993 with four doubles, a triple, three homers, 15 RBIs and 15 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .377/.425/.568/.993 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .306/.405/.472/.877 with four doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking 12 times. Over the last 19 games, he has raised his average 108 points and his OPS 289 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .316 (49-for-155)/.385/.458/.843 through the first 35 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (49), tied for fifth in doubles (11), eighth in total bases (71) and tied for second in stolen bases (17). Over his last 32 games, he is batting .336/.410/.496/.906. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (126).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 190 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .361 team OBP is third in Double-A. **Dustin Harris** is second in the league with 28 walks while **Evan Carter** is third in OBP (.430) in the league and third in the league with 27 walks.

-Originally committed to Troy University in Alabama.

-Paired a 7-3 record with a 1.19 ERA in his junior season at Pine Forest High School in Pensacola, Fla., earning the 2019 Pensacola News Journal Pitcher of the Year award...recorded 109 strikeouts against just 10 walks that season while contributing a .384 batting average and 28 RBI at the plate to lead Pine Forest to its first regional appearance in 12 years.

-Is one of several Texas minor leaguers enrolled in the club's 'RangersU Powered by ACU' program, which allows players and coaches to earn academic credit by taking online courses taught by Abilene Christian University faculty and staff in both English and Spanish.

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 12 prospect in the Rangers system per MLB.com.

-Struck out seven over six innings on April 15th in San Antonio, allowing all four runs with two outs (two runs in the second inning and two runs in the sixth before he exited).

-Threw first quality start of the season on May 16th against Amarillo. He took a no-hitter into the seventh inning, retiring 18 in a row before an A.J. Vukovich triple and Deyvison De Los Santos home run ended his night. Frisco went onto win 3-2 when Dustin Harris lifted a go-ahead solo home run to start the eighth.

2022 SEASON

-Was one of the youngest starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League, pitching the entire season at the age of 20.

-Late in the season, he added a slider to give himself a true four-pitch mix.

-Led the Crawdads staff in innings pitched (104.2) and strikeouts (126).

-Over his first six starts, he allowed 23 runs (7.67 ERA), but rebounded to collect a 3.59 ERA over his last 16 games (15 starts), starting on May 24th.

-In his last five starts, Roby owned a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP), striking out 36 batters to just five

-On August 19th, he threw an immaculate inning against Winston-Salem (nine pitches with three strikeouts).

2021 SEASON

-Made only six starts because of an elbow sprain in June, but did not have surgery.

-It was a proximal tear in the UCL, which heals easier than a distal tear without surgery.

-In six starts, struck out 38.9% of hitters (35 of 90) and held opponents to a .177 batting average against.
