Looking to Split

The Fightin Phils finish their home-opening six-game series with the Portland Sea Dogs today at 3:15. Reading is looking to earn a split as Portland leads this week's 3-2 following the Sea Dogs sweep of last night's doubleheader. If Reading loses, they will drop the first two series of the season for the fourth-straight year. Noah Skirrow makes his second start of the week, opposite Angel Bastardo for Portland.

Double Trouble

The Fightin Phils fell in both ends of last night's doubleheader 9-2 and 5-4. The last time Reading was swept in a doubleheader was Aug. 9 of last season at New Hampshire. The R-Phils were swept in three doubleheaders in 2023. Robinson Pina also allowed three home runs in game one of the doubleheader, marking the first time a Fightin Phils pitcher has allowed three home runs since Victor Vargas on June 8, 2023.

Ducks Left Stranded

Reading stranded 11 runners on base in game one of last night's doubleheader, marking a season high. They left 21 men on base between the two games yesterday. In total, Reading has stranded 39 runners on base this week, which averages to 7.8 per game.

Getting on Base

Multiple Fightin Phils own impressive early-season on-base streaks. Marcus Lee Sang is up to an eight-game on-base streak after reaching in both games yesterday. Lee Sang did not own an on-base streak north of six games in his time with Reading last season. Jim Haley and Carson Taylor both own five-game hit streaks for the Fightin Phils.

Rodriguez Rolling

Jose Rodriguez has had a strong first home series since joining the Phillies in a trade from the White Sox last week. In his first home series, Rodriguez is slashing .375/.524/.625 with a 1.149 OPS. He also has a home run, a couple RBI, has walked five times and owns just three strikeouts.

The Road Ahead

Following today, Reading's next two opponents feature the two teams who represented the Northeast Division in the playoffs last season. Reading heads to Binghamton from Tuesday through Sunday next week. Then, Somerset comes to Reading from April 23-28.

Double Steals

Last time, Portland executed a double steal of second and home with Phillip Sikes and Max Ferguson. It marks the first time Reading allowed a double steal of second and home since Portland did it here on Sept. 9, 2023.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 14, 2016: At Harrisburg, Nick Pivetta (6.0 IP, H, 7 K, 2 BB) notches his first win of the season and Angelo Mora goes 3-for-4 with a HR and 4 RBIs in 9-0 blanking of the Senators.

What's Up Dogs

Portland Enters tonight's game with a 3-3 record, after playing just one game last weekend, on Sunday, at home against Hartford. The first two games of the Sea Dogs season were postponed due to a snowstorm that hit Portland last week. Last season, the Sea Dogs with a 73-63 overall record, which was the third best in the Eastern League Northeast. They also narrowly missed the postseason, after finishing 2.5 games back of Somerset in the first-half standings. Portland's roster has nine of Boston's top-30 prospects, including: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (6), Nick Yorke (7), Blaze Jordan (20), Eddison Paulino (23), Hunter Dobbins (26) and Angel Bastardo (27).

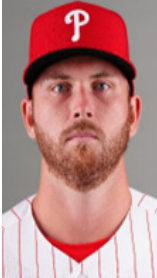
Throw a Dog a Ball

Right-handed pitcher Angel Bastardo gets the ball in the final game of this week's series. Bastardo is the first Sea Dog to make his second start of the season. He pitched last Sunday at home against Hartford and suffered the loss, but was solid over five innings. He allowed just one hit and one-earned run, with two walks and three strikeouts. He split last season between High-A Greenville and Portland, combining to go 2-8, with a 4.68 ERA over 24 starts. He spent all of 2022 with Single-A Salem, 2021 with the FCL-Red Sox and made his pro debut in 2019 with the DSL-Red Sox 1. The 21-year old signed with the Red Sox as an International Free Agent in 2018 at 16-years old.

2024 Notes: Started season on Triple-A Lehigh Valley's Development List. Activated off Development List and transferred to Double-A Reading Apr. 9. Made first start same night against Portland. Roughed up by Sea Dogs, surrendering seven hits and four-earned runs in just 2.1 innings of work. Threw strikes on 60% of pitches in no decision.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by the Philadelphia Phillies as an undrafted free agent to a minor league contract on June 16, 2020.

2023: Pitched the entire season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley. Led the team in wins, strikeouts and innings pitched.

2022: Spent majority of the season with Double-A Reading. Amongst all Phillies minor league pitchers, ranked first in games started (25) and innings pitched (119.2) and was second in strikeouts (133). Was on the injured list with a right ankle contusion from May 12-20. Promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5.

2021: Began professional career with High-A Jersey Shore. Was on the injured list from June 18 through July 16 with right biceps tendinitis, which included a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Phillies (ROK). Promoted to Reading on July 23 and transferred back to Jersey Shore on September 7. Overall, he struck out 60 over 58 innings pitched. In eight relief appearances, he posted a 3.13 ERA (8 ER, 23.0 IP)

2020: Did not pitch as season was cancelled due to COVID-19 Pandemic. Participated in the Florida Instructional League.

Appeared in 16 games and started 15 for Liberty in 2019 and went 5-6 with a 3.76 ERA. In 2019, led the Atlantic Sun Conference with 11.50 strikeouts per nine innings pitched (98 SO/76.2 IP). Finished collegiate career in 2020 with a 1-1 record and 1.96 ERA over an impressive four starts in shortened-season. Struck out 20 hitters across 23 innings pitched.
