### TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Oklahoma City are set to play in the series finale on Sunday night. Express LHP Cody Bradford is slated to start against Dodgers RHP Ryan Pepiot. Tonight's first pitch at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark is scheduled for 6:05 p.m. CT.

### SERIES SPLIT STILL ALIVE

The Express defeated the Dodgers 4-3 on Saturday night in game five. After three scoreless innings, Oklahoma City SS Yonny Hernandez put the home team up 1-0 with his solo home run in the fourth inning. Round Rock put up a four spot in the top of the sixth inning. 2B Justin Foscue drew a walk, 1B Blaine Crim doubled and SS Davis Wendzel walked which loaded the bases for LF Sandro Fabian who smacked a grand slam to put the Express ahead 4-1. In the bottom of the ninth inning, back-to-back singles from Hernandez and C Hunter Feduccia had two runners on with no outs. LF Bryson Brigman singled to score Hernandez and make it a 4-2 game. A throwing error from Fabian allowed the runners to sit at second and third base. A wild pitch from RHP Ian Kennedy allowed Feduccia to score and made it a 4-3 game. A flyout ended the game and Round Rock hung on for the 4-3 win and just their second win of the series.

### BACK TO BRADFORD

Round Rock LHP Cody Bradford is scheduled to take the mound on Sunday after he was optioned from the Texas Rangers on August 1. The lefty leads the Express pitching staff in wins (8). In 12 games and six starts with the Rangers this year, Bradford has posted a 4.50 ERA (20 ER/40.0 IP) with 11 walks and 37 strikeouts. Bradford earned his first Major League win on July 7 at Washington.

### HITTING 60 WINS

Round Rock hit the 60-win mark on the season after 106 games which is tied with the 2015 club for the fourth-quickest to 60 wins in club history. It is also the quickest to 60 wins since 2019 when it took 104 games.

### KENT GETS BACK TO IT

In his first game with the E-Train since April 4, Round Rock RHP Zak Kent needed only seven pitches to work through the first frame. The righty threw 3.0 scoreless innings and allowed one hit with three strikeouts and zero walks. In seven career starts at the Triple-A level, the righty owns a 1.36 ERA (5 ER/33.0 IP).

### IN GRAND FASHION

Express LF Sandro Fabian belted a grand slam in the sixth inning. It was the seventh grand slam of the season for the E-Train but the first since C Sam Huff launched one on July 2 against Las Vegas. The Express lead the Pacific Coast League in grand slams.

### SERIES SPLITS

Round Rock kept the possibility of a series split alive after last night's 4-3 win. A victory in the series finale tonight would mark the E-Train's seventh split on the season and force just the second split this year for the Dodgers who are 14-3-1 in series play.

### FABIAN IS EN FUEGO

Express LF Sandro Fabian hit a go-ahead grand slam in the sixth inning yesterday which marked his 15th home run of the season and the first grand slam of his career. Fabian has homered in back-to-back games for the third time this season and has hit safely in five straight games which is a season high. Over the last five games he is 7-for-19 with two home runs, five RBI, two runs and two strikeouts.

### HOW ABOUT A DOZEN?

Round Rock's pitching staff fanned 12 Oklahoma City batters yesterday. It's the first time since July 19 that the Express have tallied 12 or more strikeouts in a game and it's the 21st time this year.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

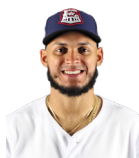
