The Nuts opened the season with a 1-0 four-hit shutout victory at Dayton on Friday, but dropped the final two games of the series. The Loons, conversely, won the first two games of the year at home against Fort Wayne before averting a no-hitter on Sunday on Kyle Nevin's one-out single in the bottom of the ninth.

Last Game, Sunday: Dragons 7, Lugnuts 6. Cade Hunter lined an 0-1 pitch from Yehizon Sanchez into left field with one out and the bases loaded in the bottom of the ninth, driving in Cam Collier to lift Dayton to the rubber match victory. In the loss, Cameron Masterman delivered a three-run double for the Lugnuts.

Leading the League: 1B Will Simpson tops the MWL with six walks, OF Cameron Masterman is 1st with four doubles and four extra-base hits and is tied for 1st with nine total bases, OF Henry Bolte is tied for 1st with Masterman (and two others) with four RBIs.

2023 Retrospective: The Lugnuts finished the season with a 60-71 record... catcher Daniel Susac won the Midwest League batting title with a .303 average... 11 former Lugnuts (Ryan Noda, Hogan Harris, Mason Miller, Garrett Acton, Samad Taylor, Tyler Soderstrom, Lawrence Butler, Hagen Danner, Drew Millas, Joey Estes and José Espada) made their Major League debuts, bringing the total to 184 MLB Lugnuts all-time... Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. who played in the 2016 Crosstown Showdown, won the 2023 All-Star Home Run Derby... reliever Kumar Nambiar represented the Minor League Baseball Players' union in a panel of new labor unions with President Biden and Vice President Harris at the White House; Nambiar retired at the end of the season and now works in the Baltimore Orioles' analytics department... the World Series was won by the Texas Rangers, with assistant hitting coach Seth Conner (2013-14 with Lansing), over the Arizona Diamondbacks, starring 2019 Nuts catcher Gabriel Moreno and 2014 pitcher Miguel Castro.

A Good First Impression: The Lugnuts played the Michigan State Spartans on Wednesday in the 16th Crosstown Showdown exhibition, winning easily 18-0. Pitchers Grant Judkins, Hunter Breault and Yehizon Sanchez combined to hold the Spartans to two base runners on a pair of base hits while the offense blasted four home runs: a solo shot and a grand slam from Will Simpson and three-run homers by Joshwan Wright and Henry Bolte. Wright reached base in all four plate appearances (single, homer, two walks), but was outdone by Colby Halter, who reached base five times thanks to two singles, two walks and an HBP.

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 12) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from the University of Washington last year.

Familiar Faces: Lansing returns 17 players from the 2023 ballclub, not including second-year manager Craig Conklin and fourth-year pitching coach Don Schulze. The returners include James Gonzalez, Euribiel Angeles, Brayan Buelvas, Jonny Butler and Joshwan Wright, each of whom appeared in games for the Lugnuts in both 2022 and 2023, as well as lefty Jack Owen, who has pitched effectively for the Lugnuts during each of the last three seasons.

Come Together: The Lugnuts' Opening Day roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and six countries: Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: The Dragons walked off the Nuts for the second straight day to start the year, winning 4-3 on a throwing error by 3B Oliver Dominguez. The Lugnuts committed seven errors in the loss. Yikes. 3B Mark Sobolewski made two, P Matt Fields made two, and there was one apiece on 2B Ryan Schimpf, C Karim Turkamani and 3B Oliver Dominguez, plus a passed ball charged to Turkamani. The miscues led to three unearned Dragons runs, including the game winner. (Note that this is not the franchise record. That's nine errors, committed 6-13-03 vs. Fort Wayne.)

2016: After the first two games of the year were postponed in Lansing, the Lugnuts finally got the season going with a 5-4 loss at Great Lakes that saw Loons outfielder Jordan Paroubeck foul a ball into the broadcast booth that broke Lugnuts broadcaster Jesse Goldberg-Strassler's laptop.

In a Nutshell: Today is Eduardo's Lansing Lugnuts' debut, becoming the 934th all-time Lugnut... he opens the year as part of a piggyback tandem with right-hander Blaze Pontes... he is the youngest Lugnuts pitcher and the second youngest player on the team behind Henry Bolte.

Draft Day: Signed for \$125,000 out of Colegio Acelardo de Educación Secundaria (C.A.D.E.S.T.)... first ever player drafted from C.A.D.E.S.T.

Hometown Hero: Also born in San Juan: current A's infielder Darell Hernaiz as well as Bernie Williams, Danny Tartabull, Mike Lowell, Javy Lopez... home city of Vega Alta ("high/upper meadow"), founded 1775, is located in northern Puerto Rico, neighboring Vega Baja.

2021: Made professional debut on September 10 with a perfect inning against AzCL Giants Black, striking out one.

2022: Returned to action with the Arizona Complex League on July 5 with a hitless, scoreless inning against AzCL Brewers Gold... made eight appearances, none longer than 2 2/3 innings (August 6, striking out six Cubs).

2023: Joined Stockton in late May, making season debut on May 25... tossed three starts of at least six innings, peaking with 7-inning shutout gem on August 30 vs. Rancho Cucamonga (3 H, 3 BB, 5 K, 83 pitches, 50 strikes)... set career high in strikeouts with nine in five innings at Visalia, August 2... limited right-handers to .235 avg., .677 OPS (though they also hit the only three home runs he allowed all year); lefties batted .291 with an .849 OPS... 3.82 ERA in home games (8 G, 6 GS, 37 2/3 IP) compared to 7.18 ERA in road games (8 G, 6 GS, 31 1/3 IP).

Stoltz's Scouting Report: From Nathaniel Stoltz's Excessive Prospect Analysis: "Rivera has been the A's org's youngest pitcher in full-season ball by a full year, as he only recently just turned 20. As is to be expected from a young, huge (6'7", 237) pitcher who is light on pro experience, he's had bouts of inconsistency in Stockton, particularly on the command front, as the Puerto Rican southpaw is still figuring out how to corral his extended arm action and lengthy stride down the mound. He's got two good pitches to work with already, though: a 92-95 mph fastball that touches 96 and features big carry, and a wipeout mid-80s slider that he already shows signs of commanding... There's reason to expect a pitcher like this to possibly have lots of development remaining." In Stoltz's midseason review last year, he ranked Rivera as the A's No. 31 prospect.
