#### JUMBO SHRIMP SWEEP DOUBLEHEADER

Jacksonville broomed Norfolk 4-3 and 5-1 in Friday's doubleheader at Harbor Park. In the opening contest, Tristan Gray whacked a bases-clearing double in the first inning. Troy Johnston's RBI single in the fifth made it 4-0, and the Jumbo Shrimp were able to hold on for the win from there. Jacksonville again jumped out to the lead in the finale, scoring a pair of runs on a José Devers single coupled with an error. Jhonny Pereda went yard in the fourth. After Billy Cook's sixth-inning homer, a Tides error plated two Jumbo Shrimp in the seventh to make it 5-1.

#### **DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Jacksonville's doubleheader sweep over Norfolk on Friday was the Jumbo Shrimp second twin bill brooming in a week (July 20 vs. Durham). Jacksonville had not accomplished the feat of two doubleheader sweeps in a season since 2021, when managed four double-dip broomings. The Jumbo Shrimp have won seven of their last eight games. Seven of those eight games have been decided by two runs or fewer. Jacksonville has yielded more than four runs only once during this stretch.

#### IT'S TEARIN' UP MY START WHEN I'M WITH YOU

In 2005, Jacksonville starting pitchers ranked just 25th in Double-A with 741.0 innings, which represented 60.6 percent of the club's 1223.2 innings. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has worked 51.5 percent of the club's innings, a total of 444.1 out of 863.0 frames. That figure is the eighth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville lid-lifters also lead the level in ERA (4.23; next-closest is Memphis at 4.54) while ranking second in WHIP (1.35), third in BAA (.251), fourth in OPSA (.765) and ninth in walks (175).

#### **GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'**

Jacksonville has gone 24-15 (.615) in their last 39 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 28 of those 39 affairs (71.8 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in fewest runs allowed (139: next-closest is Indianapolis at 156). ERA (3.40: next-closest is Indianapolis at 3.78) and WHIP (1.32) while ranking second in OPS against (.716) and third in both BAA (.238) and fewest hits allowed (298).

#### **QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START**

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 34 of the last 38 games, with 26 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and 14 being without an earned run. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 69 runs, 62 earned, on 150 hits (8.2 H/9) in 165.1 innings for a 3.38 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 171 strikeouts (9.3 K/9) against 74 walks (4.0 BB/9) during this stretch. Rather remarkably, the Jumbo Shrimp have started 16 different pitchers over these 38 contests.

#### **SOULJA TROY**

Heading into play on May 25, Troy Johnston, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 50 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 62-for-184, slashing .337/.407/.516/.923 with 12 doubles, three triples, five homers, 25 RBIs, 20 walks and 33 runs scored. Johnston has 16 multi-hit games in his last 31 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (109) while also ranking sixth in doubles (24) and 18th in batting average (.287).

### GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine has been stellar since early May. Over his last 63 games, the Duke product is 63for-219, slashing .288/.360/.548/.908 with 13 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 41 RBIs, 24 walks and 39 runs scored. Among the 108 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks ninth in HR/FB (25.8 percent). On the year, he ranks tied for 13th in the IL in extra-base hits (36), tied for 14th in homers (17), tied for 24th in hits (82) and tied for 25th in doubles (18).

#### SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp are 18-10 (.643) in their last 28 road games... By winning one more game in their series at Norfolk, Jacksonville would earn their second consecutive set victory, something they have not done since taking four of six from both Norfolk and Memphis from April 16-28... The Jumbo Shrimp have not been .500 since they were 16-16 on May 4, a span of 84 days. A win on Saturday would get them to 50-50 on the campaign.
