LUG-NOTES

Stopping Wagner: In two games this week against the Nuts, Loons' infielder Logan Wagner has two home runs and is 5-for-9 at the plate, hitting .556 with an OPS of 1.822. Manager Javier Godard told David Powell after last night's game, "I think slowing him down is you probably pitch him backwards and just kind of get away from the middle a little bit because he's very hot in the middle, on the heart of the plate."

Gig 'Em: In the current homestand, former Texas A&M Aggie Ali Camarillo leads the Nuts on offense, hitting .375 with at least one hit in each of the past four games. In the month of July, Camarillo is hitting a team-best .322 in 15 games.

Rotation Junction: With three Lugnuts starters promoted in the last two days (Nathan Dettmer, Zane Taylor, Ben Hansen), the Lugnuts are starting **Devin Kirby** (Midwest League debut), **Jorge Marcheco** (19th appearance, 2nd spot-start), and **Tucker Novotny** (24th appearance, 1st start - hasn't started since August 31, 2025).

Kirby's Dream Land: Starter **Devin Kirby** joins the Lugnuts from Class-A Stockton. Kirby, 26, spent 2025 in the Twins' (Fort Myers) and Orioles' (Delmarva and Aberdeen) organizations before opening this season in the Atlantic League's Southern Maryland Blue Crabs' starting rotation. After five starts for Southern Maryland, Kirby's contract was purchased by the A's. He made four appearances in the Arizona Complex League (1.38 ERA, 13 IP, 2 ER, 2 BB, 18 K) and six appearances with Stockton (5.70 ERA, 23 2/3 IP, 15 ER, 5 BB, 18 K). Kirby is a native of Ukiah, California. The UConn Huskie throws a knuckleball in addition to his fastball, curve, sweeper and change.

Bullpen on the Rise: After a rocky beginning of the season, the Nuts' bullpen has begun to find its way. In the first half, the group was ranked ninth in the Midwest League in ERA (6.09), 10th in WHIP (1.81), 12th in BAA (.288), seventh in hits allowed (277) and fifth in runs allowed (196). Coming into the series against the Loons, in the second half, the bullpen was ranked second in ERA (4.35), second in WHIP (1.45), sixth in BAA (.243), tied for fourth in hits allowed (91) and first in the league in runs allowed (57). **Abel Mercedes** (5.2 IP) and **Darlin Pinales** (5.2 IP) are both on seven-game streaks without allowing an earned run; **Luis Carrasco** (3.2 IP) is on a five-game streak.

Major League Notables:

- This is the second time in franchise history that four players have vaulted from the Lugnuts to MLB in one season, joining 2023.
- There are 12 former Nuts on the Athletics' active roster: pitchers **Gage Jump**, **Yunior Tur**, **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris** and **Jack Perkins**; infielders **Max Muncy**, **Tommy White** and **Jacob Wilson**; and outfielders **Henry Bolte**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.
- With White's and Tur's arrival, nine former Lugnuts have made their MLB debut this season and 209 have achieved the feat all-time.

Lugnut All-Stars: In the 2026 Major League All-Star Game, 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** was voted to started at first base for the A.L., but took the game off; 2019 Nut **Otto López** (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve) went 1-for-2 with a single and a strikeout; and 2022 Nut **Mason Miller** (San Diego Padres closer) struck out the only batter he faced, the White Sox' Munetaka Murakami.

Cooperstown Bound: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

JULY 23 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: It took 16 innings, 10 combined errors and 29 combined hits, but the Lugnuts finally put away the Swing of the Quad Cities, 11-10, in a franchise record five hours and 31 minutes.

2024: On a night when West Michigan debuted 19-year-old center fielder Max Clark, it was Lansing's 22-year-old center fielder Ryan Lasko who took center stage with two thrilling catches and two crucial hits, lifting the Lugnuts to a 5-1 win over the Whitecaps on Tuesday night at LMCU Ballpark. Will Simpson and Cole Conn homered for the Lugnuts to aid the winning effort, bolstered by shutout ball from starter Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang and lights-out relief from Blaze Pontes and Hunter Breault. But it was Lasko, the A's 2nd-round selection in 2023 from Rutgers, who grabbed the rave reviews: racing back to the warning track to haul in a fly from Kevin McGonigle in the first inning, leaping at the wall to take away extra bases from Eddy Leonard in the fourth inning, lasering an RBI double in the fifth inning, making a spectacular diving catch of a Max Anderson line drive in the bottom of the fifth inning, and capping the night with a frozen rope of an RBI single in the ninth inning, all in his fourth game in the Midwest League after moving up from Single-A Stockton.

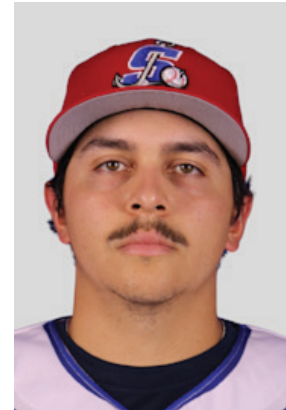

In a Nutshell: Welcome to Lansing, Devin Kirby! The right-hander with the seven-pitch arsenal (including a knuckler) becomes the 12th different Lugnut to start a game this season, the 26th different pitcher (including position-player/pitcher Gunner Gouldsmith), and the 1,007th player in Lugnuts history... Kirby opened the year with the Atlantic League's Southern Maryland Blue Crabs (5 GS, 1-0, 3.09, 23 1/3 IP, 11 BB, 22 K) before signing with the A's on May 22... made four appearances with the Complex League A's and six appearances with the Class-A Ports leading up to his promotion replacing Ben Hansen and Zane Taylor.

Hometown Hero: Ukiah is located just south of Redwood Valley in northern California, 115 miles north of San Francisco... Aaron Rodgers spent several years of his youth in Ukiah... the iconic Don Mossi lived in Ukiah after retiring... Kirby was a two-time First Team All-Conference at Ukiah High School, 2016-2017.

College Life: Spent 2019 with Santa Rosa Junior College and was named First Team All-American, All-Conference, All-State and All-Region, posting a 1.09 ERA with 79 K in 49 2/3 IP, 17 SV, 28 games pitched... transferred to UConn and missed the 2021 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery... returned in 2022 as UConn's relief ace, recording the final five outs to beat Xavier to win the Big East championship... in 2023, went 7-1, 4.35, 49 2/3 IP, 43 K, as the Huskies won the Big East regular season championship.

Off to Pro Ball: Spent 2023-2025 in the Twins' organization... pitched in the 2024 Arizona Fall League (6 G, 9.53 ERA, 11 1/3 IP, 11 H, 13 BB, 8 K)... released May 28, 2025... signed with the Orioles on June 6, 2025... released by the Orioles on August 2, 2025... signed with the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs to open 2026... signed with the A's, May 22... moved up to Lansing, July 22.
