FRES-NOTES

BERNARD'S BUZZ KILL: Derek Bernard has set the tone early, hitting .385 (5-for-13) with a homer, four RBI, and a 1.159 OPS through the first three games. He's reached base in 7 of 15 plate appearances and delivered damage against multiple arms, helping Fresno stay consistently productive at the top of the order.

WORKING THE SWARM: Fresno's offense has complemented its power with patience, drawing walks across the lineup and posting strong on-base numbers—highlighted by Bernard (.467 OBP) and Tanner Thach (.438 OBP). Even in quieter innings, hitters like Roldy Brito (.375 OBP) have helped extend innings and keep pressure on the Buzzers' staff.

ZEROES AND BULLPEN HEROES: Fresno's pitching staff has shown swing-and-miss upside early, combining for 35 strikeouts in 27.0 innings through the first three games. The staff has generated consistent pressure with strikeouts, limiting sustained rallies despite traffic on the bases.

CLOSING THE OPENING: A dominant bullpen performance slammed the late openings that Ontario had on Thursday night. Ethan Cole and Seth Clausen teamed up for a dominant showing, combining for 6 strikeouts across 4.2 scoreless innings. Cole punched out three over 2.2 innings, while Clausen followed with a pair of perfect frames and five strikeouts to secure the win. Austin Emener prevented the automatic runner in the tenth from tying the game to earn the first save of his professional career.
