ABOUT LAST TIME... The Vancouver Canadians fell behind early and never recovered in a 6-4 loss to the Tri-City Dust Devils (Angels) on Sunday afternoon at Ron Tonkin Field.

Tri-City got to starter Alex Nolan (L, 0-4) for four runs on five hits – all singles – in the opening frame to take a 4-0 lead that they held on to for the entire game and added a solo homer in the fourth to go up 5-0.

Vancouver scored their first run on two hits in the home half of the fourth. Orelvis Martinez singled before Zac Cook brought him in with a two-out RBI double to make it 5-1 Tri-City.

The C's valiant comeback effort in the eighth saw three runs come across to bring the potential tying run to the plate. Eric Rivera got the rally started with a single and went to third on the play after the right fielder booted the ball. Rafael Lantigua followed with an RBI single to bring Vancouver within four before a Will Robertson walk and Spencer Horwitz's single loaded the bases. Consecutive groundouts from Martinez and Luis De Los Santos scored two runs for a 6-4 Dust Devils lead, but that proved to be all the Canadians would be able to muster. Hagen Danner and Roither Hernandez combined on three scoreless innings of relief from the seventh through the ninth to keep the game within striking distance.

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORDO: Vancouver and Hillsboro meet for their fourth series of the season this week. The C's faltered in round three August 3-8 when they were the home team for the first time; they lost the final four games of the series to fall to 8-10 against the Hops this year. Hillsboro has outscored the Canadians 77-72 in the season series thus far.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: August 24, 2017 – The C's scored two runs in the eighth and held on in the ninth to beat Everett 3-1 at Everett Memorial Stadium. Eventual team MVP Riley Adams hit his first professional triple to score the first run of the penultimate inning before Brock Lundquist singled him home to make it 3-0. Orlando Pascual gave up a solo homer in the ninth but stranded the tying runs on base to secure his fifth save. Nate Pearson and Travis Bergen combined on eight shutout innings; Pearson went four, allowed no hits, walked one and K'd five while Bergen got the win with four one-hit frames, no walks and five strikeouts.

TUESDAY BLUES: Vancouver is 5-11 in series openers this year, their worst winning percentage of any day of the week.

HOT HANDS: Spencer Horwitz and Tanner Morris have a hit in 12 consecutive games, the longest hitting streak by any C's hitter this season. Horwitz has gone 23-for-45 (.511) with five doubles, three homers, 11 runs scored, 15 RBI and 13 walks while Morris is 15-for-51 (.294) with three doubles, a triple, seven runs scored, three RBI and five walks.

ON THE HILL: MLB.com's #20 Blue Jays prospect Sem Robberse gets the ball for Vancouver looking to build upon his successes from otherwise unfortunate starts to begin his High-A career. The right-hander last worked on August 18 against Tri-City when he took the loss after allowing five runs (two earned) on five hits with four walks and six strikeouts. He went three scoreless innings before all the damage was done in the fourth. Robberse, 19, made his High-A debut on August 12 in Everett when he was roughed up for nine runs – though only four were earned – on nine hits with five walks in two innings of work. He began the year with Low-A Dunedin, where he went 5-4 with a 3.90 ERA in 14 games (12 starts) across 57.2 frames.

Top Diamondbacks pitching prospect and their #4 overall farmhand Blake Walston makes his third start against Vancouver this year. The southpaw's last chance against the C's was on August 6, when he got the win with six innings in which he gave up three runs on five hits – including homers from Davis Schneider and Zac Cook – across six innings in which he didn't walk a batter and struck out four. Walston, 20, most recently took the ball on August 18 in Spokane when he gave up one unearned run on three hits in three frames. The Wilmington, NC native was Arizona's first round pick (26th overall) in the 2019 draft out of New Hanover High School in his hometown, the same school as long-time Red Sox slugger Trot Nixon.
