## TODAY'S HEADLINES

#### Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 293-274 LAST TIME OUT: The Saints held another late lead that slipped away as the Clippers scored three runs in the eighth inning to win 8-7. Andrew Morris allowed just two runs over 5.0 innings in the start. The offense provided him five runs of support over the first five frames, taking a 5-3 lead. Michael Helman homered in the first inning. In the fourth inning, the bottom three batters in the order drove in four runs. However, Columbus scored five runs from the sixth to the eighth innings, getting a three-run home run from Raynel Delgado, giving the Clippers an 8-7 lead

in the eighth, holding on in the ninth for the win.

Over the last nine games, 24 of the 34 runs (70.6%) scored against the Saints bullpen have come on home runs, the highest rate in Triple-A.

> HUNTINGTON HOUSE OF HORRORS: Huntington Park has historically been a difficult place for the Saints to play, going 12-27 since joining the International League in 2021. The Saints' .308 winning percentage at Huntington Park since 2021 is the worst of any road venue they have played in. WILLIAMS WARMING UP: Chris Williams has found his stride in the month of September, riding a season-long, six-game hit streak. In that stretch, he's gone 8for-20 (.400), sporting a 1.070 OPS. Williams has also drawn a walk in four of the six games, drawing five free passes, matching his total drawn in 12 August games.

PRATO POWER UP: Over his last 10 games, Anthony Prato has been locked in, collecting hits in nine of the 10 games. He's gone 11-for-30 (.367) with with four doubles and three RBI. Prato has struck out nine times in his last 30 plate appearances, but has also drawn just four walks. Prato has drawn 67 walks this season, tied for the 8th-most in the International League

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .419 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 49 of the 55 games he's played in, drawing 28 walks and been hit by a pitch 11 times, the most in the International League in that span. He is fourth among fullseason minor league players in on-base percentage at .437 across three levels

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: Yunior Severino has had an incredible turnaround this season and now finds himself in position to set several franchise single-season records. He currently is tied for the single-season RBI record with 75 and collected 117 hits on the season, tied for fourth (Jose Miranda - 2021) on the single-season hit charts. He also ranks second in the single-season home run charts with 20, trailing the 21 long balls that Jair Camargo and Chris Williams hit last season
