against the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It is the seventh of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the first of 12 games in Virginia. With a win. Gwinnett would snap a four-game road losing streak (lost final 4 games of DUR series from 5/12-15).

VS. NORFOLK: The Stripers enter play riding a three-game winning streak over Norfolk dating back to 4/29, and are 5-1 vs. the Tides this season. Gwinnett has lost its last three games at Harbor Park, however, and went 1-5 in Norfolk last year (only win was on 6/24/21, Ryan Casteel's grand slam was difference in 6-2 victory). Gwinnett is 9-2-1 in 12 season series all-time vs. Norfolk (since 2009).

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Stripers lead the International League in team batting since 4/21, hitting .276 (261-for-946, 51 2B, 3 3B, 28 HR, 135 RBI, 17 SB) in 28 games. That's two points higher than the second-place club in that span, Nashville (.274 in 27G). Only Albuquerque (.283 in 28G) and Round Rock (.278 in 28) of the Pacific Coast League have higher team averages in Triple-A since 4/21.

STRIKEOUT LEADERS: Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 445 in 42 games (10.59 SO per game). That's 16 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 429 SO in 42G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (T-2nd, 49) and Touki Toussaint (T-5th, 46) both rank among the IL top five in strikeouts through 5/23.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin opened Sunday's game vs. Memphis with a solo home run off RHP Johan Oviedo, the Stripers' third leadoff clout this season (Drew Waters has 2). It was Gosselin's first career leadoff homer with Gwinnett in his 269th game with the club.

• GWN Career: Over parts of four seasons with the club (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .295 (292-for-991, 58 2B, 10 3B, 16 HR, 132 R, 96 RBI, 10 SB, .766 OPS) with 80 multi-hit efforts in 269 games.

SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake tallied the first triple of his Triple-A career on Sunday (1-for-4, R). He is 5-for-8 (.625) in his last two games, including the second four-hit game of his career on Saturday (4-for-4, 2B, R, RBI). Through the first 33 games of his Triple-A debut, Shewmake is batting a team-best .303 (36-for-119, 8 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 17 R, 7 RBI, 4 SB, .805 OPS).

VODNIK DEBUTS: Since joining Gwinnett on 5/17, Victor Vodnik has made two scoreless relief appearances (3.0 IP, 0 H, 3 BB, 1 SO). Vodnik has yet to allow a run over 10.0 IP (4 H, 6 BB, 15 SO, .125 BAA) in nine outings between Gwinnett and Double-A Mississippi this season.

TONIGHT: The Gwinnett Stripers open a six-game series **DICKERSON DROPPING BOMBS:** After hitting .161 with no homers in his first eight games with Gwinnett, Alex Dickerson is batting .294 (10-for-34, 3 HR, 5 R, 6 RBI, .853 OPS) in his last nine games. He homered twice in the series vs. Memphis, including a game-winning two-run shot (off LHP Zack Thompson) in a 5-3 victory on 5/19.

> RISING WATERS: Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, Drew Waters is batting .304 (14-for-46, 1 2B, 2 HR, 7 R, 5 RBI, .790 OPS) in 11 games. His seventh-inning RBI single on 5/18 vs. Memphis was the difference in a 4-3 win, marking his second GWRBI of the year (also hit walk-off single for 6-5 win on 5/8 vs. CLT). Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.

> TROMP, SINCE THE HISTORIC STREAKS: Chadwick Tromp is batting .083 (2-for-24) in six games since posting three memorable streaks for the Stripers. He notched a 13-game hitting streak (.385) from 4/24-5/12. IL-best 11-game RBI streak (23 RBI) from 4/28-5/12, and IL-best nine-game extra-base hit streak (11 XBH) from 5/1-12.

