appearance on Major League rehab assignment from Milwaukee. He'll go up against Mason Montgomery who opened the series on the mound for the Bulls as Tuesday's starter

Taylor Clarke: The 30-year-old begins his MLB rehab assignment today, the day before his 31st birthday This is his debut in the Brewers organization after Milwaukee traded for him on December 14, 2023 in exchange for former Sounds shortstop Cam Devanney along with right-handed pitcher Ryan Brady. Clarke was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 25, 2024 with a right meniscus tear after making three appearances with Milwaukee in big-league spring training. He underwent surgery on March 30. Clarke went 3-6 with a 5.95 ERA (59.0 IP/39 ER) across 58 appearances ( 2 starts) with the Royals in 2023. He made the second-most appearances by Kansas City relievers and worked the seventh-most innings. Clarke is married and his wife's name is also Taylor...the couple has twin boys and a daughter. He was born with right-side facial paralysis, a weakness of the muscles that can cause some of his speech to be slurred. Clarke was originally selected by the Diamondbacks in the third round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

Mason Montgomery: The 23-year-old makes his eighth start of the season and second of the series this afternoon. He enters the day $0-5$ with a 7.84 ERA ( 31.0 IP/27 ER). Montgomery allowed four runs in the second inning (all earned) but rebounded to work six innings in a no-decision. He allowed five hits and four walks while striking out six. Montgomery has given up four runs in each of his last two starts and more than four in two other starts. The southpaw is in his first full season with Durham after being named a MiLB.com Organization All-Star last season, mostly with Double-A Montgomery. He was also named a Rays Organization All-Star after the 2022 season. Montgomery was selected by Tampa Bay in the sixth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Tech University. He spent three seasons playing for the Red Raiders in Lubbock, Texas. The White Sox selected Montgomery in the 39 th round out of Leander High School, but Mason did not sign.

Happy Mother's Day: Since 2005, the Sounds are 8-9 when playing on Mother's Day. Nashville has not lost on Mother's Day since joining the International League in 2021, beating Norfolk 4-0 on May 8, 2022 and Gwinnett 6-5 on May 14, 2023. Both of those wins were in Nashville. Initially scheduled to play on Mother's Day in 2021, the contest was rained out in Toledo. The Sounds are the only team in Triple-A who have yet to lose on Sunday. They're 6-0 and have outscored opponents 48-15 in those games (they have a - 25 run differential in all other games).

It's Miller Time: Owen Miller continues to pile up the hits with his time at Triple-A Nashville, adding three singles and two RBI in last night's game. His three hits tied a season high - it was also his 11th multi-hit game this season. Miller has at least one hit in 17 of 22 games. He has a . 432 on-base percentage this month after also having a . 432 on-base percentage across 10 games in April. Today will be Miller's 100th career game at the Triple-A level - he's played 52 with Nashville (2023-) and 48 with Columbus (2021). The infielder is batting . 307 (114 for-371) with 38 extra-base hits, 49 RBI and 49 runs scored at the level.

Big Z: Rob Zastryzny worked a scoreless inning with a strikeout out of the bullpen last night, his 12th scoreless appearance of the season and ninth of at least one inning. Zastryzny boasts a 0.46 WHIP, .115 opponent batting average and leads the Sounds with four wins in relief. Among Triple-A pitchers to have worked at least 15 innings this season, the left-hander has the lowest WHIP and opponent batting average. He also has the highest strikeout to walk ratio (23.00) in the same category.

Roster Moves: In addition to Taylor Clarke being added on Major League rehab assignment, right-handed starter Tobias Myers has reported to Nashville after being optioned by Milwaukee on Friday. In his first stint with the Brewers, Myers went 0-2 with a 5.29 ERA (17.0 IP/10 ER) in four starts. He began the season with the Sounds and went 1-1 with a 1.62 ERA ( 16.2 IP/3 ER) in four appearances ( 3 starts) before making his Major League debut with the Brew Crew on April 23 at Pittsburgh.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321 st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 701-603 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,293-2,123 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).
