LAST OUTING: Clarke last worked in a regular season game on October 1 vs. New York-AL at Kauffman Stadium. He entered in relief of starter Zack Greinke in the sixth and held the Yankees to two runs in the inning (1 inherited runner, 1 earned run) on two hits.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Clarke's first outing against Durham. He has made six relief appearances against Tampa Bay and is 0-2 with a 6.75 ERA (10.2 IP/8 ER) in his career. He last faced the Rays on July 15, 2023 in game one of a doubleheader and worked a scoreless inning.

- Set a career high in appearances

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Faced 91 consecutive batters without allowing a walk before issuing free pass to Vladimir Guerrero Jr. on June 7, ending a nine-pitch plate appearance...was the fourth-longest batters faced streak to begin a season in Royals history
- One of three pitchers to issue no more than eight walks while making at least 45 appearances (also Chris Martin and Joe Mantiply)
 • Ranked 10th in strikeout to walk ratio (6.0) among qualified relievers
- Allowed just one earned run across eight appearances (8.0 IP) in April, but allowed 11 earned runs across 11 games in May (9.1 IP)
- Earned second-career MLB save on April 28 at Chicago-AL with a scoreless ninth...was the first player in MLB history to record each of his first two saves against each Chicago teams

2021 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Ranked among Arizona pitching leaders in appearances (3rd), strikeouts (8th) and innings (10th)
- Recorded a strikeout in each of first 26 MLB career relief appearances, a new MLB record (besting Tyler Glasnow's previous tally of 24)...streak came to an end on May 4 at Miami
- · Was first season as full-time reliever

CAREER NOTES:

- In his 10th professional season; 1st with Milwaukee
- Earned 3.0-inning save in Major League debut on April 20 at Chicago-NL... recorded a hit (single off Randy Rosario) to become the first MLB player in history to record a hit and save in MLB debut
- Was the second player (Sammy Stewart w/ Baltimore in 1978) to record a win, loss and save across first three MLB appearances
- Was a Southern Leauge Mid-Season All-Star in 2017 with Jackson and a 2016 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in the Diamondbacks organization

LAST OUTING: Ashby pitched at Durham on May 7. He went 3.1 innings, allowing seven hits, four earned runs (two home runs), career-high seven walks and one strikeout. He got a no-decision in a 9-8 extra-innings victory.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Ashby's second career appearance against Durham with his first coming in the series opener.
