WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Single-A Fredericksburg snapped a five-game skid in Sunday's finale against Fayetteville (HOU), winning 11-2..2B **RAFAEL RAMIREZ JR.** went deep twice and drove in six runs in the victory, while adding a third hit to finish 3-for-4.

WESTWARD BOUND: Behind long balls from both LF **TREY LIPSCOMB** and SS **SEAVAR KING** in the early stages of Sunday afternoon's series finale, the Rochester Red Wings took down the Charlotte Knights, 7-5, closing out the week with a 4-2 series win...Lipscomb's moonshot was his third home run of the weekend and occurred in the bottom of the third, while Seaver King belted his ninth of the season...six different pitchers were called to the hill, with RHP **JACK SINCLAIR** earning the win in a two-strikeout performance...the Red Wings used their scheduled off-day Monday to travel west to Omaha for the first time since 1990...Rochester will send LHP **MATT KROOK** to the mound to face Storm Chasers RHP Vince Velasquez...

The Red Wings have not won a series in Omaha since they swept a three-game set in 1988 (6/13-15) when they were known as the Royals.

KROOK & LADDERS: Southpaw **MATT KROOK** will get the ball first for the Red Wings tonight, becoming the 22nd pitcher to start a game for Rochester in 2026 (most since 2022, 23)...it will mark his first start since he tossed 6.1 scoreless innings for Scranton/WB on 9/22/2022 vs. SYR...the Oregon alum appeared in two games out of the bullpen last week vs. CLT, allowing one earned on one hit across 3.1 combined innings, including 1.1 hitless frames on 8/13...in four appearances since joining the Red Wings, Krook is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (1 ER/5.1 IP) with six strikeouts, one walk, a 0.75 WHIP and .167 BAA (4 H)...

Tonight's appearance will be the 300th of his MiLB career, and 96th start...since making his debut with Scranton/WB in 2021, Krook ranks second in the International League with 398 strikeouts, 11th with 332.1 innings pitched, and is T-13th with 148 appearances.

INTERNATIONAL LOVE: 3B **TREY LIPSCOMB** went 1-for-5 with a HR and two RBI in Sunday's series finale vs. CLT...Lipscomb homered twice on Saturday and again on Sunday, marking his second back-to-back home run games in the last two weeks and third such stretch of the season...he now has 25 homers, the most by a right-handed Red Wings hitter since Adam Brett Walker in 2016 (27)...following an outstanding performance in last week's homestand, he was named the International League Player of the Week (8/10-16) for the first time in his career...he hit .462 (12-for-26) with four home runs, two doubles, 10 RBI and eight runs scored across six games vs. CLT...the Maryland native led the IL over the course of the week in homers and total bases (26), was tied for first in RBI, and ranked second in SLG (1.000), third in OPS (1.462) and fourth in AVG...Lipscomb has now recorded a hit in 13 consecutive games, tied for the longest active hit streak in the IL...

In the month of August, Lipscomb is slashing .375/.394/.766 with 24 hits and seven home runs.

GOOD KINGS COME IN TWOS: Sunday's series finale saw SS **SEAVAR KING** go 2-for-4 at the plate with a solo home run, a double, and a walk...it marked his fourth multi-hit performance of the series with the Knights, the most he has had in a series since making his Triple-A debut on 5/19...the 2024 Nats' first rounder now has hits in his last eight games since 8/8, the second-longest active hit streak among Red Wing hitters...during that span, he leads the International League in batting average (.469) and OPS (1.447), and is T-1st with teammate **TREY LIPSCOMB** in both hits (15) and runs scored (11).

HE GETS ON BASE: LF **PHILLIP GLASSER** finished 2-for-4 with a double, an RBI and a walk during Sunday afternoon's series finale vs. CLT...he has reached base in 23 consecutive games, tied for the fourth-longest active on-base streak in the International League and the longest by a Red Wing in 2026...during the span of the streak, he has an OBP of .434...he is slashing .326/.402/.421 in day games this season...

Glasser is 4 RBI shy of 150 in his professional career.

FOLLOW THE LEADER: RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** went 2-for-4 with a home run, two RBI, and two runs scored in Sunday's game...among Red Wings with at least 40 AB this season, he leads the team in AVG (.321), OBP (.431), SLG (.738) and OPS (1.167)...his 1.167 OPS ranks third-highest in all of Triple-A (min. 40 AB)...he has reached base in 15 of his first 16 games as a Red Wing, dating back to his debut on 7/25...

Pineda is hitting .667 (6-for-9) with three doubles against southpaws with Rochester this season, including a base hit off LHP Garrett Schoenle in the eighth inning Sunday.

BULLPEN BULLIES: The prowess of the Red Wings' bullpen was on full display once again Sunday afternoon, combining for six strikeouts while allowing just one earned run and two walks...RHP **JACK SINCLAIR** recorded two strikeouts and grabbed his fifth win of the year, increasing his career single-season bests in both categories at the Triple-A level...RHP **RILEY CORNELIO** notched two strikeouts of his own, and RHP **PAXTON SCHULTZ** logged a strikeout without allowing a hit or walk...

Since the All-Star break, the Red Wings' bullpen leads all MiLB in holds (22) and ranks third in strikeouts (180)...across Triple-A, they lead in ERA (2.95, 50 ER/152.2 IP) and rank second in batting average (.218)...they also rank third in the International League in WHIP (1.31), T-3rd in wins (13), and fourth in earned runs (50) and K/BB (2.37).

- Slated to make his first start since 9/1/2022 tonight, becoming the 22nd pitcher to start a game for Rochester in 2026...since making his debut with Scranton/WB in 2021, Krook ranks second in the International League with 398 strikeouts, 11th with 332.1 innings pitched, and is T-13th with 148 appearances.
- Assigned to the Red Wings on 8/4 after being signed by the Nationals as a free agent.
- Between Rochester and Triple-A Las Vegas (ATH) this season, has held left-handed hitters to a .128 batting average...also boasts an ERA of 2.33 (5 ER/19.1 IP) in 14 home games between the Red Wings and Aviators this season.
- Registered a 3.72 ERA in 29 innings with the Athletics.
- Started the season in the Athletics organization before joining the Nationals organization, where he has had three separate stints this year. Across his time with the Athletics and Nationals in the MLB, he has pitched 11.1 innings this season.

Entering his fourth professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the seventh round of the 2022 MLB Draft, out of Texas Christian University.

- Optioned to Rochester on 8/4 after pitching 10.5 innings for the Nationals since his recall to the team on 6/29...allowed just one hit in his last four appearances with Washington.
- Since returning to the mound for Rochester on 8/4, the right-hander has tossed 8.0 scoreless innings across four appearances, striking out 14.
- Carries the second-lowest ERA (3.92) and WHIP (1.22) of any Red Wings pitcher with at least 50 innings of work.
- Holds the most strikeouts per nine innings (13.65) of any Triple-A arm (min. 50.0 IP)...furthermore, holds the lowest ERA (2.22) in night games among all Red Wings (min. 20 IP), while also having posted an undefeated record (3-0) in such games.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
