#### JACKSONVILLE DROPS OPENER TO DURHAM

A pair of four-run Durham innings did Jacksonville in on Tuesday in an 8-4 Bulls win. Durham popped the game open with a four-spot in the second, and added a second four-run inning in the fourth to take an 8-0 lead. The Jumbo Shrimp finally responded with four runs in the bottom of the eighth. **Nick Fortes** led off with a double and scored on **Jerar Encarnacion's** first Triple-A home run to make the score 8-2. **JJ Bleday** walked in the following at-bat and advanced to third on a **Peyton Burdick** single. A wild pitch scored Bleday and Burdick went to second. **Willians Astudillo** plated Burdick with a single to make the score 8-4. **Jake Fishman** fanned six in 2.2 perfect innings of relief.

#### THE GARDNER

**Bryan Hoeing** starts Wednesday's game against the Durham Bulls. After being assigned to Jacksonville on May 3, Hoeing is 2-0 with a 4.15 ERA in 13 innings with 10 strikeouts in two starts. In four starts with Pensacola in 2022, Hoeing registered a 2-1 record to go along with a 0.35 ERA. In 25.2 innings, he struck out 26 batters and only walked four. He held opponents to a .211 batting average in Double-A, and combined with his two starts thus far in Triple-A, opponents are mustering only a .209 batting average against the Indiana native.

#### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville boasts a 12-6 record on the road thus far in 2022, but the club has struggled at home, posting just an 8-11 mark. Interestingly, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit far better on the road, posting a team batting line of .299/.368/.516. The club's resulting .884 OPS places second in Triple-A. When playing at 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville is hitting .236/.327/.393, with the club's .720 OPS ranking 17th at the Triple-A level. Just 21 of the Jumbo Shrimp's 52 home runs have come at home.

#### SIX & DIP

Heading into play on Wednesday, Jacksonville has scored at least six runs in 17 of their last 29 games, and 19 of the club's 37 contests (51.4 percent) this year. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent). When scoring at least six runs this season, Jacksonville is a robust 16-3 (.842).

#### CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Dating back to April 23, **Charles Leblanc** has reached base in 20 of his last 21 games, including a league-high-matching 18-game on-base streak that expired with an 0-for-5 day on May 14. Over these last 21 games, Leblanc is 28-for-84 at the plate, batting .333/.385/.500/.885 with five doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs and 11 runs scored. On the season, the Laval, Quebec City native has reached base safely in 30 of his 33 games, with multiple trips on in 17 of those contests. Leblanc ranks second in the IL in batting average (.346), tied for fourth in hits (44), fifth in OPS (.988), tied for sixth in RBIs (27), seventh in slugging (.575), 10th in on-base percentage (.413) and tied for 15th in extra-base hits (15).

#### **BLEDAY OF THE DEAD**

Over the season's first 18 games, Jacksonville outfielder **JJ Bleday** struggled, going just 10-for-63 at the plate with two doubles and two home runs for a .159/.321/.286/.607 batting line. However, over the last 16 games, Bleday is 16-for-56 with three doubles and five home runs, slashing .286/.429/.607/1.036. Including a nine-game hitting streak from April 28-May 7, Bleday has reached base at least once in 14 of those last 16 contests. Among the 125 qualified hitters in the IL, Bleday has posted the circuit's highest fly ball rate (58.8 percent), fifth-lowest groundball rate (28.7 percent) and fifth-lowest line drive rate (12.5 percent).

#### **RELIEF NEEDED**

Late innings have become a sudden issue for the Jumbo Shrimp of late. In the seventh inning-on over five games from April 26-30, Jacksonville yielded just three runs, all earned, on 10 hits (6.9 H/9) in 13.0 frames for a 2.08 ERA. During that span, the club collectively fanned nine batters against just two walks. However, over the last 14 games, in the seventh inning-on, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 34 runs, 32 earned, on 45 hits (10.2 H/9) in 39.2 frames for an 7.71 ERA. The club's hurlers have issued 23 walks (5.2 BB/9) against 45 strikeouts (10.2 K/9) during this run. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 7-7 during this stretch.

#### SHRIMP BITE

Jacksonville is seeking to avoid its first four-game skid of the 2022 season.



ABOUT BRYAN								

-In high school, Bryan was selected as a 2014 Under Armour All-American and was rated the 131st-best prospect in the nation by Perfect Game in 2015.

-He was ranked as the fourth-best player in the state of Indiana and the third-best right-handed pitcher as a senior in high school.

-Hoeing was named to All-Tournament Teams at 2014 Perfect Game WWBA 17U National Championship and 2013 Perfect Game WWBA 16u National Championship.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Hoeing was transferred to Jacksonville on May 3 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Hoeing was leading the Southern League in both ERA (0.35) and innings pitched (25.2) while ranking second in both batting average against (.211) and WHIP (0.94), tied for fourth in wins (2) and sixth in strikeouts (26).

#### 2021 SEASON

-There, Hoening made 22 appearances (22 GS) going 7-6 with a 4.83 ERA in 121.0 innings, he allowed 65 ER and held opponents to a .267 batting average.

After posting a 7.91 ERA in May (19.1 IP), 6.12 ERA in June (32.1 IP) and 6.29 ERA in July (24.1 IP), Hoeing closed the season strong. In August, he went 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in four starts (27.0 IP, 16 H, 7 BB, 23 K). In three September starts, the right-hander worked to a 2-0 record and 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 19 H, BB, 11 K).

#### **2019 SEASON**

-After being drafted in the seventh round of the MLB draft in 2019, Hoening was sent to the NYPL with the Batavia Muckdogs.

-In nine relief appearances, he tossed 22.1 innings and struck out 17 in his professional debut season

-He tallied his first professional strikeout on 7/18 vs. the Auburn Doubledays.

#### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-Originally drafted out of high school by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 32nd round (2015) but elected not to sign.

-Signed with Louisville but also strongly considered UNC, Vanderbilt, Indiana, and Georgia Tech.

-His mom, Donna, is the person whom had the greatest influence on his athletic career. She played basketball at Ball State. Meanwhile, Bryan's cousin, Alex Meyer, plays in the Minnesota Twins' organization.
