FROM THE CROWS NEST

WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN: With four games to go in the regular season, Bradenton is 28-32 in the second half, currently 3.0 (4.0 including the tie-breaker) behind the Threshers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. The Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After dropping the season series with Clearwater, the Threshers have the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. Clearwater can clinch with one victory of their own and/or one Marauders loss over the next four games.

LABAUT GETS US STARTED: 28-year-old southpaw **Randy Labaut** will be in a minor-league rehab assignment tonight as the Marauders face the Blue Jays for the third time this week. Over 22 appearances and two starts from Triple-A Indianapolis this season, Labaut has pitched to a 4.46 ERA and has punched out 44 hitters in 38.1 innings. Tonight marks his first outing since August 6 when he tossed 0.2 innings versus Omaha. He was placed on the 7-Day Injured List a day later. The Havana, Cuba native has been in affiliated ball since 2019 and was acquired by the Pirates in the Triple-A phase of the Rule 5 Draft last December from the Cleveland Guardians organization, where he spent all of 2024 with Triple-A Columbus. Cleveland drafted him in the 35th round with the 1060th pick of the 2019 draft out of the University of Arizona.

MR. 100: After Diamondbacks infielder Jordan Lawler graduated from MLB Pipeline's Top 100 prospects list, Marauders outfielder **Edward Florentino** was named the No. 100 prospect in all of baseball (No. 98 via Baseball America). He was also named Florida State League Player of the Month for his dominant performance in July. He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed .301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBI were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 5 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21.

FLY FLY AWAY: The Marauders currently lead the Florida State League with 102 home runs, marking their fifth season in franchise history reaching the triple-digit threshold. With four games to go, they're 15 away from matching their all-time high of 117 in 2023. Moreover, they also have blasted the most in Single-A, as they've now passed San Jose (California League, 98). 157 of their 573 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.3%). They're 37-32 when leaving the yard at least once, and 21-37 when not homering at all. They've seen six players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (**A. Plaz**, **Y. De Los Santos**, **K. Griffin**, **J. Severino**, **E. Florentino**, **E. Rodriguez**).

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: The Marauders have surpassed their franchise record with 226 stolen bases this season (2023 - 222). Before being transferred to High-A Greensboro, **Yordany De Los Santos** played a massive role as he stole 51st base out Friday night, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). Before his promotion, he was tied with **Daytona's Kyle Henley** for the most in the league - the two are the first FSL players to steal 50 since **Seth Stephensen** (LAK - 62) and **Emaarion Boyd** (CLR - 56) reached the threshold in 2023. In the process, De Los Santos also passed **Jesus Castillo** (39 - 2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. Him and Henley are tied for seventh in Single-A. Moreover, De Los Santos sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (64) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MiLB history. The two are approaching **Rich Thompson** for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer since 2005 when he stole 58 that season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

TONY TATERS: Pirates No. 30 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** demolished two homers during the Marauders previous homestand. On July 30, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A at the time, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Three nights later, he also demolished a walk-off three-run homer that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in MiLB this season. Only three batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins **Oneil Cruz** (122.9 mph) and **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** (120.4 mph) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter.

MANAGER - JIM HORNER

HOMETOWN: Twin Falls, (ID) **PREV.ROLES W/ BRD:** Bench Coach ('21)

- Returns to Bradenton in 2025 for his second season as manager of the club
- Sixth year in the Pirates organization
- Prior to 2024, Horner managed the Florida Complex League Pirates (FCL) in 2023, served as a Minor League Assistant Field Coordinator in 2022 and a bench coach for Bradenton in 2021.
- Previously served as hitting coach at Power 5 programs Texas Tech University and Washington State University.
- Last year's promotion marked his first opportunity to lead a full-season affiliate since 2015, when he managed the Jackson Generals, the then Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners, capping a ten-year coaching career in their farm system.
- Over his nine-year career on the diamond, the former catcher played in 589 minor-league games and reached as high as Triple-A before transitioning to coaching after the 2004 campaign.
