LAST TIME OUT

Moosic, PA (Aug. 3) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders topped the Rochester Red Wings 6-5 on Thursday night. The team battled for their third straight win behind eleven hits and Andres Chaparro's 20th long ball of the season.

The RailRiders took an early lead plating three runs in the bottom of the second inning. Franchy Cordero walked to reach. Back-to-back singles from Jamie Westbrook and Brandon Lockridge loaded the bases. Wilmer Difo put a ball in play and drove in a run, reaching on an error. Oswald Peraza followed with a two RBI base hit for a 3-0 advantage.

In the next frame Chaparro led off with a home run. Carlos Narvaez followed with a walk of his own and Cordero singled to get aboard. Westbrook drew a walk to load the bases yet again. Lockridge grounded into a double play but it brought in another to lead 5-0.

The Red Wings saw a solo shot from Pottsville-native Travis Blankenhorn to begin the fourth. His teammate Erick Mejia smoked a homer as well, this time to lead off the fifth. Rochester was down 5-2.

In the top of the seventh, the Red Wings came barreling back. Darren Baker and Luis Garcia laced back-to-back to drive in two runs. A fielder's choice off the bat of Jake Doll drove in the tying run to tie things at five apiece.

But, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was there once again in the bottom half. Austin Wells led off with a double down the right field line to get into scoring position. Narvaez did the same up the third base side to bring Wells home for a 6-5 advantage.

Will Warren impressed with his quality start allowing just two runs in six innings of work. He struck out six. Aaron McGarity (W, 5-2) had a clean 1.2 frames of work. Matt Bowman (S, 5) slammed the door shut in the ninth.

Alex Troop allowed five runs, four earned, in his Triple-A debut. Luis Reyes followed with three shutout innings. Luis Cessa (0-3) let up the game winning run in the eighth.

NEWS & NOTES

DRAW FOUR - The RailRiders pitching staff has combined for 38 strikeouts in three games with 15 K's in the first two contests. Last night, Will Warren added six of his own and Matt Bowman punched out the last two batters of the game. Impressively, the team has only issued nine free passes via eight walks and one hit by pitch.

CHAPPY HAPPY - Andres Chaparro smoked his 20th home run of the season last night with a solid line drive to left field. He has now hit 15 at PNC Field. This ties a career high set last year when he had 19 with Somerset and 1 with Tampa. The righty also has recorded 18 doubles which is three away from his career high from 2021.

WESTBROOK'S WORKING - Jamie Westbrook is well on his way to producing career numbers with the RailRiders. The righty has upped his batting average to .309 on the season with 82 hits in 75 games. He has hit 15 homers. The most he has ever had in a summer was 19 back in 2018. Since June 1st, Westbrook is batting .390 with more walks (24) than strikeouts (15). With SWB he mainly plays second and third base, but has also appeared in left field twice.

HITTING HOMERS - The RailRiders are now second in Triple-A with 166 to the Las Vegas Aviators. Rochester has the third least in Triple-A with just 105 as a team. The New York Yankees have amassed 150, and the Atlanta Braves are the first team to 206. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. The team homered 20 times in a week against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty-three, while six players are in double digits.

PEREIRA'S POWER: Everson Pereira has really impressed as the Yankees #4 prospect in Triple-A, batting .341 in 21 games played. He has had nine of multi-hit and eleven multi-RBI contests. Pereira has batted in 25 runs on 31 hits, including 5 doubles and 5 homers. The righty has played all three outfield positions. Pereira is also 12-26 with runners in scoring position and has come up in the clutch for the RailRiders in all four opportunities he has had with the bases loaded.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN - The RailRiders two August birthdays on the calendar. On August 15th, reliever Michael Gomez celebrates his 27th birthday. His teammate Zach Greene will as well on August 25th.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb being the latest. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospects, catcher, Austin Wells (#2 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) and outfielder Everson Periera (#4) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12), and Clayton Beeter (#13) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.

YANKEES GOT HIM: Was ranked by MLB.com as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect at the 2022 Trade Deadline in August... traded by the Dodgers to the New York Yankees for LF Joey Gallo at the Trade Deadline on Aug. 2, 2022... was assigned to Double-A Somerset upon the trade... was a Rangers and Gallo fan growing up

TJ TIME: Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

FUTURE FARMHAND: Was one of two Yankees prospects selected to the All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. The righty tossed just nine pitches, five for strikes, to record two outs in the seventh. He got San Diego's Jackson Merrill to ground out and recorded a strikeout against Jackson Chourio. Chourio is the #3 ranked prospect in all of MiLB according to MLB Pipeline, while Merrill stands at #10.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeout

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2023: In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP, breaking his previous career mark of 5 IP, set in his final two starts of 2022. In the performance, Beeter started the Patriots' second shutout win of the season.
- 2022: Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER)
- 2021: Made his pro debut in 2021 and posted a 3.44 ERA between High-A Great Lakes and Double-A Tulsa, working mostly as an opener, going no more than 3.1 IP in any outing
