RIDERS BLANKED ON FRIDAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders were held without an extra-base hit on Friday by the Midland RockHounds in a 5-0 loss from Riders Field. After racking up 11 hits on Thursday, the Riders (17-14, 48-51) managed just six singles on Friday and were shut out for the first time since July 16th. Frisco put the leadoff man aboard three of nine times, but each time Midland (15-16, 47-53) wiped out the runner on a caught stealing or double play. The RockHounds recorded their first shutout since May 20th. **Dane Acker** (1-1) allowed four runs in four innings to take the loss, striking out five. He limited damage in the fourth after Midland loaded the bases with nobody out. He induced a double play ball that scored one run and then struck out the next batter looking. **Jax Biggers** turned the 6-3 twin killing for Frisco's 90th double play of the season, good for first in the Texas League. Joe Boyle (1-0) tossed six strong innings in his Midland debut, earning the win with eight strikeouts and no runs allowed. **Reid Birlingmair** pitched two scoreless innings with three strikeouts for the Riders, facing the minimum in the fifth and sixth. He allowed a leadoff single in the sixth but **Scott Kapers** caught the runner stealing. **Michael Brewer** added two more strong innings for Frisco, holding Midland hitless in the seventh and eighth. **Antoine Kelly** allowed one unearned run in the ninth. **Keyber Rodriguez** had his first multi-hit game for the RoughRiders. Playing in his fourth career game at the Double-A level, the shortstop went 2-for-3 while batting ninth in the order. Frisco was averaging 8.5 runs per game over the previous 10 contests, including a season-high 19 runs in a win over Wichita. The Riders are now split at two games apiece in this series with Midland. Frisco has still not lost consecutive games since July 16th or three games in a row since July 1st.

K'S BY KELLY

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 17 outings. During that stretch, he has 23 strikeouts to three walks over 19.1 innings while recording three saves. He has converted on all seven save opportunities this season.

TRADE SEASON:

The Rangers and the Mets made a major trade on Saturday evening, being reported as completed during the sixth inning of that evening's Riders game, when the Mets sent three-time Cy Young winner and eight-time All-Star **Max Scherzer** to Texas in exchange for RoughRiders shortstop **Luisangel Acuña**. Acuña exits the Rangers franchise hitting .315/.377/.453/.830 with a team-high 25 doubles, 114 hits, 68 runs scored and 42 stolen bases. On Sunday, a second trade for the Rangers impacted Frisco with **Thomas Saggese** and **Tekoah Roby** going to the St. Louis Cardinals organization in exchange for LHP **Jordan Montgomery** and RHP **Chris Stratton**. Saggese was one of the best bats for Frisco, hitting .313/.379/.512/.891 with 22 doubles, 15 home runs, 78 RBIs and 67 runs scored over 93 games while Roby, who has been out with injury since early June, went 2-3 with a 5.05 ERA in 10 starts.

BIG(GERS) DAY IN WICHITA:

Riders infielder **Jax Biggers** had a monster day on Sunday after entering into the game in the second inning for **Thomas Saggese**. He whacked two home runs in a three-hit day for his first multi-home run game of his MiLB career and is now hitting .348 (16-for-46)/.464/.565/1.029 over his last 12 games.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.19 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. They have used 17 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 43 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.33 (127ER/156.0IP) while the bullpen has a 4.36 ERA (112ER/231.1IP). Over the 43 games, the Riders have the fourth-best offense in the league by OPS (.788), second-best in runs per game (6.0) and have hit 43 home runs (5th in the Texas League).

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 26 games, he has driven in 28 runs and in July, Hatcher hit .318/.360/.545/.905 with five homers and 23 RBIs in 17 games.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ABOUT MATT

REPERTOIRE

-Drafted first overall as a shortstop by the San Diego Padres in 2004, one pick before Justin Verlander. He became the first shortstop drafted first overall out of high school since Alex Rodriguez in 1993.

-At Mission Bay High School in San Diego, California, Bush hit .450 with 11 home runs and 35 RBIs. On the mound, he touched 94 mph, going 5-1 with a 0.73 ERA. He also played soccer and ran track.

2016 - 2023 SEASONS

-Bush was signed by the Rangers and assigned to the Frisco RoughRiders in 2016. Over 12 outings, he went 0-2 with a 2.65 ERA, touching 101 mph on his fastball.

-From there, he was promoted straight to Arlington, making his MLB debut on May 16th, 2016 against the Toronto Blue Jays. In that appearance, he struck out reigning AL MVP Josh Donaldson looking before retiring Jose Bautista and Edwin Encarnacion for a 1-2-3 inning.

-Missed time from 2019-2020 with Tommy John surgery.

-On August 1st, 2022, he was traded to the Milwaukee Brewers in exchange for LHP **Antoine Kelly** and INF **Mark Mathias**. He was released by the Brewers on July 1st, 2023 and returned to the Rangers organization on July 12th, 2023.

2010 - 2011 SEASONS

-Signed with Rays and pitched in High-A Chattanooga and Double-A Montgomery before being released by Tampa Bay in 2012.

2004 - 2007 SEASONS

-Played shortstop and hit for four seasons, batting .219/.294/.276/.570 between Rookie League and High-A Lake Elsinore.

-Bush was converted to a pitching in the 2007 season. He underwent Tommy John surgery to miss the 2008 season.
