## NORTHWEST ARKANSAS POWERS THEIR WAY TO WIN IN OPENER OVER FRISCO:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell in the series' opening game to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 7-3 on Tuesday night from Arvest Ballpark. The Naturals (4-0) jumped on RoughRiders (2-2) starter **Kohl Drake** (0-1) early when Peyton Wilson appeared to hit a two-run home run in the second inning, but was called out after missing home plate. It was reverted to an RBI triple and the Naturals took a 1-0 lead. Drake allowed four runs over his three innings in the start. Royals top prospect Jac Caglianone then added on with a three-run home run in the third and Northwest Arkansas plated three more in the fifth to push the score to 7-0. Frisco finally found the scoreboard in the eighth when **Alejandro Osuna** drove an opposite-field RBI single to left before **Josh Hatcher** hammered his first home run of the season, a two-run shot, to pull Frisco within 7-3. Henry Williams (1-0) took home the win with five shutout innings, striking out seven, in his start. **Bryan Magdaleno** (one inning) and **Travis MacGregor** (two innings) both fired scoreless baseball out of the bullpen in the loss.

## THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

The Frisco bullpen has been a bright spot for the Riders in the beginning of the season. While the pitching staff has had a 3.86 ERA overall (3rd-best in the Texas League to San Antonio, 2.25, and Corpus Christi, 3.44), the bullpen pitchers were even better. If you remove **Ben Anderson's** long relief as a normal starting pitcher, Frisco's bullpen pitchers have combined to allow just four earned runs over 16.0 innings (2.25 ERA). **Skylar Hales** and **Daniel Missaki** both collected saves on Saturday and Sunday, respectively. Frisco's shutout win on Sunday marked just one of four shutouts in the Texas League so far. Their one blemish as a staff is 22 walks in the four games, tied for the second-most in the Texas League.

## NO. 1 PROVING TO BE NO. 1 PROSPECT:

**Sebastian Walcott** has shown off his top prospect status in the first three games of the season, hitting .294 (5-for-17) with two doubles, two RBIs, a walk and a steal. Has hit safely in all four games so far this season. He hit four balls with exit velocities over 105 in the weekend. Walcott is the No. 1 prospect in all of baseball by MLB.com and the No. 2 prospect by Keith Law of *The Athletic*.

## VERSUS THE NATURALS:

A season ago, the RoughRiders went 7-5 against Northwest Arkansas. **Maximo Acosta** dominated on the offensive side (.421/.532/.658/1.190 over 10G), but **Abimelec Ortiz** and **Josh Hatcher** were the two best returners against the Naturals. Ortiz hit three home runs in 11 games while slashing .341/.449/.610/1.059 while Hatcher collected 17 hits in 10 games, including a five-hit game, to hit .405 with a 1.039 OPS against the Royals affiliate. With his home run in the opener on Tuesday, Hatcher is now hitting .362/.422/.534/.956 in his career against the Naturals across 14 games with two home runs and 11 RBIs.

## HATCHIN' HITTIN':

**Josh Hatcher** was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season and has started 2025 by hitting .500 (6-for-12) with a home run, three RBIs, a stolen base and four runs scored over his first three games. Last year, he was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better.

## ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz has two multi-hit games with the RoughRiders to start the season.

## WE'RE GOING PROSPECTING:

The RoughRiders have nine players in MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30 Prospects rankings to start 2025. **Sebastian Walcott** (No. 1) headlines the bunch and is the only member of the top 100 as well (No. 17). On the mound, **Winston Santos** (No. 5), **Kohl Drake** (No. 13), **Mitch Bratt** (No. 21) and **Josh Stephan** (No. 22) all slot into the starting rotation while **Skylar Hales** (No. 25) will work from the bullpen. On offense, outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** (No. 8) and first baseman/outfielder **Abimelec Ortiz** (No. 14) round out the nine players.

## FAMILIAR FACES IN FRISCO:

The RoughRiders welcome a remarkable 23 returning players in 2025 and had just two players on the roster (infielder **Cam Cauley** and catcher **Ian Moller**) that made their Double-A debuts this year.



### ABOUT JOSH

-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Alabama, and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate the new contract.

### 2025 SEASON

-Enters into 2025 in the 5th spot in the rotation.

### 2024 SEASON

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Made only relief appearance of the season on 7/9 vs. NWA, coming out of the bullpen behind MLB rehabber Tyler Mahle.

### 2023 SEASON

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

### 2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).

-Induced ground balls at an over 50% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.