• Mashing in May: Gosselin has notched hits in 12 of 14 MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller struck out five over 5.0 innings (6 H, 2 ER, 3 BB) in a no-decision on 5/20 vs. Memphis, raising his season strikeout total to 49 (T-2nd in IL). Only Norfolk's Grayson Rodriguez has fanned more batters (1st, 66) in the league this year. Muller owns a 10.99 SO/9.0 IP ratio (142 SO in 116.1 IP) over 24 career starts with Gwinnett since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, going 7-6 with a 3.48 ERA, .231 BAA, and eight quality starts.

> THE ELDER STROLLS: Bryce Elder set a new career high for strikeouts on 5/18 vs. Memphis, fanning 11 over 7.0 innings (5 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB) in his first Triple-A win of the year. His previous high was 10 strikeouts, set with High-A Rome on 6/3/21 at Bowling Green (6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 0 BB). Elder owns a 9.71 SO/9.0 IP ratio (59 SO in 54.2 IP) over his 10 career starts with Gwinnett since 2021, going 3-3 with a 3.29 ERA, 1.04 WHIP, and .166 BAA.

> PROSPECTING: Gwinnett's active roster features five on the MLB.com Braves Top 30 Prospects list: OF Drew Waters (2), LHP Kyle Muller (3), RHP Bryce Elder (4), SS Braden Shewmake (5), and RHP Victor Vodnik (12).

> CHAMPIONSHIP EXPERIENCE: The Stripers' roster includes three players who saw time with the World Series champion Atlanta Braves last year: Kyle Muller, Touki Toussaint, and Huascar Ynoa. Additionally, Greyson Jenista, Nolan Kingham, Braden Shewmake, Victor Vodnik, and coach Devon Travis were all part of the Double-A South champion Mississippi Braves in 2021.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) .. In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Bryce Elder makes his fourth Triple-A start of the season in the opener of a six-game series at Norfolk.

- GWN Career: Makes his 11th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 3-3 with a 3.29 ERA (20 ER in 54.2 IP), .166 BAA, 25 walks, and 59 strikeouts since 2021 ... When he debuted last season, was the first of Atlanta's 2020 draft class to reach Triple-A.
- Triple-A Splits: Makes his sixth career road start at the Triple-A level (2-2, 3.90 ERA, .167 BAA) and 10th career night start at the Triple-A level (3-3, 3.38 ERA, .168 BAA).

PROSPECTING: Elder is ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 4 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the second-highest ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's roster (Kyle Muller is No. 3).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Began the season on Gwinnett's Opening Night roster, but did not appear before having his contract selected by Atlanta on 4/12 ... Optioned back to Gwinnett on 5/1 ... 5/18 vs. MEM: Set new career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB) for his first Triple-A victory of the season as the Stripers won 4-3 (was his first win with Gwinnett since 9/9/21 at Columbus).

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made his MLB debut on 4/12 vs. Washington, earning the win (5.2 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 4 SO) in the Braves' 16-4 rout ... Became the 107th former Gwinnett player to reach the Majors and the first Atlanta starter to win his MLB debut since Ian Anderson (8/26/20 at NYY, won 5-1) ... Went 0-3 with a 4.73 ERA (7 ER in 13.1 IP) in his next three starts, walking 14 and striking out eight.

2021 SEASON: Earned the Braves' Phil Niekro Award for Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 11-5 with a 2.75 ERA, 1.10 WHIP, and .193 BAA in 25 starts across three levels (High-A Rome, Double-A Mississippi, Triple-A Gwinnett) during his pro debut ... Ranked among MiLB pitching leaders in innings (1st, 137.2), starts (T-2nd), wins (T-6th), and strikeouts (10th, 155) ... Named Double-A South Pitcher of the Week for 7/5-7/11 (2-0, 0.75 ERA, 0.67 WHIP, .061 BAA in 2 starts) and Double-A South Pitcher of the Month for July (4-1, 2.73 ERA, 0.88 WHIP, .140 BAA in 5 starts) ... Won eight of nine starts between 7/4 and 8/20 (8-1, 2.84 ERA, 1.04 WHIP, .179 BAA).
