NOTES AND NUGGETS

GETTING TRANSACTIONAL

- A handful of roster moves were made ahead of this week's series in Indianapolis.
- Most notably, catcher **Carter Jensen** earned a promotion to Omaha and made his Triple-A debut last night ... the Royals' No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 82 overall prospect, Jensen was the Texas League leader in hits (80) and total bases (115), while 6th with a .292 average (80-for-274) ... catcher **Brian O'Keefe** was released, having played 115 game for the Chasers over the last two years.
 - Additionally, **Kyle Wright's** rehab assignment concluded and he was optioned to Triple-A, while second baseman **Michael Massey** was sent to Omaha for a rehab, having been on Kansas City's Injured List since June 8 with a *left ankle sprain*, Massey's 4th rehab assignment with Omaha since July 2023.

LET IT GO, LET IT GO ... CAN'T HOLD IT BACK ANYMORE

Yesterday marked the beginning of the 2nd half in the 2025 International League season, with records for all teams re-setting at 0-0 ... the winner of the IL's 2nd half will play a best-of-3 league championship series against the Jumbo Shrimp.

- Omaha finished 31-43 in the 1st half ... 12 games under .500 matches the furthest below .500 the Storm Chasers got in the 1st half, while the club peaked at 2 games over .500 twice.
- 33 of Omaha's 74 games (45%) were against teams with a winning record, and the Storm Chasers went 12-21 (.363) in such contests ... 42 of 74 games (54%) were at home, and Omaha went 17-25 (.404) at Werner Park.
- 36 of Omaha's 75 games in the 2nd half are against teams with winning records in the 1st half ... in the 2nd half, Omaha plays 33 of 75 games (44%) at Werner Park ... the Chasers make 2 trips to Indianapolis and Columbus, 12 games in each city, while playing 9 games in Des Moines, plus a 9-game trip to Buffalo and Syracuse.

SWEPT UP IN PAPILLION

After sweeping the Toledo Mud Hens at Fifth Third Field, the Omaha Storm Chasers returned home and were swept by the Durham Bulls last week at Werner Park.

- Since 2021, Omaha has been swept 6 times, including twice this season ... the Storm Chasers were swept in Toledo by the Mud Hens, April 22-27, then swept at home by the Durham Bulls, June 17-22.
- Last week was the first time Omaha was swept in a 6-game series at home ... however, the Iowa Cubs took all 5 games the two teams played at Werner Park, August 8-13, 2023, the back half of an 11-game losing streak.

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

After leading for 42 of 50 innings in a series at Toledo (84%) June 10-15, the Storm Chasers have led for just 1 of the team's last 63 innings, going back to June 17.

- Omaha has trailed for 57 of the team's last 63 innings, after trailing for 48 of 54 innings last week against Durham (89%).
- In the first 3 games of last week's series, the Bulls scored in the first inning and led the rest of the game ... Omaha trailed for the final 7 innings of Friday's game, played from behind for 8 of 9 innings Saturday night, and trailed for the first 3 and last 3 innings Sunday evening ... Omaha's only lead in the entire series with the Bulls lasted approximately 8 minutes, as the Storm Chasers took a lead in the bottom of the 4th, then Durham tied the game up in the top of the 5th.
- Prior to last week, Omaha trailed for 55 innings across the previous 21 games ... that represented just 31% of the team's 178 innings, dating back to May 24.
- Omaha was outscored by Durham last week 49-23, a -26 run differential ... prior to the series with the Bulls, the Chasers' biggest negative run differential in a series was -14, when Norfolk outscored Omaha 44-30 April 15 to 20.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

- Omaha has successfully stolen 109 bases this year, and only been caught 18 times ... 109 steals rank 4th in the International League and 5th in Triple-A.
- 109-for-127 in steal attempts is a 85.8% success rate, the BEST stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 4th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 89.1%, 57-for-64).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits at the top of the Triple-A level in strikeouts, with 713 strikeouts this season ... that is the 3rd-most of any Triple-A club and ranks 8th in Minor League Baseball (1st: Rancho Cucamonga Quakes, 751).

- Over 647.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 9.91 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
- With 713 strikeouts through 75 games, an average of 9.50 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,416 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline (Royals No. 20)

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 50 | Slider: 50 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 50 | Overall: 40

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 100 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.

- Champlain is making his **team-leading 15th start** with Omaha this season ... made Omaha's 2025 Opening Day Roster, after ending the 2024 season in Triple-A with the Storm Chasers.
- Playing his 5th professional season this year, his 4th in the Royals system after being drafted by the Yankees.
- Has allowed the most runs allowed of any Minor League pitcher (62) ... however, among AAA pitchers, has 2nd-highest rate of bequeathed runners scoring, 8 of his 12 runners (67%) inherited by Omaha's relievers have scored.
- Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the **No. 20 Royals prospect**.
- Ranked by Baseball America as the **No. 29 Royals prospect**.

Took his 4th loss of the season, tied a career-high with 11 hits allowed ... surrendered 4 runs in the 1st inning as Durham sent 10 batters to the plate, with 6 hits, a hit batter and sac fly scoring the 4 runs ... followed with 3 scoreless innings, stranded 5 runners on base between the 2nd and 4th innings ... in the 5th, a single, double, walk and RBI single ended his day, without recording another out ... left with the bases loaded, 1 bequeathed runner scored.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 8 of 14 starts, including 5 straight starts, April 24 to May 18 ... has finished 6.0 innings once, his second outing of the year, April 5 vs. Louisville (CIN), his first losing decision of the year.
- Has allowed 4+ runs in 10 of 14 starts, including 4 straight from May 18 to June 6 ... in that stretch had a 12.46 ERA (24 ER in 17.1 IP), with a 2.37 WHIP and .390 opponents' average in this 4-start span as well.
- While only 5.0 innings, his scoreless start on June 13 @ Toledo was the IL's 2nd shutout of 2025 ... was the 20th complete game in the Storm Chasers era (since 2011), the first since Austin Cox on August 28, 2022 @ SWB ... was Omaha's 3rd CG less than 7.0 innings in this span ... just the 4th CG shutout for Omaha since 2011 ... was the first CG shutout less than 7.0 innings for an Omaha pitcher since Anthony Lerew on August 31, 2010 vs. Round Rock (also 5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB).

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.
